The Promise of the Comforter (Verses 1–50)

1. And the Comforter, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father sends in the name of the Son, shall teach the humble all things, and shall bring to remembrance the words spoken from the beginning.
2. And the Spirit of Truth shall guide the remnant into all truth, and shall not speak of Himself, but whatsoever He heareth of the Father and the Son, that shall He declare, and He shall shew things to come.
3. For the anointing abideth in the elect, and ye need not that any man teach you; for the same Spirit teacheth concerning all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as He hath taught you, ye shall abide in Christ.
4. And when ye are brought before kings and rulers for My name's sake, take no thought beforehand what ye shall answer, for the Spirit shall teach you in the same hour what ye ought to say.
5. The Spirit also helpeth your infirmities, for ye know not what ye should pray for as ye ought, but the Spirit Himself maketh intercession with groanings which cannot be uttered.
6. And the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God, and revealeth them unto the meek that walk in covenant.
7. For eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither hath entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love Him, but the Spirit revealeth them freely.

8. And ye shall be sanctified by the reception of the Holy Ghost, that ye may stand spotless before Christ at the last day.

9. By the power of the Holy Ghost ye may know the truth of all things, and no lie shall deceive you.

10. And the Holy Ghost beareth record of the Father and the Son, and all things that are written in the Book of Life.

11. Angels speak by the power of the Holy Ghost, and therefore they speak the words of Christ, and the words of Christ shall tell you all things what ye should do.

12. And if ye will enter in by the way, and receive the Holy Ghost, He shall show unto you all things what ye should do, and none shall pluck you from the path.

13. For the Spirit is given unto every man to profit withal, that all may be instructed of God.

14. And the Spirit testifieth not of Himself, but glorifieth the Son, and sealeth His words in the hearts of the faithful.

15. And as the wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof but canst not tell whence it cometh or whither it goeth, so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

16. For the Spirit quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing; the words of Christ are Spirit, and they are life.

17. And ye shall be taught line upon line, precept upon precept, here a little and there a little, until remembrance is restored in full.

18. And the Spirit shall recall the covenant spoken unto Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, that their seed shall be a light unto the nations.

19. And the Spirit shall recall the voice spoken at the waters of baptism, that ye are the children of Christ, His sons and His daughters.

20. And the Spirit shall recall the law written upon the tables of the heart, that ye may walk in newness of life.

21. For the letter killeth, but the Spirit giveth life, and this life is the remembrance of the Son.

22. And the Spirit shall whisper peace unto your mind, and testify of the Father's will in all things.

23. And He shall open the scriptures unto you, that ye may understand what hath been written from the foundation of the world.

24. The Spirit shall bring to mind the prophets, that their words may be fulfilled in you, even in these last days.

25. And He shall cause the remnant to remember Zion, and to seek her redemption with songs of deliverance.

26. The Spirit shall remind you of the day of your baptism, that your garments were made clean through the blood of the Lamb.

27. And He shall recall the covenant prayer spoken in secret, that the Father hath heard and shall answer openly.

28. And the Spirit shall bring forth the remembrance of the Supper of the Lord, that ye may not forget His body and His blood.

29. And He shall bring again to remembrance the law of fasting and prayer, that ye faint not in the wilderness.

30. And the Spirit shall cause you to remember the poor, the widow, and the fatherless, that mercy may not depart from you.

31. And He shall bring to remembrance the words spoken upon Mount Sinai, that the fear of God may remain before you.

32. And the Spirit shall remind you of the voice at Jordan, saying, This is My beloved Son, hear ye Him.

33. And He shall bring to remembrance the still small voice that burned within your heart, testifying that the record is true.

34. And the Spirit shall recall the visions of the prophets, confirming the things which must shortly come to pass.

35. And He shall remind you of the words spoken in parables, unfolding their meaning by the light of truth.

36. And the Spirit shall bring to remembrance the promises made to the fathers, that their seed shall not be forsaken.

37. And He shall remind you of the resurrection, that Christ rose again the third day according to the scriptures.

38. And the Spirit shall recall the words of comfort spoken in your trials, strengthening your feeble knees.

39. And He shall remind you of the oath and covenant of the priesthood, that it is eternal as the Father is eternal.

40. And the Spirit shall recall the law of consecration, that ye may remember the poor and build up Zion.

41. And He shall remind you of the songs of deliverance sung by Israel at the Red Sea.

42. And the Spirit shall bring to remembrance the fire that fell at Pentecost, filling the house with glory.

43. And He shall remind you of the day of your sealing, when your name was written among the remnant.

44. And the Spirit shall recall the promises spoken in dreams, that the visions of the night may be understood.

45. And He shall remind you of the covenant made in secret places, that your steps may not slip.

46. And the Spirit shall bring to remembrance the miracles wrought by faith, confirming that Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

47. And He shall recall the warnings spoken by watchmen, that ye may escape the snare of the fowler.

48. And the Spirit shall remind you of the law of charity, that without it ye are nothing.

49. And He shall bring to remembrance the sacrifice of the Lamb, that your hearts be broken and your spirits contrite.

50. And the Spirit shall recall the word of prophecy spoken upon the mount, that in the last days the house of the Lord shall be established in the tops of the mountains.

The Scroll of the Spirit's Remembrance

The Spirit of Truth Guides (Verses 51–100)

51. And the Spirit shall lead you in paths of righteousness for His name's sake, turning you not to the right hand nor to the left.

52. He shall guide you into all truth, removing the veil of ignorance placed by the doctrines of men.

53. The Spirit revealeth the mysteries of the kingdom unto babes and sucklings, hiding them from the wise and prudent.

54. And the Spirit testifieth of Christ continually, bearing witness that He came in the flesh to redeem mankind.

55. He shall guide your feet into the way of peace, that your steps stumble not in darkness.

56. And the Spirit shall guide the hands of the scribe, that the words may be written with fire and sealed for generations.

57. He shall open your understanding, that ye may comprehend the scriptures.

58. And the Spirit shall guide the tongue of the watchman, that the trumpet may give a certain sound.

59. He shall guide your heart when ye are tempted, reminding you of the way of escape prepared before the foundation of the world.

60. And the Spirit shall guide the prayers of the righteous, that they may ascend as incense before the throne.

61. He shall cause you to remember the law of liberty, that Christ hath made you free indeed.

62. And the Spirit shall guide the council of the elders, that the flock of God may be fed with knowledge and understanding.

63. He shall guide the mother in Zion, that her children may be raised in light and truth.

64. And the Spirit shall guide the youth, that they despise not their birthright, but hold fast to the covenant.

65. He shall guide the weary, saying, Stand still and see the salvation of God.

66. And the Spirit shall guide the strong, that their strength fail not in the day of adversity.

67. He shall guide the nations with a rod of iron, breaking in pieces the pride of kings.

68. And the Spirit shall guide the remnant out of captivity, leading them to lands of inheritance prepared of the Father.

69. He shall guide the songs of Zion, that they be filled with joy unspeakable and full of glory.

70. And the Spirit shall guide the builders of the temple, that every stone be laid in holiness.

71. He shall guide the captains of Israel, that their battles be fought in the name of the Most High.

72. And the Spirit shall guide the strangers who join themselves to the Lord, grafting them into the olive tree.

73. He shall guide the prophets, giving them utterance that pierces the heart.

74. And the Spirit shall guide the meek, teaching them to inherit the earth.

75. He shall guide the hungry, filling them with the bread of life.

76. And the Spirit shall guide the thirsty, giving them living water without money and without price.

77. He shall guide the blind, opening their eyes to behold wondrous things out of the law.

78. And the Spirit shall guide the deaf, opening their ears to hear the words of eternal life.

79. He shall guide the lame, saying, Rise, take up thy bed, and walk.

80. And the Spirit shall guide the leper, saying, Be thou clean, and thou shalt be made whole.

81. He shall guide the prisoner, opening the doors and breaking the chains of iron.

82. And the Spirit shall guide the mourner, wiping away tears from every eye.

83. He shall guide the poor, clothing them with righteousness.

84. And the Spirit shall guide the rich, commanding them to lay up treasure in heaven.

85. He shall guide the widow, defending her cause before the unjust judge.

86. And the Spirit shall guide the fatherless, setting them among princes.

87. He shall guide the nations in judgment, separating the sheep from the goats.

88. And the Spirit shall guide the wanderer, bringing him to the Shepherd and Bishop of souls.

89. He shall guide the merchant, that his balances be just and his heart without guile.

90. And the Spirit shall guide the farmer, teaching him in due season to sow and to reap.

91. He shall guide the fisherman, casting the net where the multitude of fish are gathered.

92. And the Spirit shall guide the shepherd, that none of the flock be lost.

93. He shall guide the watchman, that he sleep not in the hour of danger.

94. And the Spirit shall guide the scribe, that he add not to the word, neither diminish from it.

95. He shall guide the teacher, that he speak not his own words, but the words of Christ.

96. And the Spirit shall guide the judge, that his decrees be just and not corrupted.

97. He shall guide the king, that his throne be established in righteousness.

98. And the Spirit shall guide the priest, that his incense be pure before the Lord.

99. He shall guide the prophetess, that her song be as Deborah's, a victory unto Zion.

100. And the Spirit shall guide the remnant, that they remember their God and return unto Him with all their heart.

The Scroll of the Spirit's Remembrance

The Spirit Teaches, Not Man (Verses 101–150)

101. And the anointing abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you, for the same Spirit teacheth concerning all things.

102. The Holy Spirit is truth, and is no lie, and as He hath taught you, ye shall abide in Christ forever.

103. The Spirit teacheth comparing spiritual things with spiritual, that the wisdom of God be known above the wisdom of men.

104. And the Spirit teacheth the meek, opening their understanding without the strife of disputations.

105. The Spirit teacheth the humble, and they grow in grace and in the knowledge of the Lord.

106. He teacheth the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

107. The Spirit teacheth with power, and not with enticing words of man's wisdom.

108. He teacheth the children, confirming to them the love of their Father.

109. The Spirit teacheth the mothers, reminding them of the covenant of life within their wombs.

110. He teacheth the fathers, instructing them to raise their households in truth and light.

111. The Spirit teacheth the shepherds of Israel, that they feed the flock and not themselves.

112. He teacheth the watchmen, that their cry be not of flesh, but of heaven.

113. The Spirit teacheth prophets, giving them utterance that men cannot gainsay nor resist.

114. He teacheth the scribes, sealing their pens with fire that the record be pure.

115. The Spirit teacheth apostles, confirming their testimony with signs following.

116. He teacheth priests, guiding their offering to be acceptable in the courts of heaven.

117. The Spirit teacheth kings, that their rule be in justice and humility.
118. He teacheth judges, that they condemn not the innocent nor acquit the guilty.
119. The Spirit teacheth servants, that they serve as unto Christ and not unto men.
120. He teacheth masters, that they forbear threatening, knowing they also have a Master in heaven.
121. The Spirit teacheth strangers, welcoming them into the covenant household.
122. He teacheth the exiled, reminding them of the land of promise.
123. The Spirit teacheth the prisoner, that his chains are but for a season, but liberty is eternal.
124. He teacheth the free, that they be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.
125. The Spirit teacheth the wise, showing them their wisdom is folly before God.
126. He teacheth the foolish, making them wise unto salvation.
127. The Spirit teacheth the rich, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches.
128. He teacheth the poor, that though they have nothing, yet they possess all things in Christ.
129. The Spirit teacheth the strong, to bear the infirmities of the weak.
130. He teacheth the weak, that His strength is made perfect in their weakness.
131. The Spirit teacheth the mourner, that they are comforted by the God of all consolation.

132. He teacheth the joyful, to give thanks always and in everything.

133. The Spirit teacheth the afflicted, reminding them of the eternal weight of glory to come.

134. He teacheth the healed, that their cleansing is a testimony unto Israel.

135. The Spirit teacheth the sinner, calling him to repentance.

136. He teacheth the penitent, that their sins are remembered no more.

137. The Spirit teacheth the baptized, sealing them with the promise of redemption.

138. He teacheth the sanctified, keeping them spotless before the throne.

139. The Spirit teacheth by dreams, opening the night visions unto understanding.

140. He teacheth by visions, lifting the veil from before the eyes of the seer.

141. The Spirit teacheth by prophecy, confirming the word spoken from the beginning.

142. He teacheth by scripture, unfolding the mysteries hidden in plainness.

143. The Spirit teacheth by remembrance, bringing back the words once spoken.

144. He teacheth by whisper, speaking peace to the troubled soul.

145. The Spirit teacheth by fire, burning away the dross from the heart.

146. He teacheth by water, cleansing the soul unto repentance.

147. The Spirit teacheth by wind, moving unseen yet known by His power.

148. He teacheth by witness, confirming truth in the mouths of two or three.

149. The Spirit teacheth by covenant, reminding Israel of their oath unto the Most High.

150. He teacheth by the law of love, for love is the fulfilling of all commandments.

The Spirit Strengthens in Trial & Prayer (Verses 151–200)

151. And when they deliver you up, take no thought how or what ye shall speak, for the Spirit of your Father shall speak in you.

152. The Spirit shall give you in that same hour what ye shall answer, and none shall gainsay nor resist.

153. He shall make your mouth like a sharp sword, and hide you in the shadow of His hand.

154. The Spirit shall strengthen your feeble knees, and confirm your wavering hearts.

155. He shall be your comforter in the prison cell, your song in the night watches.

156. The Spirit shall remind you of the cross, that your sufferings are not worthy to be compared with the glory to come.

157. He shall bring to remembrance the resurrection, that death hath lost its sting.

158. The Spirit shall intercede with groanings which cannot be uttered, carrying your cries unto the throne.

159. He shall quicken your mortal body, that ye faint not in the day of adversity.

160. The Spirit shall be as oil upon your head, soothing the wounds of affliction.

161. He shall be as fire in your bones, giving you boldness before rulers.

162. The Spirit shall clothe you with power from on high, that ye may be witnesses unto all nations.

163. He shall cause you to remember the covenant of deliverance, that the Red Sea was parted for your fathers.

164. The Spirit shall remind you that lions' mouths were stopped, and the furnace cooled for the faithful.

165. He shall testify that angels encamp around them that fear the Lord.

166. The Spirit shall cause you to stand before giants, declaring that the battle is the Lord's.

167. He shall give strength to the faint, and increase power to them that have no might.

168. The Spirit shall lift up a standard against the enemy when he cometh in like a flood.

169. He shall cause your heart to remember the Psalms, and to sing though chained.

170. The Spirit shall remind you that the Son Himself prayed with strong crying and tears.

171. He shall confirm in you the same Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

172. The Spirit shall bear witness with your spirit, that ye are children of God.

173. He shall help you in prayer, when your tongue cleaveth to the roof of your mouth.

174. The Spirit shall remind you that the Father knoweth what ye need before ye ask.

175. He shall bring to remembrance the promise, that if ye ask, ye shall receive.

176. The Spirit shall strengthen your faith, that ye faint not in waiting.

177. He shall remind you that mountains move by the word of faith.

178. The Spirit shall remind you of Elijah, who prayed earnestly and the heavens obeyed.

179. He shall remind you of Daniel, whose petitions shut the mouths of lions.

180. The Spirit shall remind you of Hannah, whose silent cry brought forth a prophet.

181. He shall remind you of David, whose prayer brought down deliverance from enemies.

182. The Spirit shall remind you of Nephi, who cried unto the Lord and was encircled about in fire.

183. He shall remind you of Alma, who prayed in secret and received joy unspeakable.

184. The Spirit shall remind you of Enos, who wrestled in prayer until he obtained a remission of sins.

185. He shall remind you of the brother of Jared, whose faith moved mountains and brought the Lord down in glory.

186. The Spirit shall teach you to pray always, that ye be not overcome.

187. He shall remind you to pray in the Spirit, building up your most holy faith.

188. The Spirit shall give you utterance in unknown tongues, declaring the wonders of God.

189. He shall cause you to sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, making melody in your heart.

190. The Spirit shall remind you that thanksgiving is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

191. He shall remind you that prayer availeth much when offered fervently.

192. The Spirit shall remind you of Gethsemane, where the Son prayed, "Not My will, but Thine be done."

193. He shall strengthen you with the same submission, to endure the cup appointed unto you.

194. The Spirit shall remind you that angels strengthen those who kneel before the Father.

195. He shall bring to remembrance the deliverance of Peter from prison through the prayers of the saints.

196. The Spirit shall remind you that Paul and Silas prayed, and the foundations of the prison were shaken.

197. He shall remind you of Cornelius, whose prayers and alms came up as a memorial before God.

198. The Spirit shall remind you of John on Patmos, who was in the Spirit on the Lord's day.

199. He shall remind you that prayer without ceasing is the breath of the righteous.

200. The Spirit shall remind you that when ye know not what to pray, the Advocate intercedes at the right hand of God.

The Spirit Seals, Sanctifies, and Writes in the Heart (Verses 201–250)

201. And the Spirit shall sanctify the repentant, cleansing them by fire and by water.

202. He shall seal the names of the faithful in the Lamb's book of life.

203. The Spirit shall write the law upon the inward parts, and engrave it upon the heart.

204. He shall circumcise the heart, that the commandments be kept in love.

205. The Spirit shall sanctify the house of Israel, making them a holy nation.

206. He shall purify the sons of Levi, that their offering be righteous before the Lord.

207. The Spirit shall sanctify the altar, that every sacrifice be acceptable in heaven.

208. He shall seal the covenant made with the fathers, binding it upon the children.

209. The Spirit shall sanctify the garments of the saints, that they be white as snow.

210. He shall seal the foreheads of the servants of God, that destruction pass over them.

211. The Spirit shall sanctify the temple, filling it with glory from above.

212. He shall write the testimony upon the tablets of remembrance, that none forget the covenant.

213. The Spirit shall seal the mouths of prophets, that their words return not void.

214. He shall sanctify the vessels of the sanctuary, that they be holy unto the Lord.

215. The Spirit shall write songs upon the lips of Zion, that her praises never fail.

216. He shall seal the gates of the city, that no unclean thing enter therein.

217. The Spirit shall sanctify the earth, renewing it for the meek.

218. He shall seal the heavens, that they pour out blessings without measure.

219. The Spirit shall write upon the mind, that confusion be scattered.

220. He shall seal the covenant of baptism, that sins be remembered no more.

221. The Spirit shall sanctify the marriage bed, that it be honorable and undefiled.

222. He shall write upon the conscience, that men know good from evil.

223. The Spirit shall seal the remnant with the seal of adoption, crying, Abba, Father.

224. He shall sanctify the offerings of the poor, making them treasures in heaven.

225. The Spirit shall write visions upon the hearts of the seers, that they be plain unto all.

226. He shall seal the promises of resurrection, that none doubt the rising of the just.

227. The Spirit shall sanctify the fast, that it break every yoke.

228. He shall write the words of Christ upon the hearts of children, that their mouths testify of Him.

229. The Spirit shall seal the tribes, numbering them for inheritance.

230. He shall sanctify the Sabbath, making it a delight unto the righteous.

231. The Spirit shall write peace upon the mind, quieting the storm within.

232. He shall seal the covenant of the sacrament, that ye remember His body and His blood.

233. The Spirit shall sanctify the prayer of the penitent, though offered in weakness.

234. He shall write mercy upon the heart, that judgment be tempered with compassion.

235. The Spirit shall seal the law of consecration, that all things be in common among Zion.

236. He shall sanctify the works of faith, crowning them with righteousness.

237. The Spirit shall write holiness upon the bells of the horses, that every work be to the Lord.

238. He shall seal the covenant of tithes, that the storehouse be full.

239. The Spirit shall sanctify the tears of the oppressed, turning them into jewels of glory.

240. He shall write joy upon the soul, that sorrow flee away.

241. The Spirit shall seal the covenant of the endowment, marking the elect with power.

242. He shall sanctify the ordinance of sealing, that families be bound in eternity.

243. The Spirit shall write truth upon the inward parts, making the heart pure before God.

244. He shall seal the covenant of priesthood, that it be without beginning of days or end of years.

245. The Spirit shall sanctify the witness of two or three, that every word be established.

246. He shall write the name of the Father upon the foreheads of the redeemed.

247. The Spirit shall seal the covenant of the new Jerusalem, that she descend in glory.

248. He shall sanctify the nations, bringing them into one fold and one Shepherd.

249. The Spirit shall write eternity upon the hearts of the saints, that they endure to the end.

250. And the Spirit shall seal the final testimony, that Christ is all in all, forever and ever.
