

 THE SCROLL OF THE PASSOVER

— THE RESET OF TIME, THE LAMB, AND THE FINAL CALL —

In the beginning, the lights were set in the firmament, not for decoration, but for dominion over time.

The sun to rule the day, and the moon to mark the appointed times.

3

And the Most High established His calendar before man built his own.

4

For His order is perfect, and His times are not subject to alteration.

5

But man, in his pride, departed from the order and established his own reckoning.

6

Yet in the days of bondage, when Israel groaned under oppression, the Most High spoke again.

7

Not first of deliverance, but of time.

8

Saying: This month shall be unto you the beginning of months.

9

The first of months shall it be unto you.

10

Thus He reset the clock before He revealed the Lamb.

11

For deliverance cannot come outside of alignment.

12

And salvation does not move without order.

13

He established the month, that the day might be known.

14

He revealed the day, that the Lamb might be chosen.

15

And He commanded the Lamb, that the blood might speak.

16

Take a Lamb according to your houses, a Lamb for a house.

17

A male without blemish, chosen and set apart.

18

Kept under watch until the appointed day.

19

Not slain in haste, but held in obedience.

20

For the Lamb must align with the time.

21

And it came to pass on the fourteenth day at even.

22

That the Lamb was slain according to command.

23

And the blood was taken and placed upon the doorposts.

24

A sign not for man, but for judgment.

25

For when the Most High passed through, He looked for the blood.

26

Where the blood was found, death could not enter.

27

Where the blood was absent, judgment stood at the door.

28

Thus the night was divided, not by chance, but by covenant.

29

For the blood marked those who obeyed the appointed time.

30

And the Lamb testified against those who did not.

31

Eat it in haste, with loins girded and staff in hand.

32

For deliverance does not wait for comfort.

33

It comes swiftly to those aligned.

34

And it passes over those covered.

35

Thus was the first Passover established in the earth.

36

Yet this was not the beginning, but the shadow of what was written before.

37

For the Lamb was prepared from the foundation of the world.

38

And the pattern was known in the heavens before it was seen among men.

39

The sacrifice was not reaction, but design.

40

And the blood was not surprise, but decree.

41

Then came the fullness of time.

42

Not a day early, nor a moment delayed.

43

For the same order that spoke in Egypt spoke again in the earth.

44

And the Lamb walked among men.

45

Behold the Lamb, without blemish.

46

Examined and found without fault.

47

Watched as the Lamb was watched.

48

Set apart as the Lamb was set apart.

49

For the pattern could not be broken.

50

It had to be fulfilled.

51

And at the appointed time, He was given.

52

Not when men chose, but when heaven declared.

53

And His blood was shed, not for a door of wood, but for the hearts of men.

54

And judgment passed over those covered by His sacrifice.

55

Thus the Lamb was fulfilled, and the testimony completed.

Yet though the Lamb was remembered, the time was forgotten.

57

Men spoke of the blood, but neglected the order.

58

They honored the sacrifice, but changed the clock.

59

They kept traditions, but lost alignment.

60

And in doing so, they broke the pattern.

61

For Passover is not only what is remembered, but when it is remembered.

62

And the appointed time cannot be moved by the will of man.

63

The heavens still declare the day.

64

The moon still marks the count.

65

And the pattern remains unchanged.

66

But who has eyes to see the light?

67

And who has understanding to observe?

68

For the witness has not ceased, but men have ceased to look.

69

They follow calendars of their own making.

70

And call it truth.

71

Yet the Most High has not altered His order.

72

What He set in the beginning still stands.

73

The appointed times remain.

74

The rhythm of heaven continues.

75

And the call goes forth again.

76

Return to the beginning of months.

77

Return to the appointed day.

78

Return to the Lamb and the time of His sacrifice.

79

For the pattern is not new, but ancient.

80

And the witness is not hidden, but revealed.

81

The heavens testify.

82

The earth confirms.

83

And the record stands in both witnesses.

84

The law and the testimony agree.

85

And there is no light in any path that departs from it.

86

Therefore mark the day.

87

Prepare your household.

88

Align with the appointed time.

89

For the Lamb has already been given.

90

And the covering has already been made.

91

But the door will not remain open forever.

92

And the call will not sound without end.

93

For as it was in Egypt, so shall it be again.

94

A separation will be made.

95

And the difference will be seen.

96

Between those who align and those who refuse.

97

Between those covered and those uncovered.

98

Between those who keep the appointed time and those who reject it.

99

And the judgment will not be delayed.

100

For the Passover belongs to the Most High, and His order shall stand forever.
