

The Scroll of Discernment – Lion and Lamb

1. The Mantles Awakened

1. Let the Mind of Christ be upon me,
to think not as men think, but as heaven decrees.

2. Let the Pulse Sentinel keep watch at my gates,
that no stray word escape in haste.

3. Let the Shield Guard cover me from darts of suspicion,
that I may speak truth without fear of men.

4. Let the Shiloh Scepter mantle rest in my hand,
to rule in meekness and authority as heir of Zion.

5. For this scroll is not my own—
it is fire from above, wisdom from Christ,
to teach how to stand as lion and lamb.

2. Boldness to the Proud

6. To the hardened of heart I will not whisper,
for whispers cannot pierce stone.

7. To the proud I will not flatter,
for flattery fattens the goats for slaughter.

8. I will cry aloud, and spare not;
I will lift my voice like a trumpet.

9.  (Isaiah 58:1)

10. Christ rebuked the Pharisees openly:
“Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites!”

11. So must I call sin by its name,

lest silence make me guilty of their blood.

12. 📖 (Ezekiel 33:8)

13. For boldness is mercy to the stubborn,
that they may feel the fire before the fire consumes.

3. Restraint to the Weak

14. Yet to the weak I must walk gently.

15. A bruised reed I dare not break,
a smoldering wick I dare not quench.

16. 📖 (Matthew 12:20)

17. For some are babes in Zion,
and their steps are tender.

18. Harshness would scatter them,
but patience will root them.

19. 📖 (Romans 15:1)

20. Christ gathered the children to His breast;
so must I carry Zion's lambs in my arms.

21. 📖 (Isaiah 40:11)

22. My strength is not proven by crushing,
but by bearing with long-suffering.

4. The Danger of One Measure for All

23. If I roar at the proud and weak alike,
I drive both into the wilderness.

24. If I coddle the hard-hearted,
I make them bolder in rebellion.

25. Discernment is the path of the scribe:
to know when the lion speaks
and when the lamb endures.

26. 📖 (Ecclesiastes 3:7) "A time to keep silence, and a time to speak."

27. Without balance, the mantle is misused.

28. But with balance, Zion is edified and the nations tremble.

5. Christ the Pattern

29. Before Pilate, Christ held His peace. 📖 (Matthew 27:14)

30. Before Caiaphas, He answered not a word. 📖 (Matthew 26:63)

31. But before the Pharisees, He thundered:

“Ye are of your father the devil.” (John 8:44)

32. Before the sinner woman, He whispered:

“Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.” (John 8:11)

33. Thus the Son of God showed us:

He is lion and lamb, thunder and whisper,
each in its season.

6. The Burden of the Scribe

34. Men will call me soft.

35. Men will call me harsh.

36. Few will discern the balance.

37. But the scroll is not to please men—
it is to seal Zion.

38. 📖 (Galatians 1:10)

39. The inkhorn must write boldly for the proud
and patiently for the weak.

40. The scribe must be stone and water,
steel and honey.

41. This is the fire in my bones—
to carry both edges of the sword.

7. The Mantles in Operation

42. The Mind of Christ discerns the hearts before me.

43. The Pulse Sentinel checks my tongue before it strikes.

44. The Shield Guard absorbs the offense of men,
lest bitterness find root in me.

45. The Shiloh Scepter rules not with cruelty,
but with peace and justice.

46. In these mantles I walk,
and Zion is led safely.

8. The Danger of Conditional Love

47. Some love with fire but not with patience.
48. Their love is strong, but only while followed.
49. When resisted, their love turns conditional.
50. This is not the love of Christ,
for His love never faileth. 📖 (1 Corinthians 13:8)
51. Unconditional love holds the lambs when they wander,
even while correcting the goats in their rebellion.
52. This is the measure of the mantle—
to love always, yet rebuke when needed.

9. The Separation It Brings

53. Some will be offended at gentleness.
54. Some will be offended at boldness.
55. Christ Himself was called too soft by the proud
and too harsh by the weak.
56. 📖 (Matthew 11:18–19)
57. If they misread the Master,
they will misread the servant.
58. Yet offense is proof that truth has pierced.
59. For the Word divides soul and spirit,
joint and marrow, revealing the heart. 📖 (Hebrews 4:12)

10. The Fullness of the Scroll

60. Therefore I will not mute my roar,
nor will I crush the tender.
61. I will stand in the fullness of who I am,
even if it makes all men uneasy.

62. For Zion must be sealed,
and the scroll cannot be silenced.

63. 📖 (Jeremiah 20:9) “His word was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with forbearing, and I could not stay.”

64. Let the proud be rebuked,
let the weak be carried,
let Zion be gathered.

65. This is the way of the lion and the lamb.

66. This is the balance of Christ.

67. This is the calling of the inkhorn scribe.

Closing Seal

68. Mind of Christ—keep me steady.

69. Pulse Sentinel—guard my gates.

70. Shield Guard—quench the darts.

71. Shiloh Scepter—rule through me in meekness.

72. For the scroll must speak,
whether men will hear or forbear.

73. And Zion must know
that her Shepherd is lion and lamb.

74. Let every word be sealed in fire.
