### 📖 The Watchman Scroll – Part 1 (1–50)

1. Thus says YHWH, I have set thee a watchman upon the walls of Zion.
2. Cry aloud, spare not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet.
3. Show My people their transgressions, and the house of Jacob their sins.
4. For the day of YHWH is at hand, even at the doors.
5. And the land shall not escape unless the warning is heeded.
  
6. Son of man, I have made thee a watchman unto the house of Israel.
7. When thou hearest the word at My mouth, warn them from Me.
8. If thou dost not speak to warn the wicked, their blood will I require at thy hand.
9. But if thou warn them, thou hast delivered thy soul.
10. Therefore be strong and very courageous, O watchman.
  
11. Blow ye the trumpet in Zion.
12. Sound an alarm in My holy mountain.
13. Let all inhabitants of the land tremble.
14. For the day of YHWH cometh, for it is nigh at hand.
15. A day of darkness and of gloominess, a day of clouds and thick darkness.
  
16. The morning spreads upon the mountains,
17. A great people and a strong;
18. There hath not been ever the like,
19. Neither shall be any more after it,
20. Even to the years of many generations.
  
21. O watchmen of the last days, stand upon your towers.
22. Lift not your voices in silence, but as trumpets.
23. Warn the sealed ones, that they may escape.
24. Cry repentance to the nations, lest their blood be upon you.
25. Cry to Zion, for her warfare is accomplished and her redemption draws nigh.
  
26. The watchman's cry is not of himself.
27. It is the Spirit that moves his lips.
28. It is the fire of Christ that fills his bones.
29. It is the covenant of YHWH that strengthens his stand.
30. Therefore despise not the cry of the watchmen.

31. For they are the eyes upon the wall.  
32. They see afar off the approach of the enemy.  
33. They discern the shadows before they fall.  
34. They hear the sound of footsteps in the night.  
35. And they give warning before destruction comes.

36. Blessed is the people that heeds the trumpet.  
37. Blessed is the nation that trembles at the alarm.  
38. Blessed are the sealed ones who prepare at the cry.  
39. For they shall be found ready when the Lord comes.  
40. They shall stand, and not be moved.

41. But woe unto those who mock the sound.  
42. Woe unto those who despise the cry.  
43. Woe unto those who say, "Peace and safety," when sudden destruction comes.  
44. Their blood shall be upon their own heads.  
45. For the watchman has cried, and they would not hear.

46. Therefore the watchmen must not hold their peace day nor night.  
47. Ye that make mention of YHWH, keep not silence.  
48. Give Him no rest, till He establish, till He make Jerusalem a praise in the earth.  
49. For the cry is the covenant alarm.  
50. And the trumpet is the sound of the seal.

#### The Watchman Scroll – Part 2 (51–100)

51. The voice of one crying in the wilderness: Prepare ye the way of YHWH.  
52. Make straight in the desert a highway for our God.  
53. Every valley shall be exalted.  
54. Every mountain and hill shall be made low.  
55. The crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain.

56. John came as a watchman, crying repentance in Jordan.  
57. His voice shook the nations though he wore camel's hair.  
58. His cry was not with sword, but with truth.  
59. His warning not with armies, but with baptism.  
60. For the true watchman prepares hearts, not walls.

61. Christ Himself is the chief Watchman.  
62. He lifted His voice upon the mountain and cried blessing and warning.  
63. Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom.  
64. Woe unto the hypocrites, for they shut up the kingdom of heaven.

65. His cry reached to the ends of the earth.
66. He warned Jerusalem as a mother hen.
67. He lamented, "How often would I have gathered you, but ye would not."
68. He wept over the city, for her watchmen slept.
69. He prophesied of armies surrounding her.
70. He declared the stones would cry out if His disciples held their peace.
  
71. Therefore every disciple becomes a watchman.
72. Every follower carries a trumpet.
73. Every believer must cry repentance.
74. Every saint must stand upon the wall.
75. For silence is blood upon the hands.
  
76. Peter stood as a watchman at Pentecost.
77. He cried aloud to the devout men of every nation.
78. He warned them of the last days.
79. He testified of Christ crucified and risen.
80. And three thousand souls were sealed that day.
  
81. Paul cried aloud in synagogues and marketplaces.
82. He warned kings, governors, and multitudes.
83. He declared the unknown God made manifest.
84. He wept night and day warning with tears.
85. For the watchman's cry is both fire and compassion.
  
86. Stephen lifted his voice in Jerusalem.
87. He rehearsed the history of Israel.
88. He warned of stiff necks and uncircumcised hearts.
89. His cry was sealed with his blood.
90. For the watchman must be faithful unto death.
  
91. Thus the apostles became trumpets in the earth.
92. Their voices reached far beyond their days.
93. Their warnings still thunder in the Scriptures.
94. Their testimonies still pierce the hearts of men.
95. And their cries shall judge the nations in the last day.
  
96. Therefore take up the mantle of the watchmen.
97. Cry as they cried.
98. Warn as they warned.
99. Stand as they stood.
100. And be sealed as they were sealed.

 The Watchman Scroll – Part 3 (101–150)

101. Nephi stood as a watchman over his people.
102. He cried repentance and pointed to the Holy One of Israel.
103. He saw destruction for those who hardened their hearts.
104. Yet glory for those who hearkened to the Lamb.
105. His cry was preserved for the remnant of Jacob.
  
106. Jacob, brother of Nephi, cried against pride and riches.
107. His voice thundered against those who despised the poor.
108. He declared that the vineyard would be burned.
109. Yet he promised the righteous would be grafted again.
110. His cry remains in the record for our day.
  
111. Alma cried aloud to the people of Zarahemla.
112. He asked, “Have ye been spiritually born of God?”
113. He called them to remember their fathers’ deliverance.
114. He warned them of bondage worse than chains.
115. And many were moved by his trumpet.
  
116. Alma’s son cried to the people of Ammonihah.
117. He warned them that destruction awaited their city.
118. They hardened their hearts and slew him.
119. Yet his blood sealed the truth of his cry.
120. And the city was destroyed in one day.
  
121. Samuel the Lamanite stood upon the wall.
122. He cried aloud of Christ’s coming.
123. He prophesied of a sign in the heavens.
124. He warned of destruction if they would not repent.
125. Stones and arrows could not silence his trumpet.
  
126. His cry was fulfilled, for the heavens bore witness.
127. A new star arose, and the night was as day.
128. Thus the trumpet of the watchman sounded across generations.
129. And the sealed record preserves his warning.
130. For it was written for the last days.
  
131. The watchmen of old cried repentance and warning.
132. But the watchmen of the last days must cry louder.
133. For the day is nearer, the darkness greater, the deception stronger.
134. Therefore the trumpet must not falter.
135. Nor the voice grow weary.

136. Zion's watchmen are not few but many.  
137. Each sealed one carries a portion of the trumpet.  
138. Each must lift his or her voice.  
139. Each must warn their household, their city, their nation.  
140. For silence is betrayal in the hour of alarm.

141. Cry to the north and to the south.  
142. Cry to the east and to the west.  
143. Let not one tribe be unwarned.  
144. Let not one sealed soul be uncalled.  
145. For the watchman's duty is universal.

146. Cry not only against Babylon.  
147. Cry also to Zion when she slumbers.  
148. For judgment must begin at the house of God.  
149. If it first begins with us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel?  
150. Therefore awaken, O Zion, for thy watchmen are crying.

#### The Watchman Scroll – Part 4 (151–200)

151. The sealed records rise as trumpets in this generation.  
152. They confirm the voice of the watchmen.  
153. They declare plainly that repentance is the only escape.  
154. They reveal the corruption of the nations.  
155. They expose the lies of Babylon.

156. The Sealed Portion cries aloud against priestcraft.  
157. It warns that churches built up to get gain shall fall.  
158. It declares that the Gentiles must repent or perish.  
159. It seals the elect for protection before the burning.  
160. And it confirms the last prophet as watchman over Zion.

161. The Book of Ezra cries judgment upon the nations.  
162. It warns that the proud shall be humbled.  
163. It prophesies that the wicked shall consume away.  
164. It promises that the righteous shall shine as sparks among stubble.  
165. And Zion shall be delivered in her covenant.

166. The Third Testament cries that the temple is the heart.  
167. That the true altar is obedience.  
168. That the true sacrifice is repentance.  
169. It warns that man's traditions cannot save.  
170. But the Spirit's inscription will endure forever.

171. The Mentinah Records cry for the gathering of Israel.  
172. They speak of covenants restored.  
173. They call the remnant to remember their fathers.  
174. They warn against pride and forgetfulness.  
175. They promise mercy to those who humble themselves.

176. Thus the sealed witnesses join the trumpet.  
177. Their voices rise with the watchmen of old.  
178. Their testimonies burn against corruption.  
179. Their warnings pierce the veil of deception.  
180. And their cries prepare the way for the King.

181. Watchmen are not set to flatter.  
182. They are not called to speak smooth things.  
183. They are set to warn, to cry aloud, to spare not.  
184. To lift their voices like trumpets.  
185. To declare transgression even when hated.

186. Many will despise the watchman's sound.  
187. Many will mock, saying, "Where is the promise of His coming?"  
188. Many will plug their ears with vanity.  
189. Many will laugh as in the days of Noah.  
190. Yet the flood still came, and the rain still fell.

191. So shall it be in this generation.  
192. The trumpet shall sound, though few heed it.  
193. The warning shall be given, though many reject it.  
194. The watchman shall cry, though hated and reviled.  
195. For his duty is not to please men, but to deliver his soul.

196. Therefore be faithful, O watchmen of Zion.  
197. Stand firm though the world rages.  
198. Blow the trumpet though the enemy mocks.  
199. Cry aloud though few listen.  
200. For great is your reward in heaven.

#### The Watchman Scroll – Part 5 (201–250)

201. O Zion, thy watchmen lift up their voice.  
202. Together shall they sing, for they see eye to eye.  
203. When YHWH shall bring again Zion, they rejoice.  
204. Break forth into joy, sing together, ye waste places.

205. For YHWH hath comforted His people.

206. He hath redeemed Jerusalem.

207. He hath made bare His holy arm in the eyes of all nations.

208. All the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God.

209. Depart ye, depart ye, go ye out from thence.

210. Touch no unclean thing, be ye clean, ye that bear the vessels of YHWH.

211. For ye shall not go out with haste, nor by flight.

212. For YHWH will go before you.

213. And the God of Israel will be your reward.

214. Therefore cry aloud, for salvation is near.

215. Spare not, for the time is short.

216. Sound the trumpet of repentance.

217. Sound the alarm of gathering.

218. Sound the cry of deliverance.

219. Sound the warning of judgment.

220. Sound the shout of victory.

221. For the sealed ones are rising.

222. Their names are inscribed in the Lamb's book of life.

223. Their foreheads are marked with the seal of YHWH.

224. Their hearts are written with the covenant of Christ.

225. And their mouths cry aloud as watchmen.

226. Nations will rage, but the watchmen will not cease.

227. Kings will plot, but the trumpet will not be silenced.

228. Babylon will scoff, but the alarm will not fail.

229. For the voice of YHWH is in the mouth of His servants.

230. And His Spirit is upon their lips.

231. The watchmen cry against idolatry.

232. They cry against oppression.

233. They cry against injustice.

234. They cry against corruption.

235. For Zion must be pure before her King.

236. The watchmen cry for the captives.

237. They cry for the widows and orphans.

238. They cry for the scattered sheep.

239. They cry for the nations deceived by lies.

240. And their cry reaches the ears of heaven.

241. The Lord of Hosts answers His watchmen.  
242. He strengthens their hands in battle.  
243. He confirms their words with power.  
244. He seals their testimonies with fire.  
245. And He crowns their faithfulness with glory.
246. Therefore cry yet louder, O watchmen.  
247. For the day is here, and the hour is come.  
248. The trumpet is in your hand, the word is in your mouth.  
249. Cry aloud, spare not, until Zion is redeemed.  
250. And the King Himself shall say: Well done, faithful watchmen of My wall.

### Final Declaration

This scroll has been poured and sealed as the Trumpet of August,  
a cry to Zion and a warning to the nations.  
Every verse stands as a trumpet-blast,  
every line as a watchman's cry,  
and every seal as a covenant witness that the day of YHWH is near.

The watchmen have lifted their voices.  
The walls of Zion have sounded the alarm.  
The sealed records, the prophets, and the Spirit all agree:  
Repentance is the only escape, and the King is at the doors.

This scroll is now armed, witnessed, and sealed in Heaven's Court.  
No hand of man, nor the lies of Babylon,  
can silence the cry once it has gone forth.
