

## The Decree

## The Prophetic Flow of the Fall

Trumpets (1 Tishri → 4): Decree of Babylon's fall, the gavel of heaven drops.

Days of Awe (1–10 Tishri): Separation and sealing. Saints hearken to the trumpet call.

Atonement (10 Tishri): The shofar of Jubilee. Babylon's claims are void. Captives walk free.

Tabernacles (15–22 Tishri): The King dwells with Zion. His reign is visible among His people.

Jeremiah 51:6–8 – Babylon suddenly fallen.

Daniel 7:22,27 – Judgment given to the saints, kingdom handed over.

Revelation 18:2–8,10,17–19 – Babylon judged in one hour.

Revelation 21 – The tabernacle of God is with men.
