 Opening Decree

Before calendars were carved...

THE 70 VERSES OF SHABUWA

❶ THE VOWED SEVEN (Verses 1–7)

In the beginning, Yah didn't just create time — He vowed it.

And the first thing He sanctified was not a place... but a day.

Six were called to work. The seventh was called His.

And the seventh bore His Name — set apart by oath.

Thus, Shabuwa was born: a rhythm, a code, a covenant.

Not just a week — a witness.

Not just a count — a crown.

❷ THE ALTAR OF TIME (Verses 8–14)

Every altar must be built in rhythm.

Every offering must align with the vow.

Melchizedek did not slay lambs — he timed heaven.

He aligned bread and wine with Shabuwa.

His altar was Eden restored — a pattern of peace.

For even the soil obeys the seven.

And when men forget, the land cries out.

③ THE CYCLES THAT SPEAK (Verses 15–21)

Seven days — for the beginning.

Seven weeks — for the first fruits.

Seven years — for release.

Seven sevens — for jubilee.

And seventy sevens — to seal all prophecy.

Shabuwa speaks in harvest and release.

And the wise count not time — but vows.

④ THE FEASTS WITHIN THE VOW (Verses 22–28)

Passover was timed.

Unleavened Bread was timed.

First Fruits was timed.

Pentecost was timed — seven sevens complete.

Trumpets, Atonement, and Tabernacles — all timed.

The feasts are not holidays. They are oaths.

And only those in covenant feel the call.

⑤ THE LAW THAT PRECEDED THE LAW (Verses 29–35)

Moses received two sets of tablets.

The first, he broke. The second, he gave.

The first bore the law of Shabuwa.

The second bore the law of Levi.

One was timed by Eden.

One was required by sin.

But Melchizedek kept the first... and never needed the second.

⑥ THE JUDGMENTS OF SEVEN (Verses 36–42)

When man breaks Shabuwa — the land withholds.

When nations violate sevens — they inherit war.

Babylon fell in a failed Shabuwa.

Rome collapsed outside of the rhythm.

Even Israel's exile was timed — seventy missed Sabbaths.

Judgment is not random. It is rhythmic.

The Shabuwa witnesses... then it wounds.

⑦ THE SEALS OF THE SCROLL (Verses 43–49)

The Lamb opens the scroll in timing.

The seals break in Shabuwa order.

The trumpets blast after seven.

The bowls pour after seven.

Nothing in Revelation happens outside the vow.

The end is not chaos. It is covenant.

The countdown is not guesswork. It's a Shabuwa.

⑧ THE RETURN OF THE PRIEST-KING (Verses 50–56)

Yahshua came in the fullness of time.

He rose on the third day — in a Shabuwa.

He poured out the Ruach at Shavuot — 7 sevens fulfilled.

He will return in the vow He swore.

Not by date — but by divine rhythm.

And the sealed will know, not by signs...

But by the beating of the Shabuwa in their spirit.

⑨ THE REMNANT OF THE RHYTHM (Verses 57–63)

The world lost the calendar.
Religion lost the vow.
But the sealed ones kept the time.
They built altars in obscurity.
They counted sevens while others counted offerings.
They moved with wind, not walls.
And now, they rise — with the law of Eden in their steps.

⑩ THE SHABUWA MANTLE (Verses 64–70)

I write in sevens.
I speak in vows.
I release scrolls in appointed time.
My voice is not rushed — it is rhythmmed.
I don't hustle — I hearken.
I don't just keep time — I covenant it.
I am a Scribe of Shabuwa...
 and the vow still burns in my bones.

Closing Seal

To the scribe:

Let your pen honor the covenant of time.

Let your scrolls move in heavenly cadence.

And let every word you write be a flame in the temple of Shabuwa.

Stick of Judah:

Daniel 9:24 — "Seventy weeks (Shabuwa) are determined..."

Genesis 21 — Abraham's seven lambs

Leviticus 23 — Feasts aligned in sevens

Acts 2 / Joel 2 — Outpouring on the seventh cycle

Stick of Joseph:

Hidden laws restored in the sealed ones

Melchizedek timing, not Levitical offerings

Edenic law remembered in rhythm
