(Romans 9:28 opened in fire – 50 forged verses)

1. For it is written: He will finish the work, and cut it short in righteousness; for a short work will the Lord make upon the earth.
2. The Almighty speaks once, yea twice, and it is established without delay.
3. He hastens His word to perform it, for He is not slack concerning His promise.
4. As He spoke in the beginning, saying, Let there be light, and it was so, even so in the end He speaks and it comes swiftly to pass.
5. The word runs very swiftly, accomplishing the purpose for which it is sent.
6. The Lord will rise quickly to plead the cause of Zion.

7. He shall cut off the oppressor in a moment, and the destroyer shall vanish like smoke.
8. The swift work is not man's doing, but the hand of Elohim.
9. Though the nations rage and the peoples imagine a vain thing, yet He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh, for His decree stands fast.
10. The quick work is a fire that cannot be quenched, consuming the chaff in one day.
11. The prophets saw it afar off, a day burning like an oven, hastened at the word of the Lord.
12. Isaiah cried, saying: A remnant shall be saved, for He will finish the work in righteousness.
13. Habakkuk testified: Though it tarry, wait for it, for it will surely come, it will not tarry.
14. For the Lord shall suddenly come to His temple, and who shall abide the day of His coming?
15. He shall sit as a refiner and purifier of silver, and purify the sons of Levi in a short season.
16. The time is shortened that the holy offering may be made acceptable.
17. The harvest is ripe, and He thrusts in His sickle without delay.
18. As lightning shines from the east unto the west, so shall the coming of the Son of Man be.
19. The Lord makes speed to deliver, for His arm is not shortened that it cannot save.
20. He hastens to gather the elect from the four winds of heaven.

21. His word runs through the earth as a swift arrow, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit.

22. The mountains quake at His voice, and the earth trembles at His command.

23. The quick work is mercy to the righteous, but terror to the ungodly.

24. For the Lord will arise to cut short the boasting of the proud.

25. In one hour Babylon shall fall, and her merchants shall weep.

26. In one day her plagues shall come, for the short work shall be accomplished.

27. The vine of the earth shall be reaped in haste, cast into the winepress of wrath.

28. Yet the vine of the Lord shall be gathered quickly into His barns.

29. The remnant shall be preserved by a swift salvation.

30. For the Lord shall make bare His holy arm in the sight of all nations.

31. The ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God in a moment.

32. He will cut off the adversary like grass, and wither him in a single breath.

33. The morning comes swiftly, though the night seemed long.

34. The sun shall not tarry in its rising, nor the moon in its shining.

35. The Lord shortens the time, for the cry of the righteous is heard.

36. The widow and the fatherless shall see His salvation quickly.
37. The poor and needy shall be satisfied suddenly, for the Shepherd hastens to feed His flock.
38. The watchmen cry: The day is at hand, it will not delay.
39. The scribe declares: The vision hastens to fulfillment, it shall not tarry.
40. The king proclaims: The decree is sealed, it shall be done swiftly.
41. Behold, He comes quickly, and His reward is with Him.
42. The Judge stands at the door, even at the door.
43. The quick work shall astonish the nations, for they shall say: Who hath done this so suddenly?
44. The Lord of hosts hath purposed it, and who shall disannul it?
45. His hand is stretched out in haste, and who shall turn it back?
46. He cuts short the season, for the sake of His chosen remnant.
47. The end is nearer than when we believed, for the short work hastens on.
48. Awake, ye sleepers, for the hour is come!
49. Arise, ye righteous, for your redemption draweth nigh!

50. The short work is sealed in righteousness, and none can hinder it.

 Section 2: The Days Shortened for the Elect
(Matthew 24:22 anchored – 50 forged verses)

51. And the Master declared: Except those days should be shortened, no flesh should be saved; but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.

52. Behold the mercy of God, who remembers His chosen in the midst of tribulation.

53. For the days of vengeance are terrible, yet they are cut short for the saints.

54. The storm shall not rage forever, but be restrained for the sake of the faithful.

55. As a father spares his children, so the Lord shortens the time for His elect.

56. The enemy seeks to wear out the saints, but the Lord breaks his hand in a moment.

57. The oppressor imagines a long dominion, yet his rule is cut short.

58. The dragon rages knowing he hath but a short time.

59. The woman is given wings to flee into the wilderness, nourished for a season, but the season is shortened.

60. For the sake of Zion, the appointed days are hastened to their end.

61. The saints cry day and night, and God answers speedily.
62. Shall not God avenge His elect, which cry unto Him? Yea, He will avenge them quickly.
63. The time of Jacob's trouble is shortened, that Jacob may be delivered.
64. The hour of temptation comes upon the whole world, yet the faithful are preserved.
65. The Lord shortens the shadow of death, that light may arise upon His people.
66. He shortens the captivity, that freedom may spring forth.
67. He shortens the labor, that the birth may come swiftly.
68. He shortens the furnace, lest the gold be consumed.
69. He shortens the night, that the morning may break forth.
70. The cry goes out at midnight, but the Bridegroom comes quickly.
71. Blessed are they whose lamps are trimmed, for the delay is cut short.
72. The cry of the martyrs is not ignored, but their blood hastens the end.
73. The kings of the earth cannot prolong their thrones, for the days are numbered.
74. The beast cannot lengthen his dominion, for his time is short.

75. The false prophet cannot deceive forever, for the season is curtailed.
76. The Lord draws a line which none can cross, a boundary of mercy.
77. Though the days be evil, they are few for the sake of the righteous.
78. As in the days of Noah, the end came suddenly, and so it shall be again.
79. As in the days of Lot, judgment fell swiftly, and so shall it be in the last time.
80. The righteous escaped, yet the season was shortened for their sakes.
81. The Lord sets His watch, that the appointed time be not prolonged.
82. He who made the sun stand still for Joshua can shorten the days for His saints.
83. He who turned back the shadow on the sundial can hasten the time for the elect.
84. Time itself is in His hand, and He bends it for the sake of His chosen.
85. The wicked say: Where is the promise of His coming?
86. But the righteous know: He is not slack, but patient; yet the days are shortened.
87. The Lord delays not beyond the appointed hour, for the elect must be preserved.
88. The saints shall not all sleep, but shall be changed in a moment.
89. In the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump, the shortened time shall end.

90. The dead shall be raised incorruptible, and the living caught up.

91. The shortened days lead swiftly to the eternal day.

92. For night shall be no more, nor need of sun or moon.

93. The Lamb is the light thereof, shining without end.

94. The shortened days are mercy, that flesh may yet be saved.

100. For He who shall come will come, and will not tarry.

 Section 3: The Vineyard Hastens to Harvest
(Jacob 5 anchored – 50 forged verses)

101. And the Lord of the vineyard spake: This is the last time that I shall nourish my vineyard, for the end is nigh at hand, and the season speedily cometh.

102. He called His servants, saying: Go to, and labor diligently with your might.

103. For the tree must bring forth fruit quickly, lest it be hewn down and cast into the fire.

104. The vineyard is vast, yet the time is short.

105. The branches are many, yet the season hastens to its close.

106. The Lord of the vineyard weeps, saying: What more could I have done for my vineyard?

107. I have nourished and pruned, digged and dunged it, yet the end cometh speedily.

108. For the natural branches must be grafted again, and the wild branches must be burned.

109. The season of patience is past; the season of harvest is at hand.

110. Behold, the last pruning is upon the trees.

111. The ax is laid at the root, and every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down.

112. The faithful branches bud forth quickly, for the Husbandman hastens the growth.

113. The rain descends in its season, and the fruit swells without delay.

114. The sun shines hot, ripening the harvest before its time.

115. The Lord hastens the increase, that the barn may be filled.

116. For He hath sworn, saying: The labor shall not be in vain.

117. Though the vineyard was left desolate for a season, yet the end is redemption.

118. The scattered branches are gathered quickly into one.

119. The divided roots are bound together in haste.

120. The grafting is made sure, that the tree may flourish in the last hour.

121. The servants cry: Behold, the work is great, and the time is short.

122. Yet the Master answers: Fear not, for my arm is stretched out still.

123. The vineyard groans, but the fruit shall appear suddenly.

124. The clusters swell heavy, ready for the winepress.

125. The Master hastens, for the cup of the covenant must be filled.

126. The vineyard hastens, for the season cannot be prolonged.

127. The roots thirst, and the waters flow speedily from the fountain.

128. The leaves wither, but the fruit is preserved.

129. The tares are gathered, but the wheat is secured.

130. The watchmen cry upon the walls: The day of harvest is near!

131. The prophets declare: The summer is ended, the harvest is past, yet the Lord hastens deliverance.

132. The righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father.

133. For the wheat is gathered into His garner without delay.

134. And the chaff is consumed with unquenchable fire.

135. The vineyard hastens, for the Lord Himself treads the winepress.

136. He gathers the grapes swiftly, filling the vats with judgment.

137. The wine of the wicked is wrath, but the wine of the righteous is joy.

138. The vineyard hastens to its appointed end, that all prophecy may be fulfilled.

139. The remnant is grafted in quickly, that no promise fail.

140. The faithful branches blossom suddenly, as lilies in the desert.

141. The wild branches wither in an instant, consumed by the heat.

142. The Lord hastens His vineyard, for He will not lose His fruit.

143. The field is white already to harvest, therefore thrust in the sickle.

144. The reapers gather swiftly, binding the sheaves for the kingdom.

145. The vineyard hastens, for the Lord of the harvest is at the door.

146. The angels fly swiftly, gathering the elect into the barn.

147. The servants labor diligently, though the season be short.

148. The vineyard hastens, for the Master will soon return.

149. The quick work is seen in the ripening of the fruit.

150. And the vineyard shall be preserved in the last hour, saith the Lord of the harvest.

157. Zechariah saw the fountain opened in Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness, quickly cleansing the house of David.

158. Malachi warned: The Lord whom ye seek shall suddenly come to His temple.

159. Nephi testified: The Lord will not suffer that the Gentiles forever remain in unbelief, but a short work shall He make among them.

160. Alma cried: This life is the time to prepare to meet God... do not procrastinate the day of your repentance.

161. Helaman saw that the judgments of God come speedily upon the unrepentant.

162. Samuel the Lamanite cried: Repent and prepare, for the day of the Lord is at hand, and it shall come quickly.

163. Moroni testified: The Lord worketh not in secret combinations, but His work is plain, and He hastens His righteousness.

164. The sealed record declares: The great and abominable church shall fall suddenly in one hour.

165. Again it speaks: The saints shall be preserved, for the Lord hastens the sealing of His chosen.

166. The prophets and apostles are united, declaring one voice: the end is shortened.

167. The testimony is sure, for the Spirit bears witness with their words.

168. The quick work is a stone cut without hands, smiting the kingdoms of the world suddenly.

169. The quick work is a fire shut up in the bones of the prophets, released in the last days.

170. The quick work is a trumpet sounding long, but ending in a sudden blast.

171. Isaiah saw the Lord rising up quickly, as in Mount Perazim, to do His strange work.

172. He spoke of a short harvest, where the reaper treads the grapes at once.

173. Ezekiel measured the temple swiftly, for the pattern was already determined.

174. Jeremiah wrote the roll of lamentation, yet the word ran very swiftly.

175. Amos cried: Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper.

176. Micah spoke: The breaker is come up before them... their king shall pass before them, and the Lord on the head of them.

177. Zephaniah warned: The great day of the Lord is near, it is near, and hasteth greatly.

178. Paul affirmed: The Lord will make a short work upon the earth.

179. Peter declared: The end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer.

180. John bore record: Behold, I come quickly, and my reward is with me.

181. Nephi echoed: The Lord remembereth His covenant, and He will not suffer His word to be delayed.

182. Jacob taught: The time passed away with us, and our lives were as a dream... behold, the time soon cometh.

183. Mosiah's people trembled, for the judgments of God were swift to awaken them.

184. Alma warned: The Spirit of the Lord will not always strive with man; if ye harden your hearts, the time is cut short.

185. Ether prophesied: This land shall be a land of liberty, if it serves God; if not, destruction cometh quickly.

186. Mormon testified: Behold, the time is at hand when the sword of justice hangs over this people; it shall fall speedily.

187. Moroni sealed up the record, saying: I speak unto you as though ye were present, for the time is nigh.

188. The sealed words declare: The cup is full, and the Lord hastens His strange act.

189. Again it says: The nations shall marvel, for the Lord will make a quick work in the earth.

190. The prophets were not divided, but all pointed to this sudden conclusion.

191. For the testimony of Christ is the spirit of prophecy, and all prophecy testifies of Him.

192. The time is shortened, that His mercy may be magnified.

193. The time is shortened, that His judgment may be fulfilled.

194. The time is shortened, that His promises may be kept.

195. Blessed are they who believe the prophets, for they shall not be overtaken as a thief.

196. Blessed are they who watch, for the day shall not surprise them as a snare.

197. Blessed are they who heed, for the word shall be accomplished swiftly in them.

198. The prophets foresaw the day, rejoiced in it, and bore record of its quickness.

199. Their voices cry still: The end hastens, make ready the way of the Lord.

200. For He comes quickly, and His word shall not be delayed any longer.

(Endurance and preservation of the elect – 50 forged verses)

201. Fear not, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

203. For the Lord knoweth them that are His, and He delivers them speedily.

204. The righteous are not appointed unto wrath, but to obtain salvation.

205. The elect cry day and night, and God answers them quickly.

207. The saints are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation.

208. Though the times are perilous, the Spirit strengthens the faithful.

209. Though the tribulation is fierce, the days are cut short for their sakes.

210. Blessed are they who endure to the end, for they shall be saved.

211. The righteous shall shine as the brightness of the firmament.

212. And they that turn many to righteousness, as the stars forever and ever.

213. The elect are written in the book of life, and no man can blot them out.

214. The name of Christ is upon their foreheads, a seal unbroken.

215. Though the nations rage, the saints stand unshaken.

216. Though kingdoms fall, the covenant stands sure.

217. For the Lord is a wall of fire round about His people.

218. And the glory of the Lord is in the midst of Zion.

219. The saints overcome by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony.

220. And they love not their lives unto the death.

221. Therefore the dragon is overcome, and the saints are preserved.

222. The Spirit intercedes, sustaining them in weakness.

223. The angels encamp round about them that fear the Lord.

224. The watchers guard the gates, that the enemy enter not.

225. The elect are hidden in the secret place of the Most High.

226. They abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

227. No plague shall come near their dwelling, for the covenant protects them.

228. The shortened days are a hedge around them, lest they be consumed.

229. The times are measured for their survival, not their destruction.

230. For the Lord remembers mercy in wrath.

231. He remembers covenant in judgment.

232. He remembers His saints in tribulation.

233. The prayers of the righteous ascend like incense, hastening deliverance.

234. The tears of the saints are bottled before God, each drop remembered.

235. Their suffering is not wasted, but accounted unto glory.

236. The fiery trial is shortened, that the faith may be refined.

242. As Israel passed quickly through the Red Sea, so the saints pass through tribulation.

243. As the three were delivered from the furnace, so the faithful are preserved.

244. As Daniel was spared in the den, so the elect are secured.

245. The testimony of the saints is sure, for God is faithful.

246. He who called them is able to keep them from falling.

247. The Holy One is their refuge and their strength, a very present help in trouble.

248. Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed.

249. The saints are preserved in the shortened season, for the covenant cannot fail.

250. And when the days are fulfilled, they shall inherit everlasting joy.

 Section 6: The End Hastens Unto the Marriage Supper
(The quick work fulfilled – 50 forged verses)

251. Behold, I come quickly, and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.

260. Then we which are alive and remain are caught up together with them.

261. The quick work is complete, and the saints are gathered.

262. The shortened days are ended, swallowed up in eternal day.

263. The night is past; the morning without clouds is come.

264. The Lord reigns, clothed in majesty, His kingdom established forever.

265. The nations bring their glory into the holy city.

266. The gates are never shut, for there is no more night.

267. The Lamb is the light thereof, shining without end.

268. The river of life flows from the throne, clear as crystal.

269. On either side grows the tree of life, bearing fruit every month.

270. The leaves are for the healing of the nations, given freely.

271. No curse remains, for the quick work has cut it short.

272. The throne of God and of the Lamb is in it.

273. His servants serve Him and see His face.

274. His name is in their foreheads, sealed forever.

275. There shall be no more curse, for the covenant is fulfilled.

276. There shall be no more sorrow, for God wipes away all tears.

277. There shall be no more death, for mortality is swallowed in victory.

278. The quick work ushers in everlasting joy.

279. The shortened days open into eternal ages.

280. The saints rejoice with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

290. The four living creatures cry: Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty.

291. The twenty-four elders cast their crowns before the throne.

292. The angels rejoice, for the quick work is complete.

293. The saints rejoice, for the shortened days are fulfilled.

294. Creation itself rejoices, delivered from corruption into liberty.

295. The heavens and the earth are joined as one.

296. The covenant is perfected, the kingdom revealed.

297. The Lamb that was slain reigns forever and ever.

298. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, without end.
