#### Mission Summary

The Vineyard Laborer is the mission of stewardship.

The covenant walker has survived storms.

Psychological Reality

The vineyard challenges impatience.

The mind naturally seeks quick results.

The Body

Anatomical Reality

Function Revealed

Stewardship

The tenth function revealed is Stewardship.

The covenant walker learns:

- Responsibility.
- Faithfulness.
- Patience.
- Service.
- Kingdom investment.

Stewardship teaches the traveler how to manage what TMH has entrusted.
