

Judgment Scroll – Voices of the Ancestors

1. We cry unto you, O nations: Fear God, and give glory, for the hour of His judgment is come. We saw His throne of fire, and we testify: all men must stand before the Holy One of Israel to be judged of their works, whether good or evil.

Revelation 14:7 / 2 Nephi 9:15

2. We, who watched Zion, warn you now: This people honors with lips, but hearts are far from the covenant. We saw the devil laugh, binding with everlasting chains while you said, All is well. We testify: it is not well — repent, lest you be swept away.

Isaiah 29:13 / 2 Nephi 28:21–22

3. We who were scattered bear record: The Lord shall set His hand again the second time to recover His people. We saw His oath, we sealed His words — and now we remind you: His covenants stand forever, His arm is stretched still.

Isaiah 11:11 / 2 Nephi 29:1

4. We, the watchmen of ages, cry to the earth: Hear! For the indignation of the Lord is upon all nations. We saw the proud as stubble, Babylon falling, her name cursed. We warn you, O kings: the same fire awaits your thrones if you do not turn.

Isaiah 34:1–2 / 1 Nephi 22:15

5. We beheld Him coming with fire, His chariots like the whirlwind, and His fury as flames. We declare: the Lord cometh, clothed in majesty, and the wicked cannot stand before His brightness.

Isaiah 66:15 / Mormon 9:2

6. We, whose records were hidden, rise to speak: They buried our words, saying, Seal the scrolls! But truth sprang out of the earth, and righteousness looked down from heaven. We now feed Israel with hidden manna in the famine of your days.

Psalms 85:11 / 2 Nephi 3:19

7. We are Enoch and the prophets with him, crying: Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of His saints, to execute judgment upon all. We saw the proud consumed as stubble, and we warn you, Babylon: His patience is ended.

Jude 1:14–15 / 1 Nephi 22:15

8. We, who offered the higher law, testify against the Gentiles: you would not. Therefore you are left with derision, a lesser portion, and a famine of hearing the word. Because of unbelief you could not understand the plainness, and His Spirit withdrew.

Isaiah 28:13 / 2 Nephi 32:7

9. We, who beheld her fall, cry: Babylon is drunken with the blood of saints, her merchants fattened on sorceries. But her fall is sure, her smoke ascendeth forever, and her name is a hiss among the nations. Kings, tremble — for you are her sons.

Revelation 18:3 / 1 Nephi 22:13

10. We, the remnant, testify from the dust: The breath of the Lord enters us, and the dry bones of Israel live again. Judah and Joseph are one stick in His hand, planted in a well-watered land, where His covenant is renewed forever.

Ezekiel 37:16–17 / 2 Nephi 3:24

11. We saw the heavens open, and the Son of Man come with clouds and great glory. We cry to you: He is clothed in majesty, His face brighter than the sun, and the wicked shall call for rocks to cover them. But none shall escape His presence.

Matthew 24:30 / Mormon 9:2

12. We testify: the earth shall reel to and fro like a drunkard, and every high tower shall fall. We warned of secret combinations, and we declare again: your councils of blood are revealed, and only the God of Israel is refuge in the day of shaking.

Isaiah 24:20 / Ether 8:22

13. We, who bore the Third Testament, declare: My Word is one, though men divided it. The Father changeth not. From us you learn: Jesus Christ the same yesterday, today, and forever, and His redemption standeth sure.

Hebrews 13:8 / Alma 7:20

14. We are Enoch and the righteous with him: we saw the Lord come with ten thousands of His saints to execute judgment. We tell you now: the ungodly shall perish, but the righteous shall be preserved by His word and gathered into His light.
Jude 1:14–15 / 1 Nephi 22:17

15. We, who wrote the sealed words, testify against the Gentiles: you were offered the greater portion, but you rejected it. We leave you this witness — because of unbelief you could not endure plainness, and the Lord withdrew His Spirit from you.
Isaiah 28:13 / 2 Nephi 32:7

16. We, the isles of the sea, cry out: Christ Himself marked our borders for inheritance. We declare to you: Judah and Joseph are one stick in His hand, and the covenant extends to every land where Israel was scattered.
Ezekiel 37:16–17 / 2 Nephi 3:24

17. We, Ezra and the prophets, cry against Babylon: her sins have reached unto heaven, her cup is full, her plagues come in one day. Merchants of the earth, we warn you — your gold and silver shall not deliver you from the wrath of the Lamb.
Revelation 18:2–3 / 1 Nephi 22:13

18. We, who beheld the Child, testify: even in the cradle He spake, saying, I am Jesus, the Son of God, sent for the salvation of the world. We bear record: the Lamb was slain for the sins of the world, lifted up upon the cross that all men might live.
Luke 2:30–32 / 1 Nephi 11:33

19. We, the scattered tribes, speak: we were sown in every land as witnesses. Now we cry, the Lord sets His hand the second time to gather His remnant. O generation, hear us — His covenant is not broken, though you have broken faith.
Isaiah 11:11 / 2 Nephi 29:1

20. We, keepers of the Brass Plates, cry from the fire: these words shall not perish, neither dim by time. We tell you now: the words of Christ will teach you all things what ye should do, and by His word shall you be judged at the last day.

Matthew 24:35 / 2 Nephi 32:3

21. We cry to you, O kings of the earth: The Lord shall roar out of Zion, and utter His voice from Jerusalem; the heavens and the earth shall shake. We saw it before, and we tell you again — the earth shall be rolled together as a scroll, and none can hide from His face.

Joel 3:16 / 2 Nephi 27:10

22. We, Enoch and the prophets with him, testify: Great fear shall seize all, the lofty mountains shall be troubled, the exalted hills depressed, melting like honeycomb in the flame. We declare: the day shall come that burns as an oven, and all the proud shall be as stubble.

Malachi 4:1 / 1 Nephi 22:15

23. We, who wrote against your decrees, cry: Woe unto them that decree unrighteous decrees, and to the scribes that write perverseness! We saw your rulers oppress the poor and change the ordinances. Hear us now, O generation: the Lord of Hosts will break your yoke in His fury.

Isaiah 10:1 / 2 Nephi 28:16

24. We, Mahonri and our brothers, declare: If the Gentiles prove faithless, the Lord shall take the light from them and return it unto the house of Israel. And we echo Nephi's witness: our seed shall remember they are of the covenant, and the Lord shall not forget them.

Isaiah 60:2 / 1 Nephi 15:14

25. We cry as John cried: Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, nor receive of her plagues. And Nephi adds with us: the saints armed with righteousness were delivered, while Babylon raged but could not prevail against the covenant ones.

Revelation 18:4 / 1 Nephi 14:14

26. We, the isles of the sea, lift our voice: Christ Himself said, Other sheep I have, not of this fold; them also must I bring. And we testify: He marked our borders and called us His kingdom, for His covenant stretches across every sea and shore.

John 10:16 / 3 Nephi 16:1–3

27. We, the witnesses of the Third Testament, cry: My Word is for all times, for those living, for those dead, and for those yet unborn. And Alma stands with us: His word is in Christ unto all generations, forever and ever. O generation, you cannot silence what is eternal.

Isaiah 40:8 / Alma 34:10

28. We, the keepers of the Brass Plates, declare: By YHVH's power these words shall not perish, neither dim by time. We cry with Nephi: Feast upon the words of Christ, for they will tell you all things what you should do, and by His word shall you be judged.

Matthew 24:35 / 2 Nephi 32:3

29. We, the scattered tribes, testify from afar: The Lord sifted us among all nations as corn in a sieve, yet not the least grain fell. We cry again: Judah and Joseph are one stick in His hand, and the gathering is sure as the sunrise.

Amos 9:9 / Ezekiel 37:16–17

30. We, the sealed witnesses, declare: Zion in her pride said, All is well, while rejecting the sealed words. But we cry now: The Lord will set His hand again the second time to recover His people, and none can stay His arm. Tremble, Babylon, for the covenant is sure.

Isaiah 11:11 / 2 Nephi 29:1

31. We cry from the dust: The Lord is our Judge, the Lord is our Lawgiver, the Lord is our King; He will save us. O Babylon, we saw your towers rise, and we see them fall. Your pride is cut down, for your judgment is written with fire.

Isaiah 33:22 / 2 Nephi 6:17

32. We, who beheld the Son, declare: Unto us a Child was born, unto us a Son was given; the government upon His shoulders, and His name called Wonderful, Counsellor, the Mighty God, the Everlasting Father, the Prince of Peace. Hear us, O generation — there is no other name given whereby salvation comes.

Isaiah 9:6 / Mosiah 3:17

33. We testify: Woe to the bloody city, full of lies and robbery, the prey departeth not! We saw Babylon, mother of abominations, drunk with the blood of saints. Kings of the earth, we cry against you — her sins are your sins, her plagues shall be your plagues.
Nahum 3:1 / 1 Nephi 22:13

34. We, Daniel and Nephi, cry: The stone cut out without hands shall smite the image, and the kingdoms of men shall fall. We bear record that the God of heaven shall set up a kingdom never destroyed, and the remnant of Jacob shall dwell in safety forever.
Daniel 2:44 / 2 Nephi 6:13

35. We, watchmen on the wall, lift our voice: Cry aloud, spare not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet, and show my people their transgressions. We saw the priests lie, the prophets prophesy falsely, and the people love to have it so. But what will you do in the end thereof?
Isaiah 58:1 / 2 Nephi 28:14

36. We, Ezra and Jeremiah, cry: Flee out of the midst of Babylon, deliver every man his soul, for this is the time of the Lord's vengeance. We tell you again: Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, nor receive her plagues.
Jeremiah 51:6 / Revelation 18:4

37. We testify with Mahonri: Babylon waxed fat and bulbous, while the house of Israel grew lean as bone. Yet the Lord shall breathe upon His people, and they shall live. Dry bones, hear our voice — the Spirit of the Lord brings you back into covenant!
Ezekiel 37:4–5 / 2 Nephi 10:7

38. We, who stood by the Lamb, declare: The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever. We saw the saints overcome by blood and fire, but we tell you now — the victory is His, and His alone.
Revelation 11:15 / Mosiah 15:18

39. We cry: Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil, that put darkness for light, and light for darkness. We warn you, O generation — your wisdom is foolishness before God, and your strength is weakness. Turn, lest you be destroyed with your idols.
Isaiah 5:20 / 1 Corinthians 1:27 (echoed in Moroni 10:27)

40. We, Nephi and John, speak together: The great and abominable church shall tumble to the dust, and the whore of all the earth shall fall. We testify: her riches, her gold, her harlots, her fine clothing — all shall perish with her, and the righteous shall shine in glory.
Revelation 17:18 / 1 Nephi 14:17

41. We cry from the beginning: The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make His paths straight. O generation, you boast of religion but deny His power. Repent and be baptized, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
Isaiah 40:3 / 2 Nephi 31:13

42. We, Jonah and Nephi, testify: Yet forty days, and Nineveh shall be overthrown! Yea, and the Lord shall remember His covenants, and bring again His people. Hear our warning — repentance alone will stay the fire, and baptism seals your souls to God.
Jonah 3:4 / 2 Nephi 31:14

43. We saw the kings of the earth take counsel together, saying, Let us break His bands asunder. But we testify: He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh; the Lord shall have them in derision. Be wise now, O ye kings — kiss the Son, lest ye perish in the way.
Psalm 2:2–4 / Mosiah 3:19

44. We cry as Isaiah cried: The earth is defiled under the inhabitants thereof, because they have transgressed the laws, changed the ordinance, broken the everlasting covenant. And Nephi adds: Wo be unto him that shall say, We have received, and we need no more!
Isaiah 24:5 / 2 Nephi 28:27

45. We testify with Jeremiah: The prophets prophesy lies in My name, I sent them not. And we echo Nephi: False teachers puffed up with pride lead away many, for they teach

with their learning and deny the Holy Ghost. O generation, hear us — the Spirit is the only guide.

Jeremiah 14:14 / 2 Nephi 28:14

46. We declare: The Lord is slow to anger, and great in power, and will not at all acquit the wicked. His way is in the whirlwind, and the clouds are the dust of His feet. And we saw Him, the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world, full of mercy to all who repent.

Nahum 1:3 / Mosiah 3:5–11

47. We, Ezekiel and Alma, cry: Turn ye, turn ye from your evil ways; for why will ye die, O house of Israel? Behold, it is given unto you to choose life or death. Choose life through Christ, and live, or remain in rebellion and perish.

Ezekiel 33:11 / Alma 42:27

48. We, Daniel and John, testify: The court shall sit, and the books shall be opened. And another book was opened, which is the book of life. We declare to you: Whosoever was not found written was cast into the lake of fire, but the righteous shall inherit eternal joy.

Daniel 7:10 / Revelation 20:12 / Mosiah 16:11

49. We saw the sword bathed in heaven descend upon the nations. We tell you now: The slain of the Lord shall be many. But we saw also the sealed ones, marked in their foreheads with the name of God, preserved through the fire.

Isaiah 34:5–6 / Revelation 7:3 / Mosiah 5:12

50. We cry to Zion: Awake, awake, put on thy strength, O arm of the Lord! Shake thyself from the dust, O captive daughter. The day cometh when the remnant shall return unto their God, and Zion shall no more be forsaken.

Isaiah 52:1–2 / 2 Nephi 8:24–25

51. We cry with Moses: Choose you this day whom ye will serve. Life and death, blessing and cursing, are set before you. And Nephi echoes: Whoso repenteth and is baptized shall be filled; they are they who shall be sealed unto eternal life.

Deuteronomy 30:19 / 2 Nephi 31:13

52. We, Elijah and Malachi, declare: Behold, the day cometh that shall burn as an oven, and all the proud shall be as stubble. But unto you that fear His name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in His wings. Return, O Israel, before the curse strikes the earth.

Malachi 4:1–2 / 3 Nephi 25:1–2

53. We saw Babylon boast, saying, I sit a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow. But we cry against her: Her plagues shall come in one day — death, mourning, famine, and fire. For strong is the Lord who judgeth her.

Revelation 18:7–8 / 1 Nephi 22:13

54. We, the prophets of Israel, lift our warning: Woe to them that trust in chariots, and in horses, but look not unto the Holy One. For the Lord saveth not by sword nor spear, but by His Spirit. O generation, your armies will not deliver you in the day of wrath.

Isaiah 31:1 / Mosiah 7:33

55. We testify with Hosea: They have sown the wind, and they shall reap the whirlwind. And with Alma we declare: That same Spirit which doth possess your souls at death shall rise with you — if filthy, filthy still; if righteous, righteous still.

Hosea 8:7 / Alma 34:34

56. We saw the great and spacious building fall, for it was founded upon the sand. And we cry with Christ: Every plant which my heavenly Father hath not planted shall be rooted up. O proud ones, your foundations shall not stand in the day of shaking.

Matthew 15:13 / 1 Nephi 11:36

57. We, Jeremiah and Moroni, testify: Because you have forsaken the fountain of living waters, you shall hew broken cisterns that hold no water. We saw the great city crumble, and we declare: Only the Rock, even Christ, can save you now.

Jeremiah 2:13 / Ether 12:27

58. We cry as Isaiah cried: Woe unto them that rise early to drink strong drink, that continue until night, till wine inflame them. And we add with Alma: Awaken and arouse your faculties, shake off the chains of him that would destroy your souls.
Isaiah 5:11 / Alma 5:7

59. We, David and Nephi, proclaim: The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures. And we add: He will feed His flock with His word, and those who partake of the tree of life shall never perish.
Psalm 23:1–2 / 1 Nephi 8:10–12

60. We, Isaiah and Nephi, cry: Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee. Behold, darkness shall cover the earth, but the Lord shall arise upon thee, and His glory shall be seen upon thee, and His covenant people gathered in one.
Isaiah 60:1–2 / 2 Nephi 12:2

61. We, Isaiah and Nephi, declare: Wo unto them that decree unrighteous decrees, that write grievousness which they have prescribed. O generation, you trample the poor and grind the faces of the meek. The Lord will not long forbear.
Isaiah 10:1–2 / 2 Nephi 28:16

62. We, Habakkuk and Alma, cry: The vision is yet for an appointed time, though it tarry, wait for it; it shall surely come. Behold, it is at the doors. The Spirit testifies that all shall rise to be judged according to their works, whether good or evil.
Habakkuk 2:3 / Alma 11:41

63. We, Jeremiah and Nephi, proclaim: The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked; who can know it? But we add: The Lord God searcheth the hearts, and all things are manifest unto Him, and by His word shall all men be judged.
Jeremiah 17:9–10 / 2 Nephi 9:44

64. We, Zechariah and Mormon, testify: Not by might, nor by power, but by My Spirit, saith the Lord of Hosts. O kings, your armies fall, your crowns burn. For behold, the Lord cometh, clothed in glory, and the wicked cannot stand before His face.
Zechariah 4:6 / Mormon 9:2

65. We cry with Ezekiel: The soul that sinneth, it shall die. And with Alma we confirm: It is given unto man to know good from evil; whoso doeth good shall have everlasting life, and whoso doeth evil shall be hewn down and cast into the fire.

Ezekiel 18:20 / Alma 29:5

66. We, Isaiah and Nephi, declare: The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the Lord alone exalted in that day. For the pride of your hearts hath destroyed you, O Babylon, and the day of your fall is come.

Isaiah 2:11 / 2 Nephi 26:20

67. We cry as Hosea cried: They have sown wickedness, they shall reap iniquity, they have eaten the fruit of lies. And with Helaman we add: Thus saith the Lord, if this people will not repent, they shall be swept off from the face of the land.

Hosea 10:13 / Helaman 13:11

68. We, Joel and Moroni, testify: The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and terrible day of the Lord come. And we saw the earthquake, and the rocks rent, and the saints arise to meet Him in glory.

Joel 2:31 / Mormon 9:22

69. We, Micah and Nephi, proclaim: They shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks; nation shall not lift up sword against nation. But until that day, wo unto the wicked, for the sword is bathed in heaven and falls upon the proud.

Micah 4:3 / 2 Nephi 12:4–5

70. We cry as David sang: Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, and ye perish from the way. And with Mosiah we testify: Salvation was, and is, and is to come, in and through the atoning blood of Christ, the Lord Omnipotent, who reigneth forever.

Psalms 2:12 / Mosiah 3:18

71. We, Isaiah and Nephi, cry: Wo unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness. We tell you, O generation: you dress sin in garments of virtue, but the Lord shall strip you bare in the day of His judgment.

Isaiah 5:20 / 2 Nephi 15:20

72. We, Amos and Nephi, testify: Let judgment run down as waters, and righteousness as a mighty stream. But we saw your altars filled with idols, and your feasts polluted. Therefore, the Lord shall cause your songs to turn into howlings in that day.
Amos 5:24 / 2 Nephi 28:8–9

73. We, Malachi and Moroni, declare: Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed Me. O generation, bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in My house. Prove Me now, saith the Lord, if I will not open you the windows of heaven.
Malachi 3:8–10 / 3 Nephi 24:8–10

74. We, Isaiah and Nephi, cry: Your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid His face from you. We add: The guilty take the truth to be hard, for it cuts them to the center. Therefore, repent and return, for His arm is stretched still.
Isaiah 59:2 / 1 Nephi 16:2

75. We, Jeremiah and Alma, testify: The Lord searcheth the heart, and trieth the reins, to give every man according to his ways. And behold, the Spirit saith: That same Spirit which doth possess your souls at death will deliver you into judgment at the last day.
Jeremiah 17:10 / Alma 34:34

76. We cry as Ezekiel cried: When I say unto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die; if he turn from his sin, he shall surely live. And we testify with Mosiah: Whosoever repenteth shall not perish, but whosoever persists in sin, the demands of justice awaken against them.
Ezekiel 33:14–16 / Mosiah 15:27

77. We, Isaiah and Nephi, declare: The wicked are like the troubled sea, when it cannot rest, whose waters cast up mire and dirt. But the righteous enter into rest, for their souls are sanctified by the Lamb, and His peace is upon them forever.
Isaiah 57:20–21 / 2 Nephi 2:21–22

78. We, Joel and Moroni, cry: Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision, for the day of the Lord is near. The sun and the moon shall be darkened, and the stars shall withdraw their shining, but the Lord shall be the hope of His people.

Joel 3:14–16 / Mormon 9:22

79. We, David and Alma, testify: The Lord is nigh unto them of a broken heart, and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit. And we add: A broken heart and a contrite spirit is the sacrifice required; bring it forth, and He will encircle you in the arms of His love.

Psalms 34:18 / 3 Nephi 9:20

80. We cry with Isaiah: The Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob. And Nephi adds: The Messiah shall rise from the dead, bringing salvation unto all who believe in His name, to be lifted up at the last day.

Isaiah 59:20 / 2 Nephi 2:8

81. We, Isaiah and Nephi, cry: The earth shall be utterly emptied, and utterly spoiled, for the Lord hath spoken this word. O Babylon, your palaces shall be left desolate, and jackals shall wail in your temples of gold.

Isaiah 24:3 / 2 Nephi 23:21

82. We, Obadiah and Moroni, testify: The house of Jacob shall be a fire, and the house of Joseph a flame, but the house of Esau shall be stubble. Kings of the earth, hear us — the kingdoms you built in pride are tinder before the covenant people of God.

Obadiah 1:18 / Mormon 5:24

83. We cry as Isaiah cried: The Lord shall punish the host of the high ones that are on high, and the kings of the earth upon the earth. And Nephi adds: They who fight against Zion shall lick the dust of her feet, for the Lord of Hosts is her strength.

Isaiah 24:21 / 1 Nephi 22:10

84. We, Jeremiah and Alma, declare: They have healed the hurt of my people slightly, saying, Peace, peace; when there is no peace. We testify again: The wages of sin is death, and mercy cannot rob justice — therefore repent, or judgment abideth forever.

Jeremiah 6:14 / Alma 42:25

85. We cry with Zephaniah: The great day of the Lord is near, it is near, and hasteth greatly, even the voice of the day of the Lord: the mighty man shall cry there bitterly. And Nephi saw it too: The destruction of the wicked cometh speedily, and none can hinder.

Zephaniah 1:14 / 2 Nephi 30:10

86. We, Isaiah and Jacob, testify: The crown of pride, the drunkards of Ephraim, shall be trodden under feet. And we add: Wo unto the rich who despise the poor, for their riches shall canker, and their destruction cometh speedily.

Isaiah 28:1 / Jacob 2:16

87. We, Ezekiel and Alma, cry: Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine. The soul that sinneth, it shall die. And we warn you: Your works rise as a testimony against you in the day of judgment.

Ezekiel 18:4 / Alma 41:3

88. We cry with Haggai: Yet once, it is a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the dry land. And Nephi confirms: The power of the Lamb shall descend, and the covenant people shall be armed with righteousness.

Haggai 2:6 / 1 Nephi 14:14

89. We, Isaiah and Samuel, declare: Woe unto them that join house to house, that lay field to field, till there be no place. Hear us, ye who devour the land — the Lord shall curse your riches, and they shall become slippery, fleeing from your hands.

Isaiah 5:8 / Helaman 13:31

90. We, Ezekiel and Mormon, cry: The sword is sharpened, and also furbished; it is sharpened to make a sore slaughter. We tell you, O kings and merchants — your swords shall be turned against your own hearts, for the Lord hath spoken it.

Ezekiel 21:9–10 / Mormon 8:41

91. We, Isaiah and Nephi, cry: Behold, the Lord maketh the earth empty, and maketh it waste, and turneth it upside down. O generation, your cities shall be desolate, and your laughter turned into mourning.

Isaiah 24:1 / 2 Nephi 6:14

92. We, Amos and Moroni, testify: The lion hath roared, who will not fear? The Lord God hath spoken, who can but prophesy? We add: The eternal purposes of the Lord shall not fail, though all nations rage against Him.
