

## The Prophetic Mantle Scroll

### Witness

#### Elijah the Prophet

Elijah stood in a generation that had forgotten the covenant. Kings ruled, priests ministered, and people continued their daily lives, yet truth had become mixed with error and the voice of Elohim had become rare among the people.

Elijah was not sent to entertain.

He was not sent to gain followers.

He was not sent to build a reputation.

He was sent to call a people back to Elohim.

### The Function

The prophetic mantle exists to reveal, warn, testify, and call people back to covenant.

The prophet sees what others ignore.

The prophet speaks what others avoid.

The prophet reminds people of what Elohim has already spoken.

The prophetic mantle does not invent new truth.

It points people back to eternal truth.

The prophet serves as a witness.

A witness of covenant.

A witness of judgment.

A witness of mercy.

A witness of Christ.

Throughout every generation Elohim has raised prophetic voices to prepare His people before major events unfold.

The purpose is not fear.

The purpose is preparation.

Bible Witness

"Surely the Lord God will do nothing, but he revealeth his secret unto his servants the prophets." — Amos 3:7

Book of Mormon Witness

"A seer is greater than a prophet." For a seer may know of things past, present, and future according to the gift of God. — Mosiah 8:16–18

Both sticks testify that Elohim reveals His purposes through appointed witnesses before major events unfold.

### The Responsibility

The prophetic mantle carries responsibility.

The prophet cannot remain silent simply because the message is unpopular.

The watchman upon the wall is responsible to sound the warning when danger approaches.

If the trumpet remains silent, many may remain unprepared.

This responsibility requires courage.

It requires obedience.

It requires faith.

Many desire prophetic revelation.

Few desire prophetic responsibility.

The mantle requires both.

### The Mind of Christ

Without the Mind of Christ, the messenger begins to exalt himself rather  
than Christ.

The true prophet points beyond himself.

The testimony of prophecy is Christ.

The purpose of prophecy is Christ.

The fulfillment of prophecy is Christ.

The prophet is not the light.

The prophet points toward the Light.

#### Book of Mormon Witness

"We talk of Christ, we rejoice in Christ, we preach of Christ, we prophesy of Christ." — 2 Nephi 25:26
