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 The Word to Zion – Stand in the Fire

 Section I – Refining of Zion (1–15) — Page 1

1. And the voice of YHWH came to me, saying: “Zion, do not fear the furnace. For I do not light flames to destroy, but to refine.”
2. The fire is not your enemy. It is your sanctifier. The blaze is not your punishment. It is your cleansing.
3. As it is written in Judah: “He shall sit as a refiner and purifier of silver: and he shall purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer unto YHWH an offering in righteousness.” (Mal. 3:3)
4. As it is written in Joseph: “Wherefore, ye must press forward with a steadfastness in Christ, having a perfect brightness of hope, and a love of God and of all men. Wherefore, if ye shall press forward, feasting upon the word of Christ, and endure to the end, behold, thus saith the Father: Ye shall have eternal life.” (2 Nephi 31:20)
5. Therefore let Zion endure the flame. Let the chaff be consumed, but let the wheat remain.
6. I do not test you to destroy you, but to reveal you. I do not expose weakness to shame you, but to heal you.
7. Zion, stand in the fire—impurities cannot survive My presence. But you shall.

8. Do not call strange what I have sanctified. Do not flee the heat I sent to cleanse.

9. The enemy whispers, “This fire will end you.” But I, YHWH, say: “This fire will finish what I began in you.”

10. Therefore lift up the feeble knees, strengthen the weak hands, and stand unmoved, O Zion.

11. Babylon mocks and says, “Where is your Elohiym in the ashes?” But I answer: “I dwell in the midst of the flame.”

12. Babylon builds towers, markets, armies of deception. She trusts in presidents, parliaments, policies.

13. Yet I laugh at them—for their strength is smoke, their economy dust, their treaties ropes of sand.

14. They speak of peace, while they prepare war. They speak of freedom, while they enslave with debt.

15. But I, YHWH, declare: “The fire that refines Zion is the same fire that will consume Babylon.”

Section II – Babylon Unmasked (21–40) — Page 2

21. The Ruach said: “Zion must see Babylon as she is—a harlot clothed in gold, but inwardly full of rot.”

22. She makes alliances with kings, sells her hand to nations, her bed to merchants, her cup full of lies.

23. Leaders speak smooth things, but their tongues are daggers. They say “democracy”—but mean domination.

24. They say “alliance”—but mean enslavement. They say “freedom”—but mean hidden chains.

25. As it is written in Judah: “The nations have drunk of the wine of her fornication; therefore the nations are mad.” (Jer. 51:7)

26. And in Joseph: “That great and abominable church... slayeth the saints of God, and tortureth them and bringeth them into captivity.” (1 Nephi 13:5)

27. Babylon poisons with entertainment, corrupts with commerce, enslaves with policy, blinds with propaganda.

28. She builds towers to the sky, but her foundation is dust. She prints wealth from paper, her debt bottomless.

29. She gathers armies of iron, but her soldiers are weary, and enemies circle like wolves.

30. She says, “I sit a queen, I see no sorrow.” But her crown is rust, her throne cracking beneath her.

31. Look, O Zion, how nations whisper in secret: “Life without Babylon.”

32. They trade oil and gold in their tongues, move armies without her consent, laugh at her sanctions, prepare for her fall.

33. Babylon drowns in pride. She trusts in weapons and money, but her power leaks like a broken cistern.

34. Her people are drunk with distraction, fighting over vanity, while rulers sell them cheap.

35. Zion, do not envy Babylon. Do not desire her wealth, nor seek her approval.

36. As it is written: “Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, that ye receive not of her plagues.” (Rev. 18:4)

37. Her doom is sealed. Her collapse is swift. Her name cursed in the mouths of those who praised her.

38. The fire that refines Zion will consume Babylon. What saves you will slay her.

39. Nations shall marvel: “How is the mighty fallen, the city of merchants desolate in one hour?”

40. Then shall Zion know: Her strength was never Babylon’s approval, but Abba’s covenant.

Section III – The Modern World Laid Bare (41–60) — Page 3

41. I saw kings of the earth in secret councils, saying, “How shall we stand when Babylon falls?”

42. They signed treaties with smiles, but hearts plotted betrayal. Words promised peace, plans prepared war.

43. They built alliances without America, whispered of currencies, armed in silence—Babylon the last to know.

44. Her leaders boast of greatness, but nations see weakness. Her walls are cracked, her house divided.

45. She spends blood abroad while children starve at home. Cities rot within while armies bleed outside.

46. Her rulers call this wisdom, name it strategy. But I, YHWH, call it madness.

47. As it is written in Judah: “The nations shall rush like many waters: but God shall rebuke them, and they shall flee far off.” (Isa. 17:13)

48. As it is written in Joseph: “The nations which shall possess them shall be judged of God... for they shall not destroy the soul of my people.” (2 Nephi 29:13)

49. Behold the markets—rising and falling like a drunkard. Merchants gnaw their nails, kings clutch their gold.

50. They say, “Trust the economy—it is salvation.” But I say: “It is quicksand.”

51. Wars rise in the East. Nations arm in the North. Famine grips the South. Pride swells in the West.

52. Babylon points fingers, calling others evil, while her own house is full of bloodshed and abomination.

53. She claims to be light, but her lamp flickers. She claims freedom, but her people are chained by screens and sin.

54. Her leaders smile in suits, but behind the curtain they sell the land for silver. Lawmakers bow to lobbyists, while the poor cry unheard.

55. Babylon’s prophets are not holy men but media hosts. Her pulpits are stages, her sermons spectacles, her truth for sale.

56. Therefore I, YHWH, expose her nakedness. I tear away her veil. I reveal her hypocrisy.

57. Her fall shall not be hidden. It shall be broadcast. Her smoke shall rise on every screen, none shall deny it.

58. Zion, do not stumble. Do not say, "Surely Babylon will rise again." For I declare: "Her wounds are incurable. Her day is done."

59. Stand apart. Stand sealed. Stand strong in the flame. Though Babylon melts, Zion shall shine.

60. And all the earth shall know: Babylon trusted lies, but Zion trusted YHWH.

 Section IV – The Stand of the Remnant (61–75) — Page 4

61. The Ruach said: "Speak comfort to Zion—for the fire has not destroyed her, it has revealed her."

62. O Zion, your garments are washed in flame. Your heart tested like steel. Your name carved in heaven.

63. Do not envy Babylon—her wealth fleeting, her beauty painted, her throne sinking.

64. Lift your eyes, Zion. Your crown is light, not iron. Your inheritance promise, not politics.

65. As it is written in Judah: "Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of YHWH is risen upon thee." (Isa. 60:1–2)

66. As it is written in Joseph: "Blessed are they who seek to bring forth my Zion... for they shall have the gift and power of the Holy Ghost." (1 Nephi 13:37)

67. Therefore, O Zion, stand strong in the fire. Let flame consume fear, but not faith. Let it burn sin, but not song.

68. For I, YHWH, am with you in the furnace. My Son walks beside you, as with the three in Babylon's fire.

69. Nations will marvel: "Did we not cast Zion down? And yet she rises unharmed?"

70. And it shall be said: "This is the remnant sealed by YHWH, the bride refined for her King."

71. O Zion, sing in the fire. Do not weep as forsaken. The flame is your anointing, the blaze your crown.

72. Babylon collapses in smoke and ash, but Zion shines brighter through trial.

73. This is the separation: the harlot burned, the bride purified. The wicked scattered, the righteous sealed.

74. Fear not, O Zion. The day of Babylon's fall is your rising.

75. Stand strong. Stand sealed. Stand as fire and light. For I, YHWH, have spoken: Zion shall endure, and Babylon shall be no more.

2. Presidents bow to merchants. Pastors bow to money. Bishops bow to power. Their lips move, but the moneychangers write their speeches.
3. They gather in councils of government. They gather in conferences of churches. They speak of peace, prosperity, and unity. But their unity is against Me.
4. As it is written in Judah: “Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against YHWH, and against his anointed.” (Psalm 2:1–2)
5. And as it is written in Joseph: “They have taken away from the gospel of the Lamb many parts which are plain and most precious; and also many covenants of the Lord have they taken away.” (1 Nephi 13:26)
6. The Father says: “Look at America—her leaders speak of democracy, but her laws are bought and sold. Look at her churches—her pastors preach blessings, but sell covenants for tithes.”
7. One party cries justice while plotting control. The other cries freedom while kissing greed. One preacher cries prosperity while lusting for fame. Another cries holiness while binding men with man-made chains.
8. Both drink from the same cup. Their poison is poured out on the people.
9. Workers say, “Things will get better if we labor harder, elect better leaders, support better pastors.” But I say: “You labor for wind. You hope for dust. Babylon cannot heal.”
10. As it is written in Judah: “They have healed the hurt of the daughter of my people slightly, saying, Peace, peace; when there is no peace.” (Jeremiah 6:14)

11. And again in Joseph: “That great and abominable church... blindeth the eyes and hardeneth the hearts of the children of men.” (1 Nephi 13:27)

12. You rise early, work late, give offerings, cast votes, shout amens, and believe the system will bless you. But her wages are chains, her promises are lies, her blessings are bondage.

13. Babylon is falling while you hope she is rising. Her towers are cracking while you cling to her walls. Her leaders laugh while her people drown.

14. The Father says: “I did not call you to be slaves of systems. I called you to be heirs of the Kingdom. Stand up, O Zion.”

15. You are Zion, though you sit in churches. You are Zion, though you labor in Babylon’s fields. You are Zion, though you think yourself Gentile. I called you from the beginning, and I will not lose you.

Section II – Pleasure and Sin (16–35) — Page 2

16. I see the streets, the clubs, the homes filled with laughter not unto Me, but unto sin. I see fornication sponsored by Babylon, rebellion celebrated by her merchants, disobedience broadcast on her screens.

17. They say, “Life is short—enjoy it.” But I say: “Life is holy—guard it.” For those who sow corruption shall reap destruction.

18. As it is written in Judah: “Be not deceived: God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.” (Galatians 6:7)

19. And as it is written in Joseph: “Wo be unto him that hearkeneth unto the precepts of men, and denieth the power of God... Wo be unto the Gentiles, saith the Lord God of Hosts, for notwithstanding I shall lengthen out mine arm unto them from day to day, they will deny me.” (2 Nephi 28:26, 32)

20. Babylon says, "Do as thou wilt." But I, YHWH, say: "Do as I command." For My commands are life, and her pleasures are poison.

21. Those who lie with her will fall with her. Those who defend her will be judged with her. Those who delight in her sins will drink of her cup.

22. She will be broken, and all who hold her hand will be broken with her.

23. The Father says: "Come out of her, My people. Leave the pews of falsehood, the jobs that enslave, the pleasures that defile. For her plagues are near, and her destruction sure."

24. I call you into covenant. Into water and Spirit. Into baptism and fire. Into sealing that no man can undo.

25. For I am not offering you politics, wages, or empty sermons. I am offering you life eternal, peace unshakable, and a Kingdom that cannot be moved.

26. You trust in governments that lie, in pastors that flatter, in entertainers that distract, in wealth that rots. But none of these can save you when the fire falls.

27. As it is written in Judah: "The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and YHWH alone shall be exalted in that day." (Isaiah 2:11)

28. And as it is written in Joseph: "For the time speedily shall come that all churches which are built up to get gain, and all those who are built up to get power over the flesh, and those who are built up to become popular in the eyes of the world, must be brought low in the dust." (1 Nephi 22:23)

29. The Father says: "Babylon cannot stand. Her foundation is fraud. Her roof is pride. Her walls are lies. Her merchants are thieves. Her preachers are actors. Her rulers are traitors."

30. You see her strength in her armies, but I see their fear. You see her glory in her markets, but I see their collapse. You see her beauty in her cities, but I see smoke.

31. Babylon sponsors fornication, celebrates perversion, legalizes abomination, and calls it progress. She breaks every commandment and boasts of it.

32. Therefore, her judgment is not delayed. Her destruction is not far. For as she has corrupted the earth, so shall the earth vomit her out.

33. As it is written in Judah: “Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit.” (Revelation 18:2)

34. And as it is written in Joseph: “That great pit, which hath been digged for them by that great and abominable church... shall be filled by those who digged it, unto their utter destruction.” (1 Nephi 14:3)

35. The Father says: “Hidden Zion, do not be afraid of Babylon’s fall. Be afraid of being found in her when she falls. For all who cling to her shall be consumed with her.”

Section III – The Final Call (36–73) — Page 3

36. I see you in the churches, hoping your preacher is right. I see you in the streets, hoping your hustle will save you. I see you in your homes, hoping tomorrow will be brighter. But I tell you: tomorrow will burn brighter—with fire.

37. Come out, O Zion. Come out of false religion, false politics, false hope, false pleasure. Come into covenant.

38. For My Son has paid the price. His blood is the seal. His Spirit is the witness. His baptism is the gate.

39. And I, the Father, say unto you: "Choose now. For Babylon is falling, and My Kingdom is rising."

40. Stand not with the nations. Stand not with the harlot. Stand not with the scoffers. Stand with Me. Stand with Zion. Stand with Christ.

41. The Father says: "All who take pleasure in Babylon's sins shall drink her plagues. All who laugh with her shall weep with her. All who defend her shall fall with her."

42. For she has seduced nations with entertainment, enslaved them with money, deceived them with politics, and blinded them with religion.

43. You cannot hold her hand and hold My covenant. You cannot sleep in her bed and stand in My temple. You cannot drink her wine and drink My cup.

44. As it is written in Judah: "Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils." (1 Cor. 10:21)

45. And as it is written in Joseph: "That great and abominable church... shall tumble to the dust, and great shall be the fall of it." (2 Nephi 28:18)

46. Babylon throws festivals for sin. She parades rebellion in the streets. She brands lust as freedom, greed as success, violence as strength.

47. She crowns athletes and artists as gods, gives them stages, gives them worship, while the poor starve and the righteous are mocked.

48. And the people cheer, not knowing they are clapping for their own chains.

49. The Father says: "This is the generation that celebrates what I hate and hates what I love. This is the people who call darkness light and light darkness."

50. As it is written in Judah: “Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness.” (Isaiah 5:20)

51. They say, “It is just culture. It is just fun. It is just freedom.” But I tell you: “It is sin, and sin brings death.”

52. Your agreements with Babylon are written in heaven. Your secret lusts are not hidden from Me. Your excuses cannot save you.

53. As it is written in Joseph: “And others will he pacify, and lull them away into carnal security... and thus the devil cheateth their souls, and leadeth them away carefully down to hell.” (2 Nephi 28:21)

54. The Father says: “You think you are safe because judgment has not yet struck your house. But I warn you—the cup is already poured. The fire is already lit. The sword is already drawn.”

55. Therefore repent. Repent, O hidden Zion. Repent in the streets, in the churches, in the workplaces, in the homes. Repent before the flame consumes.

56. For I do not desire your destruction. I desire your cleansing. I do not desire your death. I desire your life.

57. My Son did not shed His blood to watch you perish with Babylon. He shed it to seal you for My Kingdom.

58. Come out of agreement with Babylon. Break her contracts. Reject her pleasures. Forsake her false prophets.

59. Come into agreement with Me. Accept My covenant. Walk in My commands. Receive My Spirit.

60. For I, the Father, have declared: “Babylon shall be broken without remedy. But Zion shall be sealed forever.”

61. The Father says: "Do not pray for Babylon's healing, for her wound is incurable. Do not wait for her recovery, for her end is sealed."

62. As it is written in Judah: "We would have healed Babylon, but she is not healed: forsake her... for her judgment reacheth unto heaven." (Jer. 51:9)

63. And as it is written in Joseph: "That great and abominable church... shall war against the Lamb of God; and the power of the Lamb shall descend upon the saints, and they shall be armed with righteousness." (1 Nephi 14:13-14)

64. Hidden Zion, you are not called to fix Babylon. You are called to flee her, to resist her, to overcome her.

65. Her entertainment blinds you. Her pleasures bind you. Her politics deceive you. Her churches numb you.

66. Come out while the door of mercy is still open. For soon the door will close, and only the sealed shall stand.

67. As it is written in Judah: "Seek ye YHWH while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near." (Isaiah 55:6)

68. And as it is written in Joseph: "For the gate by which ye should enter is repentance and baptism by water... and then cometh a remission of your sins by fire and by the Holy Ghost." (2 Nephi 31:17)

69. This is the way. Not politics. Not pulpits. Not pleasure. Not power. But repentance, baptism, sealing.

83. As it is written in Judah: "There shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring." (Luke 21:25)

84. And as it is written in Joseph: "The earth shall be drunken with iniquity; and because of iniquity, she shall stagger." (Ether 13:21)

85. These are not accidents. They are alarms. These are not random. They are reminders. These are not coincidences. They are covenant warnings.

94. And as it is written in Joseph: “For the kingdom of the devil must shake, and they which belong to it must needs be stirred up unto repentance, or the devil will grasp them with his everlasting chains.” (2 Nephi 28:19)

95. Babylon’s palaces will burn. Her towers will fall. Her cities will flood. Her markets will vanish. Her idols will crumble.

96. I, YHWH, declare: “She shall not rise again. Her crown is shattered. Her throne is overturned. Her name shall be cursed among the nations.”
