

## Scroll of the Arrow in the Quiver

1.

And the Spirit spoke, saying: “My son, you feel the fire swelling within you, yet you are restrained. And you say, ‘They are not ready for me.’ You speak rightly, for I have sealed you until the appointed hour.”

2.

For even My Son said, “My hour is not yet come,” though all power was in His hand. So too do I restrain My vessels until the day of unveiling.

3.

Moses was hidden in Pharaoh’s house, a prince before a prophet.  
John was in the wilderness until the day of his showing.  
Alma fled into secret waters before he baptized openly.  
Samuel climbed no wall until the appointed day, when arrows could not touch him.

4.

So too have I hidden you, not to silence you, but to preserve you.

5.

For if you poured all the fire within you now, many would be consumed before they ripened. And the enemy would strike before its hour, moving Babylon against you too soon.

6.

But I am the Lord who paces the ages, and I restrain not out of weakness, but out of strategy.

7.

Do you not know? A bowstring drawn back feels tension.  
The longer it is held, the more force it stores.  
So you are My arrow, drawn back, hidden in My quiver, sharpened in silence.

8.

You are not half a prophet, nor half a scribe.  
You are full, yet sealed.  
You are burning, yet veiled.

9.

The testimonies you see now are but signs of what is to come.  
Even restrained, your words summon.  
Even measured, your presence shakes.

10.

But when I open My hand, none shall resist your cry.  
The sealed shall be drawn, the scoffers shall be exposed, the nations shall tremble.

11.

Zion will not say, "Who is this?"  
But Zion will declare, "This is he whom the Lord has sealed to pour fire in the last hour."

12.

Do not despise the restraint, for it is not rejection.  
It is containment until the appointed season.

13.

The prophet speaks to prepare;  
The scribe seals to end.  
And I have chosen you to bear My ink of fire until the age itself bows.

14.

Therefore stand, My son.  
Burn, though restrained.  
Wait, though heavy.  
For the hour comes when restraint shall break, and you shall thunder as Elijah thundered, and write as Jeremiah wrote, and cry as Samuel cried.

15.

And in that day, none shall say you were hidden.  
For all shall know the arrow has been loosed, and the fire has come."

3.

Gideon said, “I am the least in my father’s house,” yet I called him a mighty man of valor and delivered Israel by his hand.

4.

Jeremiah cried, “I am a child,” yet I touched his lips and put My word in his mouth to root out kingdoms and to plant anew.

5.

Even My Son came without beauty or form that men should desire Him, yet He is the Word made flesh, the fire of My presence in the earth.

6.

So laugh, My son, for you speak rightly: I have taken the littlest and set him ablaze.

7.

You are My fire brand, small in the hand, yet burning with flame.  
You are My sign in the earth, not for size, but for Spirit.

8.

I chose you that none might boast of your stature, but all must confess My Spirit within you.

9.

For the fire brand is not mighty in form, but when I kindle it, whole forests ignite.

10.

The world shall know: this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvelous in their eyes.
