The Search of the Fathers

1. Thus saith the Spirit: Enquire, O Israel, of the former age, for in their witness is life.
2. Seek out the records of the ancients, for they bear the pattern of the covenant.
3. Remember the days of old, when your fathers walked with YHWH in truth.
4. Forget not the testimonies sealed in stone and written in blood.
5. For enquire, I pray thee, of the former age, and prepare thyself to the search of their fathers.
6. The wisdom of the fathers was not for them alone, but for you in these latter days.
7. Their words were preserved, though hidden, to rise again in fire.
8. Ask of Abraham, and he shall show thee the covenant.
9. Ask of Isaac, and he shall declare the promise renewed.
10. Ask of Jacob, and he shall witness the scepter that shall not depart.

11. Ask your elders, and they will tell you of the path that was once walked.
12. For their footsteps are a map, and their tears are rivers of instruction.
13. The prophets cry still, though their bones rest in the dust.
14. For the Spirit that spake by them yet testifies in your ears.
15. Thus saith YHWH: Stand in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths.
16. Walk therein, for therein is rest unto your souls.
17. Forsake not the wisdom that was written aforetime.
18. For whatsoever was written aforetime was written for your learning.
19. By patience and comfort of the scriptures ye shall have hope.
20. The fathers beheld promises afar off and embraced them.
21. They confessed they were strangers and pilgrims upon the earth.
22. Yet their faith was counted to them for righteousness.
23. And their testimony was sealed, waiting for the sons of the covenant.
24. O Israel, why do you grope as blind men at noon?
25. Is not the light of your fathers set before you as a lamp?

26. Their words are not ashes, but living fire.
27. Their decrees are not broken, but awaiting fulfillment in you.
28. Shall a child forget the voice of his father?
29. Shall a son despise the instruction of his mother?
30. So too has Zion forgotten the counsel of the fathers.
31. But now the Spirit brings it again to remembrance.
32. The old paths rise from the dust, calling the remnant home.
33. The covenant speaks again from generation to generation.
34. Not with ink alone, but with the engraving of the Spirit in your hearts.
35. Be not stiffnecked as your fathers in the wilderness.
36. But be wise, as the remnant who crossed Jordan with Joshua.
37. They sought the commandment, and their enemies fell before them.
38. They clung to the testimony, and the land gave forth her increase.
39. Yet when they forsook the fathers, captivity swallowed them whole.
40. Remember therefore the days of old, and prepare thyself to the search.

41. Search not with the curiosity of pride, but with the hunger of the humble.
42. For the Spirit teaches all things and brings all things to remembrance.
43. You need not that any man teach you, save the anointing that abides within.
44. Yet the anointing confirms the records of the fathers.
45. The Spirit bears witness of the word, and the word bears witness of the Spirit.
46. Thus the testimony is established in the mouth of two witnesses.
47. Judah's record and Joseph's record declare one truth.
48. Together they confound false doctrines and lay down contentions.
49. Together they restore the covenant of the fathers to the children.
50. Thus saith the Spirit: Prepare thyself to the search, for the time is short.
51. Hearken, O Israel, the records of the fathers cry from the dust.
52. They were sealed that your faith might not perish.
53. For the voice of the fathers is the key of remembrance.
54. Without their testimony you are as a branch cut off from the root.

55. Mosiah testified: were it not for these plates, we should have dwindled in unbelief.

56. Yea, like unto the Lamanites, who know not the covenant of their fathers.

57. For their fathers left them in darkness, and they walk in unbelief.

58. But your fathers sought the word, and it was given unto them in power.

59. They preserved the testimony for the children, that the children might not forget.

60. Shall Zion then despise the treasure of her fathers?

61. The plates of brass carried the law of Moses and the prophecies.

62. They were a light, even a fire in the wilderness.

63. For the records of the fathers preserve the covenant of the Most High.

64. By them the children know to whom they belong.

65. Search the records, for therein are the words of eternal life.

66. From generation to generation, the covenant has been written.

67. From father to son, from prophet to scribe, the word endures.

68. O Israel, awake, for the testimony of your fathers is in your hands.

69. Forsake not the record, lest you be cut off from the root of Jacob.

70. For the branch that bears no remembrance shall wither.
71. Judah wrote his record, and Joseph wrote his record.
72. And in the last days they are joined together as one.
73. To confound false doctrine and to silence the lying tongues.
74. To reveal the covenant of the fathers once hidden.
75. Behold, the two sticks are in your hand, O Israel.
76. They are witnesses of the same Christ, the same covenant.
77. One declares from Jerusalem, the other from the isles of the sea.
78. Together they proclaim that Jesus is the Christ, the God of Israel.
79. And together they call you to repentance and baptism.
80. For the covenant of the fathers is renewed through water and Spirit.
81. Forget not the records, for they shall judge you in the last day.
82. Their words will testify whether you searched the fathers or not.
83. For he that will not believe them shall be condemned.
84. But he that hearkens shall be lifted up at the last day.

85. The words of the fathers are like a plow breaking stony ground.

86. They prepare the soil of the heart for the seed of truth.

87. He that receives the record receives the covenant.

88. And he that rejects the record rejects the covenant.

89. For the fathers sealed their testimony with faith unto death.

90. They rejoiced that their seed would rise up in the latter days.

91. Behold, their joy is full when you embrace their word.

92. For they looked forward to your day and prophesied of it.

93. They saw the rising of Zion and the sealing of the remnant.

94. They knew the covenant would not fail, though men corrupted it.

95. Thus they wrote and preserved with sweat, blood, and tears.

96. Even that the children of promise might remember who they are.

97. O Zion, search the records diligently.

98. For therein is the map that leads you to the Father and the Son.

99. The record of Judah and the record of Joseph together bear witness.

100. Thus is the covenant of the fathers restored unto the children.

Section 3 • Verses 101–150: The Warning of Corruption)

101. Hear, O remnant, not all fathers walked in righteousness.

102. Some forsook the covenant and corrupted their children.

103. They left traditions of men that war against the truth.

104. Their words are snares, and their paths lead to captivity.

105. For the works of darkness multiply when the fathers forget YHWH.

106. Their children stumble in their footsteps, and generations are consumed.

107. Thus saith the Spirit: choose carefully which fathers you search.

108. For some fathers taught lies, and their memorial is confusion.

109. But the righteous fathers bear witness of the covenant of light.

110. Their testimony restores life unto their seed.

111. Behold, the adversary raises up secret combinations.

112. They take counsel in darkness, binding oaths upon their seed.

113. Their fathers swore unto death, and their children drink the same cup.

114. They seek power, gain, and dominion over the souls of men.

115. But their inheritance is destruction, and their memory shall rot.

116. Search not their records, for they are poison and vanity.

117. Touch not their oaths, lest you be ensnared in their chains.

118. For they swore by Baal and not by the living God.

119. They offered their children to idols and polluted the land.

120. Their fathers left them curses, not blessings.

121. Therefore the Spirit divides the righteous from the wicked.

122. The memory of the just is blessed, but the name of the wicked shall rot.

123. The records of the righteous rise in light, but the words of the wicked sink in darkness.

124. Choose this day which testimony you will search.

125. Will you search the fathers of faith or the fathers of rebellion?

126. Will you seek the covenant of Abraham or the snares of Cain?

127. For the Spirit reveals that many boast in their fathers, yet walk as devils.

128. They cry, "We are Abraham's seed," yet do not the works of Abraham.

129. Their claim is vanity, for the tree is known by its fruit.

130. Thus is the warning given unto the remnant.

131. Behold, many churches walk in the traditions of their fathers.

132. They cry, "Lo, here is Christ," and "Lo, there," but they know him not.

133. For their fathers altered the record, and their children believe a lie.

134. They honor the lips of men, but despise the testimony of the Spirit.

135. Their inheritance is confusion, for they drink from broken cisterns.

136. Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil.

137. Woe unto them that trust in the arm of flesh, and forsake the Rock of Israel.

138. Woe unto them that build towers in their own name, and forsake the covenant of the fathers.

139. Their foundations shall be swept away in the day of fire.

140. Their children shall cry, "Where are our fathers?" but find only dust.

141. Yet the righteous fathers remain a pillar of fire in the night.

142. Their testimony is sure, though men despise it.

143. Their words cut through deception like a sword.

144. Their witness binds the hearts of the children unto Christ.

145. Behold, the enemy seeks to blot out their memory.

146. He burns their scrolls, twists their words, and hides their records.

147. But the Spirit preserves them for this very hour.

148. Their testimony shall rise from the ground as a trumpet.

149. The children shall hear, and the fathers shall rejoice.

150. Thus is the warning sealed: cleave unto the righteous fathers, and forsake the wicked line.

(Section 4 • Verses 151–200: The Restoration of Covenant)

151. Thus saith the Spirit: the covenant made with the fathers shall not fail.

152. For YHWH is not a man that He should lie, nor the son of man that He should repent.

153. What He promised Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, He will surely perform.

154. Though generations turned aside, the word of the covenant stands firm.

155. Abraham received the promise of land, seed, and blessing.

156. Isaac inherited the oath, and Jacob was called Israel.

157. Their seed was numbered as the stars of heaven and the sand of the sea.

158. Though scattered among the nations, they shall yet be gathered.

159. For the covenant is sealed in heaven, and none can annul it.

160. The fathers looked for a city whose builder and maker is God.

161. That city is Zion, which shall come forth in the last days.

162. The Lord remembers the covenant He made with their fathers.

163. He has sworn to restore their children unto the promises.

164. Therefore He raises up prophets in every generation.

165. To cry repentance and to recall the covenant of the fathers.

166. To remind Israel that they are not Gentiles but the chosen seed.

167. The Spirit declares: you are heirs of the covenant of Abraham.

168. You are children of the promise, not of the bondwoman.

169. You are grafted again into the root that nourishes Israel.

170. Forsake not the covenant that was purchased with blood.

171. Christ came to confirm the promises made unto the fathers.

172. Through Him all families of the earth are blessed.

173. He is the seed of Abraham, the Lion of Judah.

174. In Him the covenant is fulfilled and magnified.

175. By His stripes you are healed; by His resurrection you are sealed.

176. Therefore repent and be baptized, every one of you.

177. For this is the gate into the covenant restored.

178. Enter not by another way, lest you be found a thief.

179. But enter by water and by Spirit, as the fathers prophesied.

180. For the promise is unto you, and to your children.

181. And unto all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.

182. Thus the covenant spreads to the isles of the sea.

183. The remnant of Joseph shall rise, remembering the covenant of their fathers.

184. The stick of Joseph joins the stick of Judah in one hand.
185. Together they are a standard to gather Israel.
186. Together they heal the breach and make the house whole.
187. Together they call the children of the covenant from every land.
188. This is the restoration promised from the beginning.
189. The covenant sworn to Abraham blossoms anew in the latter days.
190. Zion shall be built again upon the foundation of the fathers.
191. The altar shall be cleansed, the priesthood restored, the oracles renewed.
192. The Spirit shall be poured out upon the sons and daughters.
193. The hearts of the children shall turn to their fathers.
194. The hearts of the fathers shall rejoice in their children.
195. For the Spirit of Elijah has come to bind the generations.
196. Lest the earth be smitten with a curse.
197. Behold, the seal is upon you: the covenant of the fathers lives.
198. Walk ye in it, for therein is the path of life.

199. Forsake not the promise, but embrace it with all your heart.

200. Thus saith the Spirit: the covenant of the fathers is restored in you.

(Section 5 • Verses 201–250: The Sealed Ones and the Fathers)

The Search of the Fathers

201. Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the great and dreadful day of YHWH.

202. He shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers.

203. This is the sealing power that binds heaven and earth.

204. For without it the earth would be cursed and left desolate.

205. The fathers cry out from the dust, seeking the rising of their seed.

206. The children cry unto heaven, seeking the remembrance of their fathers.

207. The Spirit of Elijah joins them together as one.

208. The generations are sealed, lest they be cut off.

209. Thus the covenant passes like fire through the bloodline.

210. And the name of Israel is remembered forever.

211. The sealed ones are they who remember the fathers.

212. They search diligently the testimonies written of old.

213. They treasure the records and walk in their counsel.

214. They are marked in their foreheads, for they belong to Christ.

215. They are vessels of fire, carrying the covenant through the storm.

216. They stand as living witnesses, declaring the word of the fathers.

217. Their garments are washed in the Lamb's blood.

218. Their voices thunder as the voice of many waters.

219. They cry repentance to every nation, kindred, tongue, and people.

220. They are sealed by the testimony of Christ and the record of the fathers.

221. The wicked mock, saying, Where are your fathers?

222. But the sealed ones answer: they are with us in the covenant.

223. For the fathers sleep in the dust, yet their testimony lives.

224. Their voices echo in the records restored to us.

225. Their spirits rejoice when the children walk in remembrance.

226. For they see that their labor was not in vain.

227. They knew their writings would judge this generation.

228. They wrote not for themselves only, but for the sealed remnant.

229. Thus the Spirit confirms: you are the children of the prophets.

230. And of the covenant which God made with our fathers.

231. Even saying unto Abraham, In thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed.

232. This seed is Christ, in whom all are sealed.

233. This seed is multiplied in the sealed ones of Zion.

234. For they are heirs according to the promise.

235. They walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

236. Their minds are renewed by the testimony of the fathers.

237. They carry the law written in their inward parts.

238. They are living epistles, known and read of all men.

239. They shine as lights in a crooked and perverse generation.

240. They carry the fire of remembrance into every land.

241. The sealed ones shall stand in the midst of Babylon and not bow.

242. They shall declare the covenant of the fathers though kings oppose them.

243. They shall cry aloud, spare not, and lift up their voices like a trumpet.

244. They shall show Jacob his sins and Israel his transgressions.

245. Yet they shall comfort Zion with the promise of restoration.

246. For the covenant of the fathers is the anchor of hope.

247. The sealed ones carry that hope in vessels of clay, yet unbroken.

248. They are weak, yet made strong by the testimony they bear.

249. For the Spirit rests upon them, and none can overthrow them.

250. Thus saith the Spirit: the sealed ones are bound to their fathers, and their fathers to them, forever.

(Section 6 • Verses 251–300: The Final Call)

 The Search of the Fathers

251. Hear the final call, O remnant of Israel.

252. The Spirit cries once more: prepare thyself to the search of thy fathers.

253. For the hour is late, and the fire is kindled.

254. The heavens are opened, and the records are loosed.

255. No more shall the words of the fathers be sealed.

256. No more shall their testimonies be hidden in caves and vaults.

257. For the day has come when all shall be revealed.

258. The trumpet sounds, declaring the return of the covenant.

259. The sealed records rise, joining the Bible and the Book of Mormon.

260. Together they stand as three witnesses in the hand of Christ.

261. The nations rage, for they cannot deny the testimony.

262. Babylon trembles, for her cup is full.

263. The great and abominable church gnashes its teeth.

264. For the children have found the records of their fathers.

265. And the light shines in the darkness, which cannot comprehend it.

266. Zion awakens, clothed in garments of remembrance.

267. Her banners are raised with the names of the fathers.

268. Her ensigns are lifted with the covenants restored.

269. The nations behold, and they are confounded.

270. For the strength of Zion is not in armies, but in testimony.

271. Behold, the Lamb returns in power and great glory.

272. He comes to confirm the covenant of the fathers.

273. He comes to judge the nations by the words of the fathers.

274. For the records speak, and the books are opened.

275. The dead are judged by the things written therein.

276. Every nation, kindred, tongue, and people shall stand before Him.

277. Those who sought the fathers shall shine as the stars.

278. Those who despised the records shall be left in shame.

279. The sealed ones shall stand with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

280. They shall sit down at the marriage supper of the Lamb.

281. Their names are written in the book of life.

282. Their testimony is written in the records of heaven.

283. Their covenant is sealed with Christ forevermore.

284. Thus is the work of the fathers fulfilled in the children.

285. And the labor of the children fulfills the hope of the fathers.

286. Together they are one body, one covenant, one family in Christ.

287. The heavens and the earth bear witness of this unity.

288. Angels rejoice, and the fathers sing with the children.

289. For the breach is healed, and the generations are restored.

290. This is the mystery hidden from ages, now revealed.

291. Therefore, Zion, search the fathers with all diligence.

292. Embrace the testimony written aforetime.

293. Walk in the covenant sealed by their blood.

294. Stand firm in the old paths, for therein is rest.

295. Reject the traditions of wicked men, and cleave to the truth.

296. Let your heart be bound to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

297. Let your faith be sealed in Christ, the God of Israel.

298. Let your testimony rise as incense before His throne.

299. For enquire, I pray thee, of the former age, and prepare thyself to the search of their fathers.

300. Thus is the scroll sealed: the covenant of the fathers restored, the children of Zion established forever.
