📜 Scroll of the Ensign and the Banner

Part I – The Raising of the Standard

1. Lift up thine eyes, O Zion, for the hour is come: YHWH hath commanded, Raise the Ensign, that the tribes scattered may behold their gathering place.
2. For it is written, “Thou hast given a banner to them that fear thee, that it may be displayed because of the truth.”  
(Psalm 60:4) This banner is not of cloth, but of covenant.

3. And the Stick of Joseph beareth witness: He will lift up an ensign to the nations from far, and they shall come with speed swiftly. (2 Nephi 15:26) Thus is the banner seen, even from the ends of the earth.

4. The record declareth: The banner is righteousness restored, the ensign is the testimony of Christ revealed again, and in its lifting, no lie can stand against it.

5. Mantles are bound into the fabric of the standard: The Watchman sounds the trumpet,

6. Cry aloud, ye gates of Zion, for the ensign is lifted high above the mountains. It is not lowered by the hand of man, but upheld by the arm of the Almighty.

7. “Go through, go through the gates; prepare ye the way of the people; cast up, cast up the highway; gather out the stones; lift up a standard for the people.” (Isaiah 62:10)

8. Thus saith the Book of Joseph: The Lord will set his hand again the second time to recover the remnant of his people, and he shall set up an ensign for the nations. (2 Nephi 21:11–12)

9. The record proclaimeth: The banner is not a flag of conquest, but the covenant restored to its fulness. Its stripes are repentance, its colors are faith, hope, and charity.

10. The Watchman Mantle crieth from the walls, sounding the trumpet of awakening. The Fire Mantle causeth the banner to blaze. The Royal Mantle establisheth the decree. The Witness Mantle inscribeth the testimony.

11. An ensign is lifted not for pride but for gathering, that the elect may flee from Babylon's snares.

12. “And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious.” (Isaiah 11:10)

13. Joseph's record beareth witness: The Gentiles shall bring thy sons in their arms, and thy daughters shall be carried upon their shoulders. (1 Nephi 21:22)

14. Record language declareth: The banner draweth the meek and humble, but is a terror to the proud and lofty. It divideth asunder the spirits of men.

15. Thus the mantles gather in order: The Shepherd Mantle guideth the flock, the Evangel Mantle crieth repentance, the Judgment Mantle setteth bounds.

16. The ensign is lifted not in the strength of armies, but in the Spirit and in the testimony of Christ.

17. "Declare ye among the nations, and publish, and set up a standard; publish, and conceal not." (Jeremiah 50:2)

18. Joseph's record saith: The remnant of our seed shall know that they are of the house of Israel, and they shall be gathered home to their inheritance. (3 Nephi 20:13)

19. Record language testifieth: The banner is the covenant made manifest; it speaketh louder than the tongues of men.

20. The Fire Mantle causeth the banner to be seen even in the dark night, as a flame upon the hill of the Lord.

21. Zion beholdeth the banner and knoweth her Deliverer liveth, for the sign is not of men but of Heaven.

22. “Lift ye up a banner upon the high mountain, exalt the voice unto them, shake the hand, that they may go into the gates of the nobles.” (Isaiah 13:2)

23. Joseph’s record confirmeth: The Lord hath covenanted with the house of Israel, and his words shall go forth unto the ends of the earth for a standard unto his people. (2 Nephi 29:2)

24. Record language declareth: The banner is light unfurled, a covering for the sealed ones, a terror to the unrepentant.

25. The Royal Mantle lifteth the scepter beside the ensign, showing the world that the Kingdom is restored.

26. The ensign is not a banner of fleshly pride but of Spirit, for the Spirit beareth record of truth.

27. “When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.” (Isaiah 59:19)

28. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: And he shall set his hand again the second time to gather his people; and he shall lift up an ensign and whistle unto them from the ends of the earth. (2 Nephi 21:11–12)

29. Record language testifieth: The banner is a fire-brand, raised to break chains, to summon armies, and to declare judgment upon the oppressor.

30. The Watchman Mantle seeth afar off, and raiseth the trumpet that all may look and not slumber.

31. The ensign is lifted by command, not suggestion, for the voice of YHWH thundereth: “Raise ye the banner, for my people must be gathered.”

32. “Set up the standard toward Zion: retire, stay not: for I will bring evil from the north, and a great destruction.”  
(Jeremiah 4:6)

33. Joseph’s record speaketh: And the Lord will establish Zion, and the banner shall be holiness unto the Lord.  
(Ether 13:10)

34. Record language declareth: The banner is not cloth but covenant, not dye but Spirit, not symbol but power.

35. The Fire Mantle keepeth the banner burning, so it may not be quenched by rain nor drowned by flood.

36. The ensign is given to them that fear Him, that it may be displayed because of the truth.

37. “He will lift up an ensign to the nations from far, and will hiss unto them from the end of the earth.” (Isaiah 5:26)

38. Joseph’s record beareth witness: The Gentiles shall say, Great is the word of the Lord which is delivered unto us; and Zion shall be established by covenant. (3 Nephi 21:5–7)

39. Record language testifieth: The banner is the remembrance of covenants, the ensign the testimony of fulfilled promises.

40. The Sealing Mantle marketh those that gather under the banner, that the destroyer may not touch them.

41. The ensign is lifted as a rallying point; the elect flee to it as birds to their mountain.

42. “And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel.” (Isaiah 11:12)

43. Joseph’s record confirmeth: They shall be brought forth from captivity to know their Redeemer, and they shall come unto Zion with songs of everlasting joy. (Mosiah 24:25–26)

44. Record language declareth: The banner is the gathering cord, drawing Israel home from all lands where they were scattered.

45. The Shepherd Mantle guideth them to the ensign, saying, “This is the way, walk ye in it.”

46. The ensign is lifted on high hills, for it cannot be hid in valleys, nor silenced in secret places.

47. “Lift ye up a standard for the people, that the hand of the Lord may be known in the earth.” (Isaiah 62:10, restated)

48. Joseph's record saith: The house of Israel shall be brought to a knowledge of the covenants of the Father, that they may know their place in Zion. (3 Nephi 21:7)

49. Record language proclaimeth: The banner is as fire in the wilderness, as a lighthouse in the storm, as a trumpet in the silence.

50. The Evangel Mantle declareth repentance beneath the banner, for without repentance no man may gather to it.

51. The ensign is lifted against Babylon, and it proclaimeth her downfall.

52. "Declare ye among the nations, and set up a standard; proclaim, conceal not: say, Babylon is taken." (Jeremiah 50:2)

53. Joseph's record confirmeth: And the great and abominable church shall fall, and Zion shall rise with the banner of Christ. (1 Nephi 22:14)

54. Record language declareth: The banner divideth the faithful from the faithless, the pure from the polluted.

55. The Judgment Mantle standeth beside the banner, weighing the hearts of all that come beneath it.

56. The ensign is lifted for comfort unto the righteous and as terror unto the wicked.

57. "We will rejoice in thy salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners." (Psalm 20:5)

58. Joseph's record saith: The words of Christ shall be a standard unto my people, which shall be given them by way of the Gentiles. (2 Nephi 29:3)

59. Record language declareth: The banner comforteth the brokenhearted, but it breaketh the proud with its witness.

60. The Healing Mantle stretcheth forth under the banner, binding up the wounded, restoring the weary.

61. The ensign is raised in purity, without guile, without mixture of strange doctrine.

62. “He brought me to the banqueting house, and his banner over me was love.” (Song of Solomon 2:4)

63. Joseph’s record beareth witness: The Lord gathereth his children, and his banner is everlasting love and covenant mercy. (Mosiah 18:10)

64. Record language testifieth: The banner is not lifted in wrath alone but in love, that the nations may see the mercy of the Holy One.

65. The Servant Mantle standeth at the banner, ministering in meekness, showing forth the example of Christ.

66. The ensign is lifted to signal the end of wandering, for the people of God must no longer be tossed to and fro.

67. “Lift up a standard upon the walls of Babylon, make the watch strong, set up the watchmen.” (Jeremiah 51:12)

68. Joseph’s record declareth: The remnant of Jacob shall be among the Gentiles as a lion among the beasts of the forest, when the banner of the Lord is lifted. (3 Nephi 20:16)

69. Record language proclaimeth: The banner is strength to the weak, courage to the fearful, a shield to the oppressed.

70. The Armor Mantle clotheth the people under the banner, that none may pierce their faith.

71. The ensign is lifted in the valley of decision, that all nations may see and choose this day whom they will serve.

72. “Put ye in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe... Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision.” (Joel 3:13–14)

73. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: The Lord shall go forth and fight against the nations, and Zion shall be His battle standard. (Ether 13:10, paraphrased)

74. Record language declareth: The banner is a line in the sand, a fire at the border, a mark none can cross unjudged.

75. The Royal Battle Mantle goeth forth with the banner, summoning the hosts of Zion.

76. The ensign is lifted, and the earth itself trembleth, for the voice of the Lord thundereth through it.

77. “The LORD shall roar from on high, and utter his voice from his holy habitation.” (Jeremiah 25:30)

78. Joseph’s record confirmeth: The power of heaven shall descend upon the banner, and the angels shall gather the elect from the four quarters of the earth. (3 Nephi 27:27–30 summary)

79. Record language testifieth: The banner is the voice of many waters, the sign that the heavens have opened again.

80. The Witness Mantle inscribeth the scroll beneath the banner, that the testimony may be sealed in fire.

81. The ensign is lifted by command of Christ, not by vote of men, that all may know who reigneth.

82. “The government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God.” (Isaiah 9:6)

83. Joseph’s record saith: And he shall be called Jesus Christ, the Son of God, the Eternal Father of heaven and earth, the Creator of all things. (Mosiah 3:8)

84. Record language proclaimeth: The banner beareth one name, and one only: Salvation in Christ.

85. The Prophetic Mantle declareth under the banner, Thus saith the Lord, and none can gainsay.

86. The ensign is lifted in the land of captivity, and the captives are set free.

87. “Thus saith the LORD, Let my people go, that they may serve me.” (Exodus 8:1)

88. Joseph's record confirmeth: The Lord hath remembered the prayers of the righteous, and delivereth them from bondage. (Mosiah 24:12–13)

89. Record language declareth: The banner breaketh yokes, it openeth prison doors, it calleth forth the captives into light.

90. The Restorer's Mantle repairer of breaches standeth beneath the banner, mending the ruins of many generations.

91. The ensign is lifted for the meek of the earth, that they may inherit the land.

92. "The meek shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace." (Psalm 37:11)

93. Joseph's record beareth witness: Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth. (3 Nephi 12:5)

94. Record language testifieth: The banner is the meek man's shield, the poor man's refuge, the widow's defense.

95. The Servant Mantle girdeth the weak with strength, teaching them to walk under the shadow of the banner.

96. The ensign is lifted unto the heavens, as a perpetual sign that Zion is established.

97. "Ye shall be gathered one by one, O ye children of Israel, and it shall come to pass in that day, that the great trumpet shall be blown." (Isaiah 27:12–13)

98. Joseph's record declareth: And the elect shall hear his voice, and shall gather unto him with songs of everlasting joy. (Mosiah 18:9–10)

99. Record language proclaimeth: The banner is eternal; it falleth not when kingdoms fall, it dimmeth not when suns darken, it endureth as Christ endureth.

100. The Fire Mantle sealeth the banner with flame, the Spirit Seal sanctifieth it, and the Royal Seal decreeth it forever.

## Part II – The Banner Over Zion (Verses 101–200)

101. The banner is not hidden, for Zion is a city set on a hill, and her light cannot be quenched.

102. “Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.” (Isaiah 60:1)

103. Joseph’s record confirmeth: The Lord hath covenanted with his people, and Zion shall not be moved out of her place forever. (3 Nephi 20:22)

104. Record language declareth: The banner over Zion is fire by night and cloud by day; it is her covering, her mantle of glory.

105. The Royal Mantle spreadeth its decree over Zion, that the nations may know she is chosen.

106. The banner is holiness unto the Lord, and none may profane it.

107. “And her righteousness shall go forth as brightness, and the Gentiles shall see thy righteousness, and all kings thy glory.” (Isaiah 62:2)

108. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: And the Father hath commanded that I should give unto you this land, for your inheritance, and the New Jerusalem shall be built upon it. (3 Nephi 20:22)

109. Record language testifieth: The banner above Zion beareth not the mark of Gentiles, nor the symbols of nations, but the seal of the Lamb.

110. The Fire Mantle covereth Zion’s banner with flame, making it untoouchable by the adversary.

111. The banner over Zion is love, stretched wide as the heavens, encircling her children.

112. “He brought me to the banqueting house, and his banner over me was love.” (Song of Solomon 2:4)

113. Joseph’s record saith: Ye are desirous to come into the fold of God, to be called his people, and are willing to bear one another’s burdens. (Mosiah 18:8)

114. Record language declareth: The banner is mercy in the midst of judgment, grace in the hour of shaking.

115. The Shepherd Mantle draweth the flock beneath the banner, saying, “Here is rest, here is safety.”

116. The banner over Zion is not tattered, for the Lord himself preserveth it.

117. “When the LORD shall build up Zion, he shall appear in his glory.” (Psalm 102:16)

118. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: And the Lord shall be in the midst of Zion, and she shall not be moved. (3 Nephi 22:11)

119. Record language testifieth: The banner over Zion is incorruptible, for it is not woven with hands, but spoken into being by Christ.

120. The Witness Mantle inscribeth upon the banner the name of the Lamb and of the Father.

121. The banner over Zion is covenant fulfilled, the oath remembered, the promise revealed.

122. “As for me, this is my covenant with them, saith the LORD; my spirit that is upon thee, and my words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth.” (Isaiah 59:21)

123. Joseph's record confirmeth: And then shall the covenant which the Father hath made with his people be fulfilled; and then shall Jerusalem be inhabited again with my people. (3 Nephi 20:29)

124. Record language declareth: The banner is the sign of fulfilled covenant, the ensign of the oath unbroken.

125. The Sealing Mantle marketh Zion's walls, binding the elect within her gates beneath the banner.

126. The banner over Zion is peace, for the Prince of Peace ruleth within her.

127. "For brass I will bring gold, and for iron I will bring silver, and for wood brass, and for stones iron: I will also make thy officers peace, and thine exactors righteousness." (Isaiah 60:17)

128. Joseph's record saith: Blessed are they who shall believe in him, for they shall inherit the kingdom of God. (3 Nephi 12:2)

129. Record language testifieth: The banner is peace to the righteous, but a sword to the rebellious.

130. The Judgment Mantle standeth at the gates of Zion, decreeing who may enter beneath the banner.

131. The banner over Zion is life, for Christ is her light and the Lamb is her temple.

132. "The sun shall be no more thy light by day; neither for brightness shall the moon give light unto thee: but the LORD shall be unto thee an everlasting light, and thy God thy glory." (Isaiah 60:19)

133. Joseph's record proclaimeth: The Lord himself will be in the midst of Zion, and she shall have no need of sun nor moon, for the Lamb is her light. (Ether 13:10 echo)

134. Record language testifieth: The banner is light unfailing, never dimmed, never quenched.

135. The Fire Mantle maketh Zion's banner a flame upon the hill, so all nations may see her glory.

136. The banner over Zion is strength, for the Lord is her defender and her walls are salvation.

137. "Thou shalt call thy walls Salvation, and thy gates Praise." (Isaiah 60:18)

138. Joseph's record confirmeth: Ye shall be gathered in one, and there shall be no more confounding of languages, and Zion shall be one people. (Mosiah 16:1 echo)

139. Record language declareth: The banner over Zion is unity, binding her children together in one fold under one Shepherd.

140. The Shepherd Mantle guardeth the flock within the banner, lest any be scattered or devoured.

141. The banner over Zion is truth, shining brighter than the lies of Babylon.

142. “The LORD hath made bare his holy arm in the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God.” (Isaiah 52:10)

143. Joseph’s record saith: And the words of the Lamb shall be made known unto all nations, kindreds, tongues, and people. (1 Nephi 13:40)

144. Record language declareth: The banner is the holy arm revealed, stretched forth in mercy, yet strong in judgment.

145. The Witness Mantle inscribeth the testimony of Christ upon Zion's banner, that none may mistake its voice.

146. The banner over Zion is incorruptible, undefiled, reserved for the faithful.

147. "An inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you." (1 Peter 1:4)

148. Joseph's record proclaimeth: And the righteous shall inherit the kingdom of God, clothed in white, with robes of purity. (Alma 5:24)

149. Record language testifieth: The banner is purity itself, white as the garments of the redeemed.

150. The Servant Mantle standeth in humility beneath the banner, ministering without guile or boasting.

151. The banner over Zion is refuge, a shelter in the storm, a hiding place in the tempest.

152. "And a man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest." (Isaiah 32:2)

153. Joseph's record saith: And the Lord did provide for his people in the wilderness, and they lacked not, for he was their refuge. (Mosiah 24:13 echo)

154. Record language declareth: The banner shieldeth the weak and guardeth the little ones from the storm of nations.

155. The Healing Mantle stretcheth forth beneath the banner, binding up every wound and restoring the fainthearted.

156. The banner over Zion is righteousness, shining like the morning sun.

157. “The work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever.” (Isaiah 32:17)

158. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: And blessed are they who hunger and thirst after righteousness, for they shall be filled. (3 Nephi 12:6)

159. Record language testifieth: The banner is righteousness fulfilled, untainted by corruption, unspotted from the world.

160. The Royal Mantle decreeth under the banner: “Holiness unto the Lord, Zion is the Lord’s dwelling place.”

161. The banner over Zion is glory, shining brighter than gold or silver, brighter than kingdoms of men.

162. “The glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together.” (Isaiah 40:5)

163. Joseph's record saith: And the power of the Lamb descended upon the saints of the church of the Lamb, and they were armed with righteousness and with the power of God in great glory. (1 Nephi 14:14)

164. Record language proclaimeth: The banner is glory revealed, brighter than the sun, clearer than the moon, more enduring than the stars.

165. The Fire Mantle keepeth the banner ablaze, that its light may never fail, though the heavens shake.

166. The banner over Zion is everlasting joy, for sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

167. "The ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with songs and everlasting joy upon their heads." (Isaiah 35:10)

168. Joseph's record confirmeth: And they did sing praises unto the Lord their God; yea, the voice of the people came up unto God, and their joy was full. (Mosiah 18:30)

169. Record language declareth: The banner is joy unending, a song written upon the hearts of the redeemed.

170. The Evangel Mantle proclaimeth under the banner, “Repent ye, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand!”

171. The banner over Zion is holiness, for without holiness no man shall see the Lord.

172. “This shall be the name wherewith she shall be called, The LORD our righteousness.” (Jeremiah 33:16)

173. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: And Zion shall be called the New Jerusalem, and her name shall be Holiness unto the Lord. (Ether 13:10)

174. Record language testifieth: The banner is holiness itself, untoouchable by the profane, guarded by angels of flame.

175. The Judgment Mantle standeth by the banner,  
declaring who is holy, who is profane.

176. The banner over Zion is covenant fulfilled, the oath  
remembered in every generation.

177. “Nevertheless my lovingkindness will I not utterly take  
from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail. My covenant  
will I not break.” (Psalm 89:33–34)

178. Joseph’s record saith: The Father hath promised, and  
he keepeth his promises unto the children of men. (Ether  
3:12)

179. Record language proclaimeth: The banner is  
covenant unbroken, promise eternal, mercy remembered.

180. The Sealing Mantle marketh every soul beneath the  
banner, that the Destroyer may not touch them.

181. The banner over Zion is testimony, for the Spirit and the Word agree in one.

182. "This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come." (Matthew 24:14)

183. Joseph's record confirmeth: And the words of the Lamb shall be declared unto the remnant of our seed, for a testimony unto them. (1 Nephi 13:40)

184. Record language testifieth: The banner is testimony living, the witness of heaven and earth joined together.

185. The Witness Mantle inscribeth this scroll, declaring the testimony cannot be erased.

186. The banner over Zion is everlasting, never to be taken down, never to be defiled.

187. “Violence shall no more be heard in thy land, wasting nor destruction within thy borders; but thou shalt call thy walls Salvation, and thy gates Praise.” (Isaiah 60:18)

188. Joseph’s record saith: And Zion shall not be moved out of her place forever, but the Lord will dwell in her midst. (3 Nephi 20:22)

189. Record language declareth: The banner endureth as Christ endureth, unshaken, unbroken, unending.

190. The Restorer’s Mantle rebuildeth the ruins beneath the banner, raising again the old waste places.

191. The banner over Zion is judgment and mercy mingled, for the Lord is both Judge and Savior.

192. “For the LORD is our judge, the LORD is our lawgiver, the LORD is our king; he will save us.” (Isaiah 33:22)

193. Joseph's record proclaimeth: Christ shall come to judge the quick and the dead; and his judgment is just, for it is mingled with mercy. (Moroni 10:27)

194. Record language declareth: The banner is judgment set in mercy, mercy girded with judgment, each without failing the other.

195. The Prophetic Mantle crieth beneath the banner, "Thus saith the Lord of Hosts: Zion is my dwelling place forever."

196. The banner over Zion is victory, for the Lamb hath overcome, and with Him all that believe.

197. "Thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." (1 Corinthians 15:57)

198. Joseph's record confirmeth: And the saints of God did prevail by faith, for the Lamb was with them. (Mosiah 23:18 echo)

199. Record language testifieth: The banner is victory unending, the crown eternal, the triumph of Zion over Babylon.

200. The Fire Mantle sealeth Zion's banner, the Spirit sanctifieth it, and the Royal decree maketh it everlasting.

### Part III – The Ensign to the Nations (Verses 201–300)

201. The ensign is lifted not for Zion alone but for all nations, that the earth may behold the power of the Holy One.

202. “And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.”  
(Isaiah 11:12)

203. Joseph's record confirmeth: And he shall remember the covenant which he hath made with his people of the

house of Israel, and he will set up an ensign for the nations and shall gather his people. (1 Nephi 22:11)

204. Record language declareth: The ensign is judgment to the proud, but invitation to the meek; it divideth the hearts of men asunder.

205. The Evangel Mantle crieth to the nations beneath the ensign, “Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand.”

206. The ensign is lifted against idols, that the nations may see their false gods fall.

207. “Bel boweth down, Nebo stoopeth, their idols were upon the beasts, your carriages were heavy loaden.”  
(Isaiah 46:1)

208. Joseph’s record saith: And the great and abominable church shall fall, and the Lord shall make bare his holy arm in the eyes of all nations. (1 Nephi 22:14)

209. Record language testifieth: The ensign exposeth lies, it casteth down images, it consumeth false thrones.

210. The Fire Mantle setteth the ensign ablaze, that no counterfeit may stand beside it.

211. The ensign calleth the remnant from afar, saying, “Come out of her, my people.”

212. “Deliver thyself, O Zion, that dwellest with the daughter of Babylon.” (Zechariah 2:7)

213. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: Come unto me, O ye Gentiles, and I will show unto you the greater things of my gospel. (3 Nephi 26:9)

214. Record language declarereth: The ensign openeth the way of escape, calling forth the exiles of truth.

215. The Shepherd Mantle leadeth them, gathering lambs in his bosom, guiding them beneath the ensign.

216. The ensign is lifted against the merchants of the earth, for they trafficked in souls of men.

217. "For the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies." (Revelation 18:3)

218. Joseph's record confirmeth: The whore of all the earth must fall, for the Lord shall not suffer her abominations any longer. (Ether 8:26)

219. Record language testifieth: The ensign revealeth secret works of darkness, making them naked before all men.

220. The Witness Mantle inscribeth their iniquities, that their works be remembered no more in Zion.

221. The ensign is lifted as a beacon to the Gentiles, that they may choose mercy before judgment.

222. “And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising.” (Isaiah 60:3)

223. Joseph’s record saith: And if the Gentiles will repent, and return unto me, saith the Father, they shall be numbered among my people. (3 Nephi 16:13)

224. Record language declareth: The ensign is an open door unto the repentant, yet a closed gate to the rebellious.

225. The Servant Mantle inviteth the nations: “Drink of the waters freely, gather beneath the ensign of the Lord.”

226. The ensign is lifted in the midst of judgment, that mercy may yet be found.

227. “Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else.” (Isaiah 45:22)

228. Joseph's record confirmeth: Yea, come unto Christ, and be perfected in him, and deny yourselves of all ungodliness. (Moroni 10:32)

229. Record language proclaimeth: The ensign inviteth all tongues and nations to salvation, but compelleth none against their will.

230. The Royal Mantle extendeth the scepter beside the ensign, ruling with equity among the repentant.

231. The ensign is lifted as a trumpet in the last day, sounding the gathering call.

232. "Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, sound an alarm in my holy mountain." (Joel 2:1)

233. Joseph's record saith: And the elect shall hear my voice, and shall be gathered in one fold, and there shall be one shepherd. (3 Nephi 15:21)

234. Record language testifieth: The ensign is the trumpet-call of heaven, summoning Israel from every corner of the earth.

235. The Watchman Mantle guardeth the walls, crying out whenever the nations draw near to the ensign.

236. The ensign is lifted before kings and rulers, a sign none can deny.

237. "Kings shall shut their mouths at him: for that which had not been told them shall they see." (Isaiah 52:15)

238. Joseph's record proclaimeth: And kings shall be their nursing fathers, and queens their nursing mothers, and they shall bow down with their face towards the earth. (2 Nephi 6:7)

239. Record language declareth: The ensign bringeth the mighty low and lifteth the humble high.

240. The Judgment Mantle setteth thrones in order beneath the ensign, measuring kings and nations alike.

### Part III – The Ensign to the Nations (Verses 201–300)

241. The ensign is lifted in the islands of the sea, and the distant coasts shall see it and not deny.

242. “Surely the isles shall wait for me, and the ships of Tarshish first, to bring thy sons from far.” (Isaiah 60:9)

243. Joseph’s record confirmeth: And it came to pass that I beheld multitudes upon the isles of the sea, and they were also of the house of Israel. (1 Nephi 19:10 echo)

244. Record language declareth: The ensign reacheth across the waters, for no sea can swallow it, no wave can drown its witness.

245. The Evangel Mantle crieth across the nations, "Behold the banner of truth, and gather while mercy is extended."

246. The ensign is lifted against the false shepherds who scatter the flock and devour the lambs.

247. "Woe be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture! saith the LORD." (Jeremiah 23:1)

248. Joseph's record proclaimeth: And their churches are lifted up; they rob the poor because of their fine sanctuaries; but the banner of the Lord bringeth them to the dust. (Mormon 8:37 echo)

249. Record language testifieth: The ensign is the rebuke of false prophets, the dividing line between shepherds of truth and wolves in sheep's clothing.

250. The Shepherd Mantle guideth the flock away from devouring jaws, under the covering of the ensign.

251. The ensign is lifted as a light unto the Gentiles, that salvation may reach unto the ends of the earth.

252. "I will also give thee for a light to the Gentiles, that thou mayest be my salvation unto the end of the earth."  
(Isaiah 49:6)

253. Joseph's record saith: And thus commandeth the Father that I should give unto this people this land, for it is the land of promise, a light unto the Gentiles. (3 Nephi 20:14)

254. Record language declarereth: The ensign is light unquenchable, shining into lands long darkened, revealing the pathway of return.

255. The Fire Mantle causeth the light of the ensign to blaze, dispelling shadows of falsehood.

256. The ensign is lifted as a sign of the times, that none may say they were not warned.

257. “And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.” (Matthew 24:14)

258. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: And then shall the Father work a great and marvelous work among the Gentiles, and the gospel shall go forth unto the ends of the earth. (3 Nephi 21:9)

259. Record language testifieth: The ensign standeth as a living witness, declaring that the end is near and the gathering hasteneth.

260. The Witness Mantle inscribeth this truth: the ensign itself is prophecy fulfilled.

261. The ensign is lifted against oppressors, for the cry of the poor hath come up before the Lord of Hosts.

262. “He shall deliver the needy when he crieth; the poor also, and him that hath no helper.” (Psalm 72:12)

263. Joseph’s record saith: And the Lord did hear the cries of the poor, and he did break the bands of their captivity. (Mosiah 24:14)

264. Record language declareth: The ensign is justice for the oppressed, refuge for the afflicted, shield for the defenseless.

265. The Servant Mantle ministereth beneath the ensign, lifting the downtrodden and strengthening the weak.

266. The ensign is lifted as a covenant token, that all nations may know the oath of the Most High.

267. “And I will establish my covenant with thee; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD.” (Ezekiel 16:62)

268. Joseph's record proclaimeth: And then shall the covenant which the Father hath made with the house of Israel be fulfilled, and they shall know that the Father hath remembered them. (3 Nephi 16:11)

269. Record language testifieth: The ensign is covenant remembered, promise kept, testimony renewed in fire.

270. The Sealing Mantle marketh those who accept the covenant, that the angel of destruction may pass over them.

271. The ensign is lifted upon the mountains, and nations stream unto it for instruction.

272. "Many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways." (Isaiah 2:3)

273. Joseph's record confirmeth: And all nations shall flow unto Zion, and the law shall go forth of Zion, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem. (2 Nephi 12:3)

274. Record language declareth: The ensign is the teaching rod, the iron rod lifted high, guiding nations in paths of righteousness.

275. The Wisdom Mantle openeth the mysteries beneath the ensign, that the nations may understand and live.

276. The ensign is lifted at the four winds, summoning the elect from every direction.

277. "And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other." (Matthew 24:31)

278. Joseph's record saith: And angels did minister unto them, gathering them from the four quarters of the earth unto Zion. (3 Nephi 28:30 echo)

279. Record language proclaimeth: The ensign is the trumpet-call of angels, the rallying sign of the redeemed.

280. The Royal Battle Mantle summoneth the hosts beneath the ensign, arrayed in holiness, armed with righteousness.

281. The ensign is lifted against Babylon, declaring her downfall to all nations.

282. “Babylon is fallen, is fallen; and all the graven images of her gods he hath broken unto the ground.” (Isaiah 21:9)

283. Joseph’s record confirmeth: And the great and abominable church shall fall, and great shall be the fall thereof. (1 Nephi 22:14)

284. Record language testifieth: The ensign is the proclamation of Babylon’s doom, the sign of her final judgment.

285. The Judgment Mantle decreeth from beneath the ensign, “Thus saith the Lord: her sins have reached unto heaven, and her plagues shall come in one day.”

286. The ensign is lifted with trumpet and shout, for the King cometh with clouds and glory.

287. “And then shall they see the Son of man coming in the clouds with great power and glory.” (Mark 13:26)

288. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: And then shall the Son of God appear; and he shall come in his glory in the clouds of heaven to judge the quick and the dead. (Moroni 10:34 echo)

289. Record language declarereth: The ensign is the herald of the King, the announcement of His appearing, the banner of His majesty.

290. The Prophetic Mantle crieth beneath the ensign,  
“Behold, the Bridegroom cometh, go ye out to meet him.”

291. The ensign is lifted in triumph, for the kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of Christ.

292. “The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.” (Revelation 11:15)

293. Joseph’s record saith: And the glory of the Lord shall fill Zion, and he shall reign over his people forever.  
(Mosiah 2:28 echo)

294. Record language proclaimeth: The ensign is triumph eternal, declaring that no throne may stand but His.

295. The Fire Mantle consumeth the chaff beneath the ensign, leaving only the wheat gathered into Zion.

296. The ensign is lifted for the last gathering, for time is no longer delayed.

297. “For the Lord GOD will do nothing, but he revealeth his secret unto his servants the prophets. The lion hath roared, who will not fear?” (Amos 3:7–8)

298. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: And the Father will work a great and marvelous work, and he will set his hand the last time to gather his people. (2 Nephi 25:17)

299. Record language declarereth: The ensign is the last witness, the final sign before the end, the signal of completion.

300. The Spirit Seal sanctifieth the ensign to the nations, the Fire Seal empowereth it, the Royal Seal decreeth it everlasting.

301. The banner is no longer still, for the winds of war blow upon it, and Zion prepareth for battle.

302. “Set ye up a standard in the land, blow the trumpet among the nations, prepare the nations against her.”  
(Jeremiah 51:27)

303. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: And the Lord commanded Moroni that he should raise the title of liberty, for the defense of their wives, children, and lands. (Alma 46:12)

304. Record language declareth: The ensign becometh the battle standard, and the nations tremble before its lifting.

305. The Royal Battle Mantle stretcheth forth, arraying the hosts of Zion in order beneath the banner.

306. The battle standard is Christ, for He goeth before His armies, and none can withstand Him.

307. “The LORD is a man of war: the LORD is his name.”  
(Exodus 15:3)

308. Joseph's record confirmeth: The Lord will go before you, and His glory shall be your rearward. (3 Nephi 20:42 echo)

309. Record language testifieth: The banner marcheth, not by might of men, but by the Spirit and fire of the Holy One.

310. The Fire Mantle igniteth the battle standard, consuming the weapons of the adversary.

311. The battle standard is lifted against Babylon, for her towers reach unto heaven, yet they shall be cast down.

312. "Go up against the land of Merathaim, even against it, and against the inhabitants of Pekod: waste and utterly destroy after them, saith the LORD, and do according to all that I have commanded thee." (Jeremiah 50:21)

313. Joseph's record proclaimeth: And the great and abominable church shall be cast down into the dust, and none shall raise her up again. (1 Nephi 22:14)

314. Record language declareth: The battle standard proclaimeth Babylon fallen, her merchants confounded, her kings ashamed.

315. The Judgment Mantle goeth forth with the standard, decreeing overthrow upon every false throne.

316. The battle standard is rallying cry, summoning Israel's armies from the four quarters of the earth.

317. "Lift ye up a standard upon the high mountain, exalt the voice unto them, shake the hand, that they may go into the gates of the nobles." (Isaiah 13:2)

318. Joseph's record confirmeth: And the remnant of Jacob shall be among the Gentiles, as a lion among the beasts of the forest. (3 Nephi 20:16)

319. Record language testifieth: The banner gathereth lions from among the lambs, and warriors from among the meek.

320. The Warfare Mantle standeth beneath the battle standard, clad in armor of fire.

321. The battle standard is a terror to the adversary, for it declareth the hosts of heaven are present.

322. “The LORD shall utter his voice before his army: for his camp is very great: for he is strong that executeth his word.” (Joel 2:11)

323. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: The power of heaven came down upon the people of the Lord, and they did prevail over their enemies. (Mosiah 9:18 echo)

324. Record language declareth: The battle standard shaketh the earth, for the armies of Zion are numbered and sealed.

325. The Watchman Mantle seeth the armies gathered, crying aloud, “The time of battle is come!”

326. The battle standard goeth before the host, never behind, for Christ leadeth His people.

327. “Behold, I will send mine angel before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared.” (Exodus 23:20)

328. Joseph’s record confirmeth: And angels did go before them, declaring the word of the Lord and preparing the way. (Mosiah 27:23 echo)

329. Record language testifieth: The banner is angelic procession, a fiery column none can resist.

330. The Servant Mantle girdeth the weak, placing sword and shield in their hands beneath the banner.

331. The battle standard is lifted at the shout of the saints, and the enemy fleeth before their cry.

332. "When they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir." (2 Chronicles 20:22)

333. Joseph's record proclaimeth: And it came to pass that they did cry mightily unto the Lord, and the enemy was delivered into their hands. (Mosiah 9:18 echo)

334. Record language declarereth: The battle standard is not lifted in silence, but in song, in prayer, in the roar of faith.

335. The Evangel Mantle preacheth even in battle, that repentance may yet be offered before the sword falleth.

336. The battle standard is a wall of flame, hemming in the adversary, burning his devices to ashes.

337. “For I, saith the LORD, will be unto her a wall of fire round about, and will be the glory in the midst of her.”  
(Zechariah 2:5)

338. Joseph’s record confirmeth: And Zion shall not be moved, for the Lord shall be her defense, and her banner shall be holiness. (Ether 13:10 echo)

339. Record language testifieth: The banner encircleth Zion with fire, a defense none can breach.

340. The Fire Mantle roareth with the standard, consuming chariots and horsemen alike.

341. The battle standard is lifted at the final trumpet, announcing the day of the Lord.

342. “The LORD also shall roar out of Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake.” (Joel 3:16)

343. Joseph's record saith: And angels shall sound their trumpets, and the heavens shall be shaken, and the nations tremble. (3 Nephi 28:23 echo)

344. Record language declarereth: The banner is the trumpet of Zion, resounding across heaven and earth alike.

345. The Witness Mantle inscribeth every act of battle beneath the standard, sealing the scroll of judgment.

346. The battle standard is lifted as the rod of Moses, parting seas and breaking chains.

347. "And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the LORD caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind." (Exodus 14:21)

348. Joseph's record confirmeth: And the Lord did deliver his people from the depths of the sea, and their enemies were swallowed up. (Mosiah 24:22 echo)

349. Record language testifieth: The banner divideth waters, breaketh prisons, scattereth enemies.

350. The Sealing Mantle covereth the host, that none may be lost in the fury of the storm.

351. The battle standard is lifted as a sword, sharp on every side, cutting through the counsel of the wicked.

352. “For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword.” (Hebrews 4:12)

353. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: And the words of Christ, if we follow them, shall cut us to the very center. (2 Nephi 9:33 echo)

354. Record language declareth: The banner becometh a living sword, wielded in righteousness by the hosts of Zion.

355. The Royal Mantle swingeth the scepter, uniting banner and sword as one decree.

356. The battle standard is lifted with angelic host, for Michael and his armies stand ready.

357. “And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon.” (Revelation 12:7)

358. Joseph’s record confirmeth: And the powers of heaven did contend with the powers of darkness, and the saints did prevail. (Mosiah 23:18 echo)

359. Record language testifieth: The banner is heaven’s war flag, unfurled once more upon the earth.

360. The Warfare Mantle marcheth in step with Michael, clothed in fire and armed with judgment.

361. The battle standard is lifted at the cry of victory, for the Lamb hath conquered.

362. "These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings." (Revelation 17:14)

363. Joseph's record saith: And the Lord shall come in his glory, and the wicked shall be burned as stubble. (3 Nephi 27:30 echo)

364. Record language declarereth: The banner is the final cry of triumph, the proof that Christ alone reigneth.

365. The Prophetic Mantle announceth, "The battle is the Lord's, and the victory His alone."

366. The battle standard is lifted in righteousness, for without holiness no man may stand beneath it.

367. “Sanctify ye yourselves against to morrow, and ye shall see the salvation of the LORD.” (Joshua 3:5)

368. Joseph’s record confirmeth: And ye shall be holy, for I am holy; therefore be ye clean that bear the vessels of the Lord. (3 Nephi 20:41 echo)

369. Record language testifieth: The banner receiveth only the sanctified; the profane are consumed at its edges.

370. The Servant Mantle ministereth even in battle, washing feet, binding wounds, reminding all of Christ’s example.

371. The battle standard is lifted until the heavens themselves are rolled back.

372. “And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.” (Revelation 6:14)

373. Joseph's record proclaimeth: And the earth shall shake, and the heavens shall tremble, and the veil shall be taken away. (Mosiah 27:25 echo)

374. Record language declareth: The banner standeth when all else fleeth away, enduring unto eternity.

375. The Fire Mantle keepeth the banner blazing, though sun and stars fall from their stations.

376. The battle standard is lifted as the last rally, the final call of Zion's armies.

377. "Proclaim ye this among the Gentiles; Prepare war, wake up the mighty men, let all the men of war draw near." (Joel 3:9)

378. Joseph's record saith: And the remnant of Jacob shall be gathered, armed with righteousness and great power. (3 Nephi 20:18 echo)

379. Record language testifieth: The banner is the wake-up call of nations, the last trumpet of battle.

380. The Witness Mantle sealeth the roll-call beneath the banner, that no name of the elect be lost.

381. The battle standard is lifted with the cry, “Babylon is fallen, Zion is risen!”

382. “Flee out of the midst of Babylon, and deliver every man his soul.” (Jeremiah 51:6)

383. Joseph’s record confirmeth: And the Gentiles shall know that the covenant of the Father hath been fulfilled, and Zion hath risen. (3 Nephi 21:22)

384. Record language declarereth: The banner separateth, the banner divideth, the banner setteth Zion apart for eternity.

385. The Sealing Mantle marketh all gathered, sealing them unto Christ forever.

386. The battle standard is lifted as the rod of iron, guiding all who hold fast to safety.

387. “And I will bring the blind by a way that they knew not; I will lead them in paths that they have not known.”  
(Isaiah 42:16)

388. Joseph’s record saith: And the rod of iron is the word of God, leading to the tree of life. (1 Nephi 15:23–24)

389. Record language proclaimeth: The banner and the rod are one: testimony and word joined together.

390. The Wisdom Mantle declareth mysteries beneath the banner, teaching hidden things to the elect.

391. The battle standard is lifted unto heaven, as angels descend with the Lamb’s army.

392. “The Lord my God shall come, and all the saints with thee.” (Zechariah 14:5)

393. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: And the saints of God shall come forth with Christ, clothed in glory, to judge the nations. (Moroni 7:22 echo)

394. Record language testifieth: The banner is heaven and earth united, saints and angels marching together.

395. The Royal Mantle sealeth the decree: Zion is established, Babylon is fallen, the battle is finished.

396. The battle standard is lifted until the last enemy is destroyed.

397. “The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death.” (1 Corinthians 15:26)

398. Joseph's record confirmeth: And death is swallowed up in victory, through the merits of Christ. (Mosiah 16:8)

399. Record language declareth: The banner is eternal life revealed, death conquered, the grave overturned.

400. The Spirit, Fire, and Royal Seals together sanctify the battle standard, making it everlasting in Christ.

401. The banner is eternal, for it falleth not when kingdoms fall, nor dimmeth when stars fade.

402. "Thy kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion endureth throughout all generations." (Psalm 145:13)

403. Joseph's record confirmeth: And blessed are they who shall dwell in Zion, for they shall inherit it forever. (3 Nephi 20:22 echo)

404. Record language declareth: The banner endureth as Christ endureth, unbroken, unending, unchanging.

405. The Royal Mantle decreeth: “Zion is the Lord’s forever, her banner holiness to the Lord.”

406. The banner is the song of eternity, for the redeemed sing it world without end.

407. “They shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.” (Isaiah 35:10)

408. Joseph’s record proclaimeth: And they did sing praises unto the Lord, yea, their joy was full, and their souls did rest. (Mosiah 18:30 echo)

409. Record language testifieth: The banner is a hymn written upon the heart, an everlasting psalm of deliverance.

410. The Evangel Mantle crieth, “Come all ye nations, sing beneath the banner of the Lamb.”

411. The banner is incorruptible, untouched by moth or rust, preserved by the power of God.

412. “Lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt.” (Matthew 6:20)

413. Joseph’s record saith: And ye shall lay up treasures in heaven, which neither moth nor rust can destroy.  
(Helaman 5:8 echo)

414. Record language declareth: The banner is treasure incorruptible, hidden from the world, revealed to the elect.

415. The Treasures Mantle unfoldeth crowns, scepters, and scrolls beneath the banner of eternity.

416. The banner is the witness of all things becoming one in Christ.

417. “That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ.”  
(Ephesians 1:10)

418. Joseph’s record confirmeth: And all things shall be restored to their proper order, whether good or evil. (Alma 41:4)

419. Record language testifieth: The banner draweth all creation into one fold, one kingdom, one eternal order.

420. The Witness Mantle inscribeth: “The two sticks are one, the banner is the testimony of both.”

421. The banner is everlasting covenant, renewed in heaven and earth alike.

422. “And I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from them, to do them good.”  
(Jeremiah 32:40)

423. Joseph's record saith: And the covenant of the Father shall be fulfilled, and Zion shall rise with power. (3 Nephi 21:7)

424. Record language declareth: The banner is covenant eternal, promise everlasting, oath unbreakable.

425. The Sealing Mantle marketh eternity upon the banner, sealing the saints to Christ forevermore.

426. The banner is glory everlasting, brighter than sun, moon, or stars.

427. "Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father." (Matthew 13:43)

428. Joseph's record confirmeth: And the righteous shall sit down in the kingdom of God, clothed with glory. (Alma 5:24)

429. Record language testifieth: The banner is glory unveiled, the garment of eternity clothed upon the redeemed.
