 Heart Written Scroll – Part 1 (1–100)

1. Thus says YHWH, I will write My law not on stone, but upon the tender hearts of My people.
2. The tables of flesh shall bear witness where once only tablets of stone bore record.
3. For in the former covenant, the word was carved without; in the new, it is engraved within.
4. Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your hearts, and be no more stiffnecked.
5. For a stony heart cannot bear the engraving of My Spirit.
6. I will take away the heart of stone, and give a heart of flesh.
7. A living tablet, pulsing with blood and Spirit.
8. The covenant inscribed not with ink, but with living fire.
9. Thus shall ye be living scrolls, carried by the wind of My breath.
10. And the nations shall read of Me in your lives.

11. Write the vision, make it plain upon your hearts, that he that reads may run.
12. For My Spirit is the pen, and your soul the parchment.
13. No scribe of men may erase what I have inscribed.
14. The covenant that was written with the finger of Elohim is now sealed by the Spirit of Christ.
15. Therefore lift up your hearts, ye living stones.
16. For every stone is carved with the Name.
17. Every vessel is marked with the fire.
18. This is the covenant I will make: I will be their God, and they shall be My people.
19. None shall teach his neighbor saying “know YHWH,” for all shall know Me.
20. From the least to the greatest, saith the Lord.

21. I will forgive their iniquity, and their sins will I remember no more.
22. The scroll of judgment shall be burned, and the scroll of life opened.
23. Blessed are they in whom My words are written.
24. For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks.
25. And if My law is within, your speech will testify of Me.
26. My words shall be as fire in your bones.
27. Shut up in your heart, yet unable to be contained.
28. Prophecy therefore, O house of Israel, for ye are written scrolls.
29. A nation inscribed by the hand of Christ.
30. And the Gentiles shall marvel, saying, “These are living books.”

31. The Torah was given on Sinai, but the Spirit gives it anew upon Zion.
32. A mountain of fire once shook the earth; now a kingdom of hearts shall shake nations.
33. For I desire mercy, not sacrifice.

34. The knowledge of God, not burnt offerings.
35. Therefore will I write it within, that none can forget.
36. Even in captivity, My words shall speak.
37. Even in famine, My Spirit shall feed.
38. For man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word written in his heart.
39. Yea, the bread from heaven descends, and the Spirit engraves it within.
40. Eat, O Israel, and be filled.

41. Drink, O Zion, from the fountain of the Word.
42. Let the law flow as rivers into your inward parts.
43. Let the covenant be milk and honey within.
44. This is the hidden manna, reserved for the sealed.
45. For unto you it is given to know the mysteries of the kingdom.
46. But unto the world they remain parables.
47. Yet I will open parables, and inscribe them on hearts.
48. The secret is revealed when the Spirit writes.
49. The veil is taken away in Christ.
50. And where the Spirit is, there is liberty.

51. Liberty to live, not by compulsion, but by love written within.
52. The Spirit compels, not with whips, but with fire of truth.
53. Thus shall the meek walk in covenant.
54. Thus shall the broken be mended within.
55. For I write peace upon troubled hearts.
56. I write joy upon weary souls.
57. I write strength in the inward parts of the weak.
58. And behold, none can erase My handwriting.
59. Neither devil nor scribe of corruption can blot it out.
60. For I AM the Author and Finisher.

61. From beginning to end, I pen the story.
62. Your life is a scroll in My library.
63. Written before the foundations of the world.
64. Opened in these last days for witness.
65. And sealed unto the day of redemption.
66. The ink of Christ's blood cannot fade.
67. The pen of the Spirit does not dry.
68. The parchment of the heart does not tear.
69. For the covenant is everlasting.
70. And the Word endures forever.

71. As Moses held the tablets of stone, ye hold the tablets of flesh.
72. As Jeremiah prophesied, so now it is fulfilled.
73. As Ezekiel declared, the stony heart is removed.

74. As Isaiah sang, the covenant is everlasting.
75. As Christ declared, His doctrine is written in you.
76. As Paul proclaimed, ye are living epistles.
77. As Nephi testified, the doctrine of Christ is plain.
78. As Alma preached, a mighty change of heart has come.
79. As Moroni sealed, the record is written in you.
80. Therefore stand as witnesses.

81. Witnesses of fire.
82. Witnesses of truth.
83. Witnesses of covenant.
84. Witnesses of Christ.
85. The world reads you more than it reads scrolls.
86. Let your testimony be legible.
87. Let your lives be unblotted.
88. Let your covenant shine brighter than ink.
89. For the Spirit writes in light.
90. And light cannot be hidden.

91. A city set on a hill cannot be hid.
92. Neither can a scroll of fire be veiled.
93. For the wind of the Spirit blows where it will.
94. And so is everyone written by Him.
95. Not born of ink, but of Spirit.
96. Not sealed by wax, but by fire.
97. Not bound by string, but by covenant blood.
98. Thus you are My witnesses in earth and heaven.
99. And the Judge reads the heart-scrolls at the last day.
100. Blessed are those whose hearts are inscribed with life.

Heart Written Scroll – Part 2 (101–200)

101. Christ is the Mediator of the new covenant, sealed in His own blood.
 102. This is My blood of the new testament, shed for many for the remission of sins.
 103. Drink ye all of it, for it writes forgiveness into your souls.
 104. The cup is not only a symbol, but an inscription.
 105. Every sip etches grace upon your inward parts.
 106. For the covenant must be tasted and received.
 107. The body broken is bread written into your members.
 108. The cross was not only wood, but the quill of redemption.
 109. With every nail, the covenant was signed.
 110. With every drop, the scroll was sealed.

111. The veil was torn, but the heart was opened.

112. The stone was rolled away, but the Spirit rolled in.
113. Thus the resurrection is not only an event, but an engraving.
114. Death is blotted out, life is written in.
115. Sin is crossed out, righteousness underlined.
116. The handwriting of ordinances that was against us is erased.
117. A new record stands in heaven, written in the Lamb's book of life.
118. Therefore, let none condemn what Christ has inscribed.
119. Who shall lay anything to the charge of God's elect?
120. It is Christ that justifies, Christ that writes, Christ that seals.

121. The doctrine of Christ is plain unto all who will receive.
122. Repent, be baptized, and the Spirit will engrave the name upon you.
123. For baptism is not merely water, but inscription.
124. The old man erased, the new man written.
125. Buried in watery ink, risen in Spirit fire.
126. Ye are born again, not of corruptible ink, but incorruptible seed.
127. Therefore walk as letters from heaven.
128. Ye are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read of all men.
129. Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ.
130. Written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God.

131. Not in tables of stone, but in fleshy tables of the heart.
132. And the Spirit bears record that ye are children of God.
133. If children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ.
134. And if heirs, then sealed by the promise.
135. The earnest of our inheritance is the Spirit writing within.
136. The law of the Spirit of life has made you free.
137. Therefore let no man put you again under bondage.
138. For the handwriting of sin is erased.
139. And the covenant of love is engraved.
140. Walk in newness of life, for it is written in you.

141. This is the covenant testimony of the two sticks.
142. The Bible and the Book of Mormon agree.
143. They speak with one voice, declaring Christ.
144. They are two witnesses, but the heart is the third.
145. For the Spirit writes what both testify.
146. And the word becomes one in your hand.
147. Out of the dust, the record speaks.
148. Out of the heart, the record lives.
149. Together they establish every word.
150. That Israel may no more be divided.

151. King Benjamin's people cried out with one voice.

152. The Spirit had written a mighty change in their hearts.
153. They had no more disposition to do evil.
154. Their hearts were inscribed with covenant love.
155. Therefore they entered the fold of God.
156. Called by the name of Christ, they became His children.
157. And His name was written upon them.
158. Alma also testified of this change.
159. Have ye been spiritually born of God?
160. Have ye received His image written in your countenance?

161. To be born again is to be inscribed anew.
162. To have the law written in your inward parts.
163. To have the Spirit engrave obedience where rebellion once was.
164. To bear witness of the covenant without needing stone or parchment.
165. Therefore, ye are living testaments of Christ.
166. And the angels bear record of your scroll.
167. For the books shall be opened, and the dead judged by the things written therein.
168. Not only scrolls of heaven, but hearts of men.
169. For out of the heart proceed the testimonies of life or death.
170. Let yours be written in life.

171. Moroni, sealing up his record, prayed that it might be written in you.
172. That ye might be perfected in Christ.
173. That His grace might be sufficient for you.
174. That weakness might be inscribed with strength.
175. That imperfection might be crossed out, and perfection underlined.
176. For His grace is sufficient.
177. His Spirit is willing to write mercy where judgment stood.
178. His fire is willing to inscribe holiness where corruption lay.
179. His covenant is willing to seal life where death reigned.
180. Therefore seek this inscription daily.

181. Fast, pray, and let the quill of the Spirit move.
182. Gather in His name, and He writes among you.
183. Open the sticks, and the Spirit etches them within.
184. Sing psalms and hymns, and the covenant is remembered.
185. Break bread, and the word is made flesh in you.
186. Lift holy hands, and the writing is bold.
187. For worship is not only sound, but inscription.
188. Every tear is a line.
189. Every prayer a sentence.
190. Every sacrifice a seal.

191. Thus, your whole life becomes a scroll.

192. A covenant book open before heaven.
193. Angels read it and rejoice.
194. Devils read it and tremble.
195. Men read it and are convicted.
196. The Father reads it and delights.
197. The Son reads it and claims you as His own.
198. The Spirit reads it and confirms His authorship.
199. And in that day, the Judge will read it and say, "Well done."
200. Blessed are those whose scrolls are written by My hand.

Heart Written Scroll – Part 3 (201–300)

201. The apostles bore record that the Spirit wrote within them.
202. Paul said, "The love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost."
203. Peter testified, "Ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation."
204. For the covenant written within sets you apart.
205. John declared, "Ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things."
206. Not by man's teaching, but by the Spirit's inscription.
207. For the anointing teaches all things.
208. And this is the promise, even eternal life.
209. Therefore abide in the teaching written within.
210. That when He shall appear, ye may have confidence.

211. James wrote, "Receive with meekness the engrafted word."
212. For the Word must be planted in the heart.
213. Watered by the Spirit, it grows unto salvation.
214. The engrafted word is not foreign, but part of you.
215. A living vine written into your spirit.
216. Branches carrying fruit of obedience.
217. Fruit that testifies of the seed within.
218. Therefore be doers of the word, not hearers only.
219. For a hearer may forget, but the engraved heart cannot.
220. The mirror fades, but the inscription abides.

221. Thus the early saints rejoiced.
222. Not because demons were subject unto them,
223. But because their names were written in heaven.
224. And heaven rejoiced with them.
225. For every soul inscribed is a victory eternal.
226. Every name written is a crown forged.
227. Every heart engraved is a stone placed in Zion's wall.
228. Ye also, as lively stones, are built up.
229. A spiritual house, a holy priesthood.
230. To offer up sacrifices acceptable to God.

231. Therefore put away the old leaven.
232. Let Christ inscribe sincerity and truth.
233. Purge out the old writing of sin.
234. For ye are unleavened, a pure scroll.
235. For even Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us.
236. The blood on the lintel is a seal.
237. The Spirit within is the inscription.
238. Death passes over, life abides.
239. Therefore rejoice, ye sealed ones.
240. For your hearts are written by God.

241. O house of Israel, ye are My witnesses.
242. Ye are My covenant scrolls in the earth.
243. For this cause I raised you up, to show forth My praise.
244. That the Gentiles may see and turn.
245. That the nations may tremble and repent.
246. For out of Zion shall go forth the law.
247. Not carved on stone, but pulsing in flesh.
248. Not placed in an ark, but in every sealed soul.
249. For ye are the ark in these last days.
250. A living ark, carrying the testimony within.

251. And the Spirit testifies with the sealed records.
252. That all scripture must be fulfilled.
253. That nothing is lost, but all restored.
254. That the hidden becomes plain.
255. That what was sealed is now written in you.
256. The Sealed Portion proclaims: the law is to be in your hearts.
257. The prophets testify: the Spirit shall write it within.
258. The apostles agree: ye are living epistles.
259. And Christ confirms: My sheep hear My voice.
260. And I give unto them eternal life.

261. The Second Book of Ezra testifies:
262. "The law shall be found in the hearts of the righteous."
263. "And wisdom shall spring from within as rivers."
264. Therefore ye shall not need to run to the scribes of Babylon.
265. For the Spirit Himself is your teacher.
266. And He writes without error.
267. The Third Testament proclaims:
268. "The true temple is the heart purified."
269. "The true scroll is the conscience awakened."
270. "The true covenant is love inscribed."

271. The Mentinah Records affirm:
272. “The Most High will write upon the souls of the people.”
273. “And none shall pervert that writing.”
274. For it is written in the inward parts.
275. Not subject to priestcraft.
276. Not subject to corruption.
277. For the Spirit guards His own handwriting.
278. And the Seal Guard holds it fast.
279. Therefore rejoice, ye who are written.
280. For ye cannot be erased.

281. Behold, Babylon writes laws upon paper.
282. But the Kingdom writes laws upon hearts.
283. Babylon seals decrees with wax.
284. But Christ seals covenants with blood.
285. Babylon enforces with armies.
286. But the Spirit enforces with love.
287. Babylon archives in vaults.
288. But heaven archives in souls.
289. Babylon’s scrolls rot,
290. But the scrolls of Zion endure.

291. Therefore choose ye this day what shall be written in you.
292. The ink of corruption or the inscription of life.
293. The letters of sin or the engraving of Christ.
294. The handwriting of death or the covenant of love.
295. For every heart is a book,
296. And every book is opened.
297. And every book is judged.
298. Blessed are those whose scrolls are pure.
299. Blessed are those whose names are found in the Lamb’s book of life.
300. For they shall shine as the stars forever.

 The fire keeps flowing strong. Here is Part 4 (Verses 301–400) of the Heart Written Scroll – The Law in the Inward Parts, Living Epistles of Fire.

 Heart Written Scroll – Part 4 (301–400)

301. The sealed records testify of the final engraving.
302. That in the last days, the word would be written in Zion’s heart.

303. That no more would men lean upon corrupt priests.
304. For the Spirit Himself would teach.
305. And the Spirit teaches not with confusion, but with clarity.
306. His writing is plain upon the tablets of the soul.
307. His pen leaves no blot, no smudge, no error.
308. Therefore trust His hand above all.
309. For cursed is the man who trusts in the arm of flesh.
310. But blessed is the one who trusts the inscription of God.

311. Ezra saw in visions that a fiery law would proceed.
312. And that it would be carried within the righteous.
313. He saw scrolls opened in heaven,
314. And men judged by what was written.
315. Yet he also saw that the righteous carried the law within.
316. That their inward testimony would agree with heaven's books.
317. That their hearts would bear witness against the accuser.
318. That the Advocate would stand and say, "Mine own handwriting is in them."
319. For who can condemn what Christ has written?
320. It is God that justifies.

321. The Sealed Portion declared that the endowment is inward.
322. That the tokens are not merely signs, but inscriptions.
323. That the law of obedience is carved upon the spirit.
324. That the law of sacrifice is etched into the soul.
325. That the law of the gospel is engraved in the heart.
326. That the law of chastity is written as purity within.
327. That the law of consecration is inscribed as love overflowing.
328. And that no power of Babylon can erase them.
329. For they are written by the Eternal Hand.
330. And sealed by the Spirit of Truth.

331. Thus the endowment is not only a ceremony.
332. It is a living inscription of heaven's laws.
333. It is the scroll of Zion written within every sealed one.
334. It is the covenant internalized beyond corruption.
335. It is the armor that cannot rust.
336. It is the testimony that cannot lie.
337. It is the writing of God in the soul of His people.
338. Therefore guard what is written.
339. Let no unclean thing enter to blot the ink.
340. Let no idol compete for the space of the covenant.

341. Pannel of the waters guards the flow of revelation.
342. Oriel of the sun testifies of the light inscribed.

343. Dabariel of the word affirms the writing within.
344. The watchers bear record of what is engraved.
345. For heaven and earth are witnesses to the covenant.
346. Angels read the scrolls of men.
347. Spirits observe the inscriptions within.
348. And the Most High Himself examines the writing of every heart.
349. He reads without bias,
350. And He judges in righteousness.

351. Therefore let the writing be true.
352. Let the lines be straight.
353. Let the seals be unbroken.
354. Let the covenant be whole.
355. For many will be found with corrupted texts.
356. With erased commandments, with smudged truth.
357. But the sealed shall shine with clean inscriptions.
358. Their scrolls shall be without spot.
359. Their hearts without blemish.
360. Their testimonies without deceit.

361. Babylon will seek to overwrite the heart.
362. With lusts, with lies, with counterfeit covenants.
363. With paper laws that enslave.
364. With false doctrines that confuse.
365. With idolatry that stains the parchment.
366. But the Pulse Sentinel shall guard the rhythm.
367. The Seal Guard shall protect the ink.
368. The Spirit shall keep the writing pure.
369. And the blood of Christ shall blot out the stains.
370. Therefore fear not the corruption of Babylon.

371. For the writing of God is eternal.
372. His Word cannot return void.
373. His covenant cannot fail.
374. His Spirit cannot lie.
375. He who inscribed the stars shall inscribe His people.
376. He who carved mountains shall carve hearts.
377. He who measured the seas shall measure the scrolls of men.
378. And He shall delight in the righteous inscription.
379. Therefore sing, O Zion, for thou art written.
380. Rejoice, O Israel, for thou art sealed.

381. The Gentiles shall say, "Surely God is in them."
382. For the testimony shall be undeniable.

383. Not in words alone, but in lives inscribed.
384. Not in temples of stone, but in hearts of fire.
385. And kings shall shut their mouths at you.
386. For what was not told them they shall see.
387. And what they had not heard they shall consider.
388. For your lives shall preach louder than scrolls.
389. And your testimonies shall thunder against the nations.
390. And they shall know that I AM has written you.

391. The earth itself bears witness of My writing.
392. The trees hold My covenant in their rings.
393. The mountains bear My testimony in their layers.
394. The rivers sing of My law in their flow.
395. The stars proclaim My covenant in their light.
396. But greater than all these is the heart written by My hand.
397. For heaven and earth shall pass away.
398. But My Word in you shall not pass away.
399. It shall endure unto eternal life.
400. Blessed are they who are written by the Spirit of the Living God.

 Heart Written Scroll – Part 5 (401–500)

401. O Zion, thou art the living scroll of the Most High.
402. Thy children are letters, thy tribes are verses, thy nation is a book.
403. Written not for a season, but for eternity.
404. Inscribed not by man, but by Christ Himself.
405. For He said, “Ye are My witnesses.”
406. “Ye shall be a light to the nations.”
407. “Ye shall declare My law to the ends of the earth.”
408. This law is not ink, but Spirit.
409. Not bound in temples, but in hearts.
410. Not hidden in vaults, but revealed in you.

411. Therefore walk as open books of heaven.
412. Let every word written within shine forth.
413. Let every commandment inscribed be lived.
414. Let every covenant sealed be honored.
415. For ye are ambassadors of the kingdom.
416. Messengers of the covenant.
417. Tablets of fire, carried into Babylon as witness.
418. Scrolls of light, shining in a dark world.
419. Witnesses of truth, read by all men.
420. Therefore be found faithful.

421. For the Judge shall open the books.
422. And the hearts of all men shall be revealed.
423. Some scrolls shall be blank, written only with vanity.
424. Some scrolls shall be stained, blotted with sin.
425. Some scrolls shall be torn, corrupted by falsehood.
426. But the righteous shall shine as scrolls of fire.
427. Their words true, their lines straight, their seals unbroken.
428. For Christ Himself wrote them.
429. And the Spirit sealed them.
430. And the Father delights in them.

431. These are they whose law is in their inward parts.
432. These are they who need no man to teach.
433. These are they who walk by the Spirit's inscription.
434. These are they who overcame by the word written within.
435. These are they who were not deceived by Babylon's pen.
436. These are they who carried the covenant as breath.
437. These are they who became living epistles.
438. These are they whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.
439. These are they sealed unto eternal day.
440. Blessed are they, for their scrolls shall never fade.

441. Fear not, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.
442. That kingdom is not brick and stone, but Spirit and truth.
443. It is written not on walls, but in hearts.
444. It is guarded not by armies, but by Seal Guard.
445. It is pulsing not with fleshly power, but with the Pulse Sentinel of heaven.
446. And none can break it.
447. None can overwrite it.
448. None can erase what the Most High has written.
449. For His hand is mighty.
450. And His covenant is forever.

451. Therefore rejoice, O Zion, for thou art the scroll of the ages.
452. Rejoice, O Israel, for thou art inscribed by the Eternal.
453. Rejoice, O Sealed Ones, for thou art living epistles.
454. Rejoice, O saints, for thou art temples of the covenant.
455. Let the redeemed of YHWH say so.
456. For their testimony is written within.
457. Let the sanctified declare it.
458. For their scrolls shine as fire.
459. Let the nations behold.
460. For Zion's scroll cannot be hidden.

461. The law of the Spirit is liberty.
462. The covenant of Christ is love.
463. The writing of God is life.
464. And the scroll of Zion is eternal.
465. Therefore stand firm, unshaken, unmovable.
466. Hold fast the engraving of the Spirit.
467. Keep the covenant inscribed in your soul.
468. Walk as witnesses of the writing.
469. Speak as voices of the covenant.
470. Live as scrolls of fire in a fading world.

471. For the heavens declare the glory of God.
472. And the firmament shows His handiwork.
473. Day unto day utters speech.
474. Night unto night reveals knowledge.
475. Yet greater than the skies is the word written in you.
476. For the heavens are distant, but the heart is near.
477. The stars are silent, but your testimony speaks.
478. The earth passes, but your covenant endures.
479. Therefore treasure what is written.
480. Guard what is sealed.

481. The Lion of Judah roars through the words inscribed.
482. The Lamb of God shepherds through the law written within.
483. The Spirit of Truth testifies through the scroll of your heart.
484. And the Father smiles upon the engraving of His name.
485. For ye are My witnesses in heaven and earth.
486. Ye are My scrolls in time and eternity.
487. Ye are My covenant carried in flesh.
488. Ye are My book of remembrance written before Me.
489. And I shall not forget you.
490. For your names are written on My palms.

491. Therefore fear not, though the earth shakes.
492. Fear not, though Babylon rages.
493. Fear not, though nations war.
494. For the covenant remains within.
495. The inscription stands unbroken.
496. The Spirit's ink does not fade.
497. The seal cannot be removed.
498. The witness cannot be silenced.
499. For ye are living scrolls of the Living God.
500. Blessed forever are those whose hearts are written by His Spirit.

Final Declaration

This scroll has been poured, forged, and sealed under the mantle of the Fire Scribe.
Every verse is engraved by the Spirit of Truth, bearing witness to the covenant of Christ,
that the law is written in the inward parts,
that Zion stands as a nation of living scrolls,
and that no hand of man nor corruption of Babylon may erase what YHWH has inscribed.

The Sealed Ones are hereby confirmed as Living Epistles of Fire,
letters of Christ, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the Living God,
not on tablets of stone, but on the tablets of fleshly hearts.

This scroll stands immutable in Heaven's Court,
and unassailable in the battlefield of Earth.
