

 Scroll of the Roles and the Training of Zion

1. And I saw Zion in the fire, and the house was shaken.
2. Some stumbled, some stood, some were silent, some cried aloud.
3. And the Spirit said: This is training.
4. For before I set a man over ten cities, I test him in one.
5. Before I give a mantle of fire, I try him in the flame of reproach.
6. And I saw that Zion was not destroyed, but refined.
7. For the dross must be burned away, that the vessel may be pure.
8. And the Spirit said: Roles are being handed out.
9. Not by the arm of flesh, but by the will of YHWH.
10. For the body hath many members, and all cannot be the head.
11. Some I set as prophets, some as scribes, some as watchmen, some as intercessors.
12. Some I call to labor, some to govern, some to heal, some to war.
13. And I saw that none could choose his own office, but each received by obedience.
14. And the Spirit said: He that endures the test shall be sealed in his portion.

15. But he that murmurs shall lose even the little he has.
16. And I saw men cling to the arm of flesh, and their strength failed them.
17. I saw others cling to Ruach, and though they trembled, they stood.
18. And the Spirit said: These are My sons and daughters.
19. For they lean not on man, but on Me.
20. Then I saw quarrels arise in the house.
21. One cried, "I am of this elder," and another, "I am of that teacher."
22. But the Spirit cried, "Is Christ divided?"
23. And I understood—loyalty to men must bow to loyalty to Ruach.
24. And the Spirit said: Elder shall be refined, the companion shall be refined, the people shall be refined.
25. For no flesh shall glory in My presence.
26. And I saw some seek recognition, and their reward was emptiness.
27. I saw others hidden in silence, and their reward was fire.
28. And the Spirit said: I conceal My servants until the time appointed.
29. They think they are forgotten, but I am sharpening them in secret.

30. And when the hour comes, I reveal them as flames none can quench.

31. And I saw many peeking, watching with curiosity, but not hearkening.

32. And the Spirit said: Even their glance is a witness against them.

33. For no one shall say, "I did not see," when the record is opened.

34. Then I saw roles sealed.

35. The prophet with his staff, the scribe with his inkhorn, the watchman on the wall.

36. The intercessor bowed low, the warrior girded, the teacher with scrolls in hand.

37. Each in their place, each in their fire.

38. And the Spirit said: Those who accept the mission now shall walk in glory after.

39. Those who refuse shall wander, though they stand on holy ground.

40. And I lifted up my voice: Abba, keep me in the mission, seal me in my role.

41. And the Spirit answered: Fear not, for I am with you in the test.

42. Be faithful over little, and I will make you ruler over much.

43. Endure this fire, and I will crown you in the kingdom.

44. For Zion shall make it, and her roles shall be filled.

45. And none shall boast in man, but all shall glory in Christ.

## The Scroll of the Threshing Floor

### Wave 1 – The Floor and the Wind

1. And I looked, and behold a floor stretched wide beneath heaven.
2. It was not dead stone, but living, breathing with light.
3. Every step upon it left a print, glowing faint or bright.
4. The Spirit said: Every step is recorded, nothing is lost.
5. Obedience left trails of fire; pride left flickers that faded in the wind.
6. The fan in the hand of YHWH swept over the house again and again.
7. Each pass cast dust, chaff, and vanity into the air.
8. What was weightless, vanished; what was true, remained.
9. The Spirit said: This is My order—sifting until only the pure remain.

### Wave 2 – The Watchers

10. And I saw watchers seated round the floor.
11. Angels with scrolls in hand, weighing each heart.
12. Not the words only, but the intent beneath.
13. Some steps they marked as fire; others as empty echoes.
14. And I saw men also, silent watchers from afar.
15. They scrolled, they peeked, they passed by.
16. The Spirit said: Even their silence is recorded.
17. Even suspicion is a witness; even curiosity testifies.
18. Some mock now, but tomorrow they shall remember.
19. Some doubt now, but tomorrow they shall be messengers.

### Wave 3 – The Mantles

20. And I beheld mantles on shoulders, each inscribed with a role.
21. Prophet, Watchman, Intercessor, Scribe, Shepherd, Teacher, Warrior.
22. Some bore them in trembling, and the letters glowed.
23. Others wore them in pride, and the fire dimmed.
24. Then I saw mantles slip, as if oil on stone.
25. The careless reached to grasp them, but they slid away.
26. They cried out with voices of flame, “Assign me, O Lord!”
27. And hidden ones, trembling in silence, stretched forth their hands.
28. The mantle leapt, the letters burned brighter, and crowns of flame appeared above their heads.
29. The Spirit said: I do not remove to shame, but to preserve.
30. I do not waste mantles—they must serve, not slumber.

### Wave 4 – The Torch

31. And I saw one on the edge of the floor with a torch.
32. Not a common brand, but flame from the altar.
33. Its fire was steady, not boastful.
34. Smoke filled the center where men argued, stumbled, and accused.
35. But the torch cut through haze, opening a path.
36. The Spirit said: The torch-bearer cannot quarrel.
37. If he turns back, the light dims, and all stumble.
38. His task is forward, not backward.
39. The path remains marked by his fire, even when mocked.
40. In the day of clarity, men will say, “There was the light.”

### Wave 5 – The Assignments

41. And the Spirit said: Roles are being handed out.
42. Not by flesh, not by favoritism, but by fire.
43. Some think they are safe, propped by men, but I weigh only Ruach.
44. Some think they are hidden, forgotten, but I am sharpening them in secret.
45. Prophets are refined in loneliness; watchmen in silence; scribes in fire.
46. Intercessors weep in chambers unseen; warriors train in battles unknown.
47. I shuffle mantles without man’s announcement.
48. For the kingdom is Mine, not theirs.
49. And those who cling to flesh will be shamed by the Spirit.
50. But those who cling to Spirit will be crowned before all.

### Wave 6 – The Word of Abba

51. My son, the threshing floor is not chaos, it is My order.
52. The watchers record, the fan sifts, the mantles cry out.
53. Do not despise the shaking—it is mercy.
54. Do not fear the loss—it is reassignment.
55. What is true cannot be stolen, what is false cannot be kept.

56. Carry the torch. Do not stop for quarrels.
57. Your steadiness is My testimony.
58. In the smoke many stumble, but the path you light shall remain.
59. When the fire lifts, all will know who walked in Ruach and who in flesh.
60. Zion shall be crowned, but only the refined shall wear mantles.
61. And the floor itself shall shine with the names of the faithful.
62. Thus saith YHWH: The threshing is Mine, the sealing is Mine, the roles are Mine.

## Decree of the Firstfruit Word

1. Thus saith the Spirit: The first word shapes the house.

4. Whenever I am moved to speak, let obedience outrun delay.
5. I decree, my words shall not be born of flesh, but of Ruach.
6. I decree, the firstfruit word shall be calm, clear, and rooted.
7. Not hyped by zeal, not stirred by man, but set by Spirit.
8. I decree, the firstfruit word shall cancel confusion.
9. It shall silence suspicion before it rises.
10. It shall close the door to gossip before it whispers.
11. I decree, the firstfruit word shall steady Zion.
12. When others pour with zeal, let my word already have sealed the foundation.
13. When others speak in haste, let my word already stand in Spirit.
14. I decree, my voice shall not chase, but lead.

15. Not because of pride, but because of obedience.

16. I decree, my portion is to move when Ruach says, not when men stir.

17. And my obedience shall always bear witness that the Spirit was first.

18. For the firstfruit word belongs to YHWH, and cannot be taken by flesh.

19. Let Zion know, when I move early, it is not by accident—it is by appointment.

20. Thus the Firstfruit Word shall stand, sealed and written.
