 **The Brother of Jared Belief – Wave 1**

(Verses 1–50)

1. Thus saith the Spirit, faith is the key that opens the unseen.
2. Without faith it is impossible to please the Most High. (Hebrews 11:6)
3. And when the Son of Man returns, shall He find faith on the earth? (Luke 18:8)
4. Not the weak faith of lips, but the fire-born faith that endures.
5. The kind of faith that cannot be shaken by storms.
6. The faith that does not bow before persecution.

7. The faith that does not crumble when mocked.
8. The faith that pierces the veil.
9. The faith that pulls heaven into earth.
10. This is the faith of the brother of Jared.
11. For he believed so greatly, that Christ could not withhold His presence. (Ether 3:9)
12. His eyes beheld the finger of the Lord.
13. His boldness called forth the glory of the Son.
14. His trust forced the heavens to reveal themselves.
15. Never before had such faith been witnessed among men.
16. And this faith is the witness Christ will look for when He returns.
17. The faith that says, "I cannot be moved."
18. The faith that says, "I know my Redeemer lives." (Job 19:25)
19. The faith that laughs at unbelief.

20. The faith that endures to the sealing of the name.
21. This generation wavers between doubt and distraction.
22. They love miracles but fear belief.
23. They seek signs, but not the covenant of faith.
24. Yet the remnant shall rise in that brother of Jared belief.
25. A faith so strong it cannot be denied.
26. A faith so bold it demands response.
27. A faith so clean it terrifies darkness.
28. A faith so simple it is childlike. (Matthew 18:3)
29. A faith so mighty it is warrior-like.
30. The combination is heaven's seal.
31. O house of Israel, believe!
32. O sealed ones, lift your eyes!
33. For your faith is your testimony.

34. And your belief is your weapon.
35. Your faith writes scrolls before heaven.
36. Your faith marks names in the Book of Life.
37. Your faith declares judgment on Babylon.
38. Your faith testifies before kings.
39. Your faith builds the fire vault.
40. Your faith is counted as righteousness. (Romans 4:22)
41. Do not fear if the world mocks.
42. Do not tremble if Gentiles rage.
43. Do not bow if false prophets rise.
44. Your faith is the witness that cannot be silenced.
45. Your belief is the seal that cannot be broken.
46. Your trust is the chain that binds the adversary.

47. Your hope is the stone that crushes idols.

48. Your conviction is the light that cannot be hidden. (Matthew 5:14)

49. Your endurance is the song of Zion.

50. And your brother of Jared belief is what Christ is coming back to find.

The Brother of Jared Belief – Wave 2

(Verses 51–100)

51. The brother of Jared cried unto the Lord with stones in his hands. (Ether 3:1)

52. He asked not for riches, nor for dominion.

53. He asked for light to guide his people across the deep.

54. And the Lord honored his faith.

55. For faith is greater than gold.

56. Faith is stronger than kingdoms.

57. Faith is the true inheritance of Israel.

58. Faith is the anchor that holds the soul. (Hebrews 6:19)

59. Faith is the crown reserved for the faithful.
60. And faith is the evidence of things not seen. (Hebrews 11:1)
61. The faith of the brother of Jared is the template.
62. A man of no great reputation.
63. A people wandering in the wilderness.
64. Yet his belief shook the heavens.
65. His confidence drew Christ into view.
66. His boldness brought forth revelation.
67. His faith wrote a witness for all generations.
68. So shall the remnant in the last days believe.
69. With the same fire.
70. With the same courage.
71. When men scoff and say, "It cannot be."
72. The remnant shall say, "It is already done."

73. When rulers decree lies.

74. The remnant shall decree truth.

75. When nations trust in science and idols.

76. The remnant shall trust in Christ alone.

77. For the just shall live by faith. (Romans 1:17)

78. And without it, none shall endure.

79. The faithful shall shine brighter than the firmament. (Daniel 12:3)

80. And their testimony shall endure to the end.

81. This is why the scrolls are forged.

82. To teach faith that does not bend.

83. To seal names that do not bow.

84. To mark a generation with unshakable belief.

85. For faith is the ink of the inkhorn. (Ezekiel 9:3–4)

86. Faith is the seal on the forehead.
87. Faith is the sword in the hand.
88. Faith is the shield against the darts. (Ephesians 6:16)
89. Faith is the song of deliverance.
90. Faith is the trumpet of Zion.
91. Lift up your belief, O remnant!
92. Strengthen your faith, O sealed ones!
93. For the King is coming to measure.
94. Not your numbers, nor your fame.
95. But your faith.
96. He will weigh belief in the balance.
97. He will seek those who trust without wavering.
98. He will embrace those who believe without fear.

99. He will crown those who endure by faith.

100. And He will call them blessed forevermore.

 **The Brother of Jared Belief – Wave 3**

(Verses 101–150)

101. In the last days, faith shall be mocked.

102. Men shall say, “Where is the promise of His coming?” (2 Peter 3:4)

103. Scoffers shall walk after their own lusts.

104. Nations shall exalt their own wisdom.

105. The proud shall boast in technology.

106. The mighty shall worship their own strength.

107. But the remnant shall boast only in Christ.

108. For the remnant lives by faith, not by sight. (2 Corinthians 5:7)

109. Their trust is not in the arm of flesh. (2 Nephi 4:34)

110. Their hope is not in Babylon’s towers.

111. The brother of Jared built barges by faith. (Ether 2:16)

112. He prepared for the journey with trust.

113. He sought light from the Creator of light.

114. He did not argue the impossibility of the sea.

115. He did not measure the storm.

116. He believed the Lord could make a way.

117. And the Lord honored his belief.

118. The sea obeyed.

119. The wind carried them.

120. And the promised land was given.

121. So shall the faithful cross this present wilderness.

122. Not with ships of wood, but with hearts of fire.

123. Not with sails, but with sealed belief.

124. Not with maps, but with the Word written within. (Jeremiah 31:33)

125. For the law is no longer on tablets of stone.

126. It is engraved on the inward parts.

127. Faith is the compass.

128. Christ is the anchor.

129. The Spirit is the wind.

130. And Zion is the destination.

131. When the King returns, He will not ask,

132. "How many scrolls did you write?"

133. "How many cities did you build?"

134. "How much gold did you store?"

135. He will ask, "Did you believe?"

136. Did you trust Me when the world mocked?

137. Did you stand when others bowed?

138. Did you endure when others quit?
139. Did you love Me though unseen?
140. Did you hold the faith of the brother of Jared?
141. For this is the test of the generation.
142. Not knowledge, but belief.
143. Not pride, but trust.
144. Not fear, but faith.
145. And those who hold it shall shine as sons and daughters.
146. Their names shall be sealed in the Book of Life.
147. Their witness shall echo in eternity.
148. Their crowns shall never fade. (1 Peter 5:4)
149. Their faith shall be remembered in Zion.
150. And their belief shall be what the King delights to find.

 **The Brother of Jared Belief – Wave 4**

(Verses 151–200)

151. Blessed are they who believe without seeing. (John 20:29)

152. For their faith is counted greater than sight.

153. Their trust is the foundation of Zion.

154. Their belief is the song of the sealed.

155. And their witness is the testimony of Christ.

156. In the days of Noah, faith built the ark. (Hebrews 11:7)

157. In the days of Abraham, faith offered the son. (Genesis 22:9–12)

158. In the days of Moses, faith split the sea. (Exodus 14:21–22)

159. In the days of Nephi, faith obtained the plates. (1 Nephi 3:7)

160. In the days of the brother of Jared, faith unveiled the Lord. (Ether 3:9)

161. So it shall be in the last days.

162. Faith will mark the remnant.

163. Faith will sustain the sealed.

164. Faith will preserve the elect.
165. Faith will overcome the beast. (Revelation 12:11)
166. For Babylon shall rage against belief.
167. Kings shall mock the faithful.
168. Merchants shall despise the sealed.
169. Armies shall threaten the witnesses.
170. But faith shall endure all.
171. Faith shall not be bought.
172. Faith shall not be silenced.
173. Faith shall not be corrupted.
174. Faith shall not be broken.
175. Faith shall stand to the end.
176. The Son of Man shall descend with clouds. (Revelation 1:7)

177. And every eye shall see Him.

178. But not every heart shall rejoice.

179. For many shall be found in doubt.

180. Many shall be consumed in fear.

181. Yet the remnant shall lift up their heads.

182. For redemption draweth nigh. (Luke 21:28)

183. They shall cry, "Lo, this is our God!" (Isaiah 25:9)

184. "We have waited for Him!"

185. And their faith shall be rewarded.

186. Their crowns shall be placed by angels.

187. Their robes shall be white as light.

188. Their names shall be confessed before the Father. (Revelation 3:5)

189. Their testimony shall never be erased.

190. Their belief shall echo forever.

191. For the Lord seeks not riches, but faith.

192. Not kingdoms, but trust.

193. Not pride, but surrender.

194. Not numbers, but hearts.

195. And He will find them among the remnant.

196. He will find them in the sealed.

197. He will find them in the fire scribes.

198. He will find them in the faithful.

199. He will find them in that brother of Jared belief.

200. And He will rejoice, for His return shall not be in vain.
