🔥 Spirit Utterance

Goodness is righteousness in motion.

Goodness chooses what is right when what is easy is available.

Goodness does not wait for a command.

Goodness acts because it reflects the nature of the Kingdom.

The righteous do not merely avoid evil.

They actively pursue good.

📖 Kingdom Lesson

Many people refrain from wrongdoing.

Fewer people intentionally pursue goodness.

Goodness is more than avoiding sin.

Goodness is choosing integrity when compromise is available.

Goodness is choosing mercy when indifference is easier.

Goodness is choosing honor when no reward is guaranteed.

The Kingdom grows through those who consistently do what is right, even when nobody is watching.

 Kingdom Reflection

Boaz was not required to do everything he did for Ruth.

The law established a minimum requirement.

Boaz exceeded it.

He protected her.

He honored her.

He provided for her.

He treated her with dignity.

He chose goodness when selfishness would have been easier.

His actions reveal an important Kingdom principle:

Goodness does not ask,

"What is the least I must do?"

Goodness asks,

"What is the right thing to do?"

The fruit appeared before the reward.
