PREFACE — THIS IS NOT A BOOK OF SYMBOLS

This work is not written to decorate understanding.

It is written to extract it.

The visions recorded in Book of Ezekiel have long been approached as mystery, metaphor, or imagery without function.

But what was shown was not confusion—it was order.

Not poetry—it was structure.

Not imagination—it was revelation of a living system.

The problem has never been the vision.

The problem has been the approach.

Most read what is written.

Few draw out what is hidden.

As it is written in Book of Proverbs 20:5,
counsel is deep, and must be drawn out.

And as declared in Book of Habakkuk 2:3,
the vision is appointed—meaning it is not only seen, but timed to be understood.

This work stands at that intersection.

The approach taken here is not traditional commentary.

Each chapter is examined as a functional layer of a system, where:
movement has order

structure has purpose

and spirit governs operation

The standard is not interpretation—it is alignment.

The measure is not what sounds correct—but what moves correctly.

Through the witness of Book of Isaiah 11:2,

it is established that the Spirit is not abstract—it carries attributes that define how a system operates:

wisdom, understanding, counsel, might, knowledge, and fear.

These are not ideas.

Does what is being observed move according to that Spirit?

If not, it is out of order.

Chapter 1 — The Living System

In the thirtieth year, in the fourth month, in the fifth day of the month—
the heavens opened.

Not imagination.

Not symbolism without substance.

The heavens opened...

and what was revealed was not chaos, but order already in motion.

By the river of captivity, the vision did not remove the prophet from the
system—

it showed him the system while still inside the broken one.

This is the first key:

Revelation does not require escape.

It requires opening.

And what opened was not just sight—

it was timing.

For as it is written in Book of Habakkuk 2:3,

the vision is for an appointed time.

So what Ezekiel saw...

was not only what existed—

but what would be understood when the time aligned.

And behold, a whirlwind came out of the north.

Not wind.

Not weather.

Movement.

A great cloud.

Fire folding into itself.
Brightness surrounding it.
And in the midst of the fire—
a color like amber.
Contained fire.
Structured fire.
Not destruction—power held in order.
The north is not mentioned without cause.
It is the place of throne alignment.
The direction of authority.
So what approached...
was not random presence.
It was government drawing near.
Out of the midst came the likeness of four living creatures.
Not figures to be admired.
Not beings to be mythologized.
They were carriers.
Each one had four faces.
The face of a man.
The face of a lion.
The face of an ox.
The face of an eagle.
This was not identity—it was function encoded.
Man—understanding and authority.
Lion—dominion and rulership.
Ox—service and strength.
Eagle—vision and elevation.

Not divided.
Not separate.
All present in one operation.
Their feet were straight.
They did not bend.
They did not wander.
Their path was fixed.
And they went every one straight forward.
They turned not when they went.
This is the second key:
No deviation exists in a system governed by the Spirit.
There is no confusion in direction.
No hesitation in execution.
Only alignment.
Their wings were stretched.
Two covered.
Two moved.
And the sound of their movement
was like great waters.
Like an army in motion.
Like force that cannot be stopped.
Movement with weight.
Movement with purpose.
And between the creatures—fire.
Not outside them.
Not separate from them.
Among them.

Fire moved up and down.
Like coals.
Like lamps.
And out of the fire—lightning.
This is not symbolic energy.
This is:
Power moving within the system itself.
Not external fuel.
Not borrowed strength.
Internal.
Alive.
And the living creatures ran and returned
as the appearance of a flash of lightning.
No delay.
No lag.
Instant execution.
This is not how man moves.
This is how aligned systems move.
Now the vision shifts deeper.
Beside each creature—
a wheel.
And the appearance of the wheels
was like beryl.
And their structure was as a wheel
in the middle of a wheel.
This is not imagery.
This is architecture.

Cycle within cycle.

they went upon their four sides.

And they turned not when they went.

Again—no deviation.

This is repeated because it is foundational.

A system governed by the Spirit

does not correct itself mid-path.

It is already correct.

And the rings of the wheels—

were full of eyes.

Round about.

This is the third key:

The system sees while it moves.

It is not blind.

It does not react late.

It is aware in all directions.

Eyes are not decoration.

They are:

awareness

perception

constant observation

This is what is written in Book of Proverbs 20:5—

Deep waters.

Because most will see “eyes”
and never draw out what they mean.
And when the living creatures went,
the wheels went beside them.
And when the living creatures were lifted up,
the wheels were lifted up.
Because...
the spirit of the living creature was in the wheels.
This is the core.
There is no separation between:
carrier
system
movement
They are one.
Because the Spirit governs all of it.
And this Spirit is not undefined.
For it is written in Book of Isaiah 11:2—
The Spirit carries:
wisdom
understanding
counsel
might
knowledge
fear
So what is being seen is not just motion.
It is:
motion governed by attributes.

Correct movement.
Not just movement.
Above the heads of the creatures—
a firmament.
Like crystal.
Stretched forth.
This is not sky.
This is boundary.
Domain.
A governing layer.
Everything below operates under it.
Nothing breaks it.
And above the firmament—
a throne.
And upon the throne—
the likeness as the appearance of a man.
Now the structure is complete.
Because everything below this point
answers to this level.
From the appearance of his loins upward—fire.
From his loins downward—fire.
And brightness all around.
Like the bow in the cloud.
This is the appearance
of the glory of TMH.
And when Ezekiel saw it—
he fell upon his face.

Because when the system is revealed fully...
there is no standing in self.

THE CODE OF THIS CHAPTER

This is what was shown:

A living system where:

time is structured (wheels)

movement is exact (no turning)

awareness is constant (eyes)

power is internal (fire)

Spirit governs all layers

authority sits above all

And this becomes the measure.

Not doctrine.

Not opinion.

Movement.

If it does not move like this—

it is not aligned.

If it deviates—

it is out of order.

If it lacks awareness—

Book of Isaiah 11:2 → Spirit function

EZEKIEL 2 — THE COMMISSION INTO THE SYSTEM

1. “Son of man, stand upon thy feet” (v.1)

After seeing the full system in Chapter 1...

Ezekiel is told:

Stand.

This is the first transition:

Chapter 1 → revelation

Chapter 2 → responsibility

You don't stay face down forever.

Once you see...

you are required to stand in it.

2. “The Spirit entered into me... and set me upon my feet” (v.2)

He didn't stand by willpower.

The Spirit:

entered him

lifted him

positioned him

This is critical.

Same Spirit from Chapter 1 (that governed the system)

is now:

entering the messenger

Meaning:

He is no longer just observing the system...

he is now being aligned to operate within it.

Isaiah 11:2 Connection

This is where the Spirit shifts from:

external governance → internal operation

Now:

wisdom is in him

understanding is in him

counsel begins to speak through him

3. “I send thee to the children of Israel... a rebellious nation” (v.3)

Now the assignment is revealed.

Not to the nations far off.

Not to strangers.

To:

a rebellious house

Defined as:

transgressors

stiff-hearted

hardened

This is key:

The system is not broken.

The people are out of alignment with it.

4. “They and their fathers have transgressed unto this day” (v.3–4)

This isn’t new rebellion.

This is:

generational misalignment

Meaning:

the system (Chapter 1) stayed consistent

the people drifted over time

This ties back to what you been saying:

Drift is not sudden.

It's accumulated deviation.

5. "Whether they will hear, or whether they will forbear..." (v.5)

Now we hit a major law.

The prophet is told:

It doesn't matter if they:

listen

reject

ignore

Because:

the assignment is not based on response

It's based on:

delivery of truth

Habakkuk 2:3 Connection

The vision is appointed.

So whether they receive it or not...

does not change:

the timing of its release

6. "They shall know that there hath been a prophet among them" (v.5)

Even if they reject it now...

they will recognize it later.

This is pattern:

warning ignored

judgment hits

recognition comes after

7. “Be not afraid of them... though briers and thorns be with thee” (v.6)

Now the environment is described.

Not peaceful.

Not supportive.

But:

resistance

opposition

hostility

Briers, thorns, scorpions

These are not random words.

They describe:

piercing resistance

constant irritation

hidden attacks

Meaning:

The messenger is placed inside friction, not outside it.

8. “Be not afraid of their words... nor dismayed at their looks” (v.6)

Two forms of pressure:

what they say

how they look

So:

verbal attack

silent rejection

Both are designed to:

break alignment

9. “Speak my words unto them” (v.7)

Not:

your opinion

your interpretation

your emotion

But:

my words

This ties directly back to Chapter 1:

The system speaks from above (throne level).

The messenger:

relays—not edits

10. “Be not thou rebellious like that rebellious house” (v.8)

Now it gets real.

The messenger is warned:

Don’t become what you were sent to correct

This is one of the deepest points in the chapter.

Because proximity to rebellion

can cause contamination.

11. “Open thy mouth, and eat what I give thee” (v.8)

Now we move from speaking...

to consuming.

This is not optional.

The message must be:

internalized

digested

absorbed

Before it is spoken.

12. The Scroll Appears (v.9–10)

A hand is sent.

A roll (scroll) is given.

Written:

within

without

And it contains:

lamentations

mourning

woe

Meaning:

The message is not light.

It is:

corrective

confrontational

heavy

And it is fully written already.

Not being created by Ezekiel.

Being delivered to him.

THE FULL BREAKDOWN — EZEKIEL 2 CODE

This chapter shows:

HOW A MAN IS BROUGHT INTO ALIGNMENT WITH THE SYSTEM

He sees (Chapter 1)

He is lifted by the Spirit

He is sent into misalignment

He speaks regardless of response

He resists pressure

He consumes the message

He delivers what was given

THE CORE LAW OF THIS CHAPTER

You don't carry the system until the Spirit enters you.

And you don't speak for it...

until you've eaten what it says.

CONNECTION BACK TO CHAPTER 1

Chapter 1 = perfect system

Chapter 2 = imperfect people + sent messenger

So now we have tension:

system = aligned

people = rebellious

messenger = bridge

Book of Ezekiel — Chapter 3

Same witnesses governing the pull:

Book of Habakkuk 2:3 → appointed release

Book of Proverbs 20:5 → draw it out

Book of Isaiah 11:2 → Spirit function

EZEKIEL 3 — THE WEIGHT OF THE MESSENGER

1. “Eat this roll... go speak” (v.1)

Chapter 2 introduced the scroll.

Now Chapter 3 enforces it.

Not optional anymore.

Order:

Eat

Then go

Then speak

This is law:

No message without ingestion.

2. “I did eat it... it was in my mouth as honey” (v.2–3)

Now this is deep.

The scroll contains:

lamentation

mourning

woe

But tastes like:

honey

Meaning:

Truth can be:

heavy in content

but right in spirit

Because alignment feels right—even when the message is hard.

3. “Go, get thee unto the house of Israel” (v.4)

Again—sent to:

not strangers

not foreign nations

But:

his own people

This is consistent:

Correction begins within the house.

4. “Not to many people of a strange speech...” (v.5–6)

This part gets overlooked but it’s heavy.

He’s told:

If you were sent to people with:

different language

different speech

They would likely listen.

But Israel:

will not hear

Meaning:

This is not an issue of understanding.

It is an issue of:

rebellion despite understanding

5. “All the house of Israel are impudent and hardhearted” (v.7)

Defined clearly:

impudent → resistant, stubborn

hardhearted → unyielding

So the resistance is not accidental.

It is intentional misalignment.

6. “I have made thy face strong against their faces” (v.8)

Now the Spirit adjusts the messenger.

Because the environment is hard...

the messenger must be:

equally firm

7. “As an adamant harder than flint have I made thy forehead” (v.9)

This is serious.

Adamant = unbreakable hardness.

Meaning:

no intimidation

no pressure folding

no emotional collapse

Key law:

The messenger must be harder than the resistance.

8. “All my words... receive in thine heart” (v.10)

Not just eat it.

Now:

receive it in the heart

This moves from:

mouth → taste

to heart → identity

Meaning:

The message becomes:

who you are—not just what you say

9. “Go, get thee to them of the captivity” (v.11)

Now location is emphasized again:

captivity

So:

the people are bound

but still responsible

Captivity does not remove accountability.

10. “Whether they will hear, or whether they will forbear” (v.11)

Repeated again.

Why?

Because this is foundational.

The messenger’s job:

is not dependent on reception

11. The Spirit Lifts Him Again (v.12–14)

Now something happens.

Spirit lifts him

he hears a great rushing

“Blessed be the glory of the Lord from his place”

And the sound of:

wings

wheels

a great rushing

This connects back to Chapter 1

The same system:

creatures

wheels

movement

is still active.

Meaning:

The messenger is now moving WITH the system

Not separate from it.

12. "I went in bitterness... but the hand of the Lord was strong upon me"

(v.14)

Now we see tension.

inward bitterness

outward compulsion

Meaning:

Even when the message is heavy...

the assignment overrides personal feeling

13. "I sat where they sat... astonished seven days" (v.15)

He doesn't speak immediately.

He sits:

among them

in their condition

in silence

For:

seven days

This is key:

Before speaking...

he fully observes

And seven = completion.

So:

He sees the condition completely
before delivering the word.

14. THE WATCHMAN APPOINTMENT (v.16–17)

Now the role is defined.

“I have made thee a watchman”

This is major.

Watchman =

observer

warning system

early detection

Function:

hear from TMH

warn the people

15. The Responsibility of Warning (v.18–21)

Now it gets serious.

Case 1 — Wicked not warned:

they die in sin

BUT their blood is required of the messenger

Case 2 — Wicked warned:

they still die

BUT the messenger is clear

Case 3 — Righteous turns and not warned:

they fall

their righteousness not remembered

blood required of the messenger

Case 4 — Righteous warned:

they stay aligned

messenger is clear

This is the law:

Warning transfers responsibility.

Silence transfers guilt.

16. "Arise, go into the plain..." (v.22)

He's called out again.

Into the plain:

open space

separation

This is where instruction deepens.

17. The Glory Appears Again (v.23)

Same as Chapter 1.

No change.

Meaning:

The system has not changed

Only the assignment has expanded.

18. "The Spirit entered into me... and set me upon my feet" (v.24)

Repeated again.

Why?

Because:

everything operates by the Spirit

Not memory.

Not past experience.

Continuous operation.

19. "I will make thy tongue cleave... thou shalt be dumb" (v.26)

Now this is deep.

He is told:

You will not always speak.

There will be times:

you are silent

Meaning:

The messenger:

does not speak at will

only speaks when instructed

20. "When I speak with thee, I will open thy mouth" (v.27)

Final lock:

Speaking is:

controlled by the source

Not constant.

Not forced.

Timed.

THE FULL CODE OF EZEKIEL 3

This chapter establishes:

THE WEIGHT OF CARRYING THE SYSTEM

You must eat the message

You must become the message

You must observe before speaking

EZEKIEL 4 — WHEN THE MESSAGE BECOMES A SIGN

1. “Take thee a tile... portray Jerusalem upon it” (v.1)

Now the method changes.

Not just speaking.

Visual demonstration

A tile (clay tablet)

Jerusalem drawn on it

This is:

Turning the message into something visible

Key shift:

Chapter 3 → spoken warning

Chapter 4 → demonstrated warning

2. “Lay siege against it... build a fort... cast a mount” (v.2)

Now he is told to:

simulate war

build siege structures

set camps against it

This is not random acting.

This is:

Prophetic modeling of what is coming

Meaning:

The people will see:

before it happens.

3. “Take an iron pan... set it for a wall” (v.3)

Iron pan = barrier

Placed between:

Ezekiel

the city

Meaning:

Separation is coming

communication cut

protection removed

division established

And Ezekiel:

sets his face against it.

Meaning:

judgment is fixed

4. “Lie on thy left side... lay the iniquity... 390 days” (v.4–5)

Now we enter time.

He must:

lie on his left side

for 390 days

Each day = a year

Meaning:

390 years of iniquity (house of Israel)

Now we connect:

This is not just time.

This is:

measured rebellion

Habakkuk 2:3 Connection:

The judgment is not random.

It is:

appointed based on accumulated time

5. "After that... lie on thy right side... 40 days" (v.6)

Now:

40 days

for Judah

Again:

Day = year

Meaning:

Separate accountability

Israel → 390

Judah → 40

The system tracks:

each house independently

6. "Set thy face toward the siege... arm uncovered" (v.7)

Now posture matters.

face set

arm uncovered

Meaning:

No hiding.

No softening.

Direct execution of judgment

7. "I will lay bands upon thee... thou shalt not turn" (v.8)

Now restraint is introduced.

He cannot move.

He is:

bound in position

defilement

The condition of the people:

spiritually unclean

living in corruption

13. “Even thus shall the children of Israel eat their defiled bread among the Gentiles” (v.13)

Now it’s explained.

This is what will happen:

in captivity

Meaning:

removed from land

eating unclean

living outside covenant structure

14. Ezekiel Responds (v.14)

He says:

He has not defiled himself.

Meaning:

The messenger is:

still aligned

Even while showing corruption.

15. “Lo, I have given thee cow’s dung for man’s dung” (v.15)

Adjustment is made.

Meaning:

Judgment is firm...

but mercy still operates.

16. “I will break the staff of bread in Jerusalem” (v.16)

Now we get the direct declaration.

Staff of bread = support system

Broken.

Meaning:

Everything sustaining them:

will collapse

17. “They shall eat bread by weight... drink water by measure” (v.16–17)

Reinforced again.

Meaning:

fear

lack

survival mode

18. “That they may want bread and water... and be astonished one with another” (v.17)

Final condition:

confusion

shock

deterioration

1. “Take thee a sharp knife... a barber’s razor” (v.1)

cutting begins

razor taken

used on head and beard

Meaning:

Hair =

identity

covering

dignity

So this act represents:

removal of identity + exposure

2. “Weigh and divide the hair” (v.1)

Now the hair is:

measured

divided

Meaning:

judgment is precise

Not random destruction.

Measured outcome.

3. “Burn a third... smite a third... scatter a third” (v.2)

Now we get the breakdown:

Three outcomes

Burned (fire in the city)

Struck (sword around the city)

Scattered (wind dispersion)

Meaning:

no one escapes consequence—only different forms of it

4. “Take a few... bind them in thy skirts” (v.3)

A remnant is kept.

Meaning:

Even in judgment:

preservation exists

5. “Then take of them again... cast them into the fire” (v.4)

But even within the remnant:

some are tested again.

being spared does not remove refinement

6. “This is Jerusalem... I have set it in the midst of the nations” (v.5)

9. “I, even I, am against thee” (v.8)

10. “I will execute judgments in the midst of thee” (v.8)

11. "Such as I have not done... and whereunto I will not do any more the like" (v.9)

This is extreme.

Meaning:

unprecedented judgment

Because of:

unprecedented corruption.

12. "Fathers shall eat the sons... sons shall eat their fathers" (v.10)

Now the result:

Total breakdown.

Meaning:

collapse of natural order

family destroyed

survival overrides covenant

13. "I will accomplish my fury... I will be comforted" (v.13)

This is heavy.

Meaning:

Judgment:

satisfies justice

Not emotion.

Not reaction.

completion of what is due

14. "I will make thee waste... a reproach" (v.14)

Now external effect:

Meaning:

They become:

an example

a warning

a sign to others

15. "In anger... fury... rebukes" (v.15)

Triple emphasis.

Meaning:

This is not light correction.

This is:

full execution mode

16. "Evil arrows of famine... I will increase the famine" (v.16)

Now we see weapons:

famine

scarcity

Meaning:

supply systems collapse further

17. "I will send famine and evil beasts... pestilence and blood" (v.17)

Now full breakdown:

famine

beasts

disease

violence

Meaning:

EZEKIEL 11 — FALSE COUNSEL VS RESTORATION

1. “The Spirit lifted me up... to the east gate” (v.1)

Same movement as Chapter 10.

Now Ezekiel is brought to:

the place of transition (east gate)

Meaning:

this is where leadership decisions are made

2. “Five and twenty men... princes of the people” (v.1)

Now identified:

Meaning:

leadership class

Not random people.

Decision-makers.

3. “These are the men that devise mischief, and give wicked counsel” (v.2)

Direct exposure.

Meaning:

corruption is being led from the top

4. “It is not near; let us build houses: this city is the caldron, and we be the flesh” (v.3)

Now we hear their mindset.

Meaning:

They believe:

they are safe

judgment is not immediate

they are protected inside the system

Key deception:

false security inside a corrupted system

5. "The Spirit of the Lord fell upon me... I know the things that come into your mind" (v.5)

Now direct confrontation.

Meaning:

nothing is hidden from the system

Even:

thoughts

intentions

6. "Ye have multiplied your slain... filled the streets with the slain" (v.6)

Now the result of their leadership:

Meaning:

violence flows from corrupted counsel

7. "Your slain... they are the flesh, and this city is the caldron: but I will bring you forth" (v.7)

Now correction of their belief.

Meaning:

They thought:

the city protects them

But:

they will be removed from it

8. “Ye have feared the sword; and I will bring a sword upon you” (v.8)

Meaning:

what they feared becomes their reality

9. “I will bring you out... deliver you into the hands of strangers” (v.9)

Meaning:

loss of control confirmed

10. “Ye shall fall by the sword... in the border of Israel will I judge you”
(v.10)

Meaning:

judgment occurs at the boundary

Not inside their comfort zone.

11. “This city shall not be your caldron” (v.11)

Final correction.

Meaning:

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The system:

never broke

never failed

never changed

Only:

who was aligned to it changed

Same witnesses:

Book of Habakkuk 2:3 → they say “not yet,” but the time is already set

Book of Proverbs 20:5 → draw out denial and blindness

Book of Isaiah 11:2 → Spirit vs dull perception

EZEKIEL 12 — THE EXPOSURE OF DENIAL

1. “Thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house... which have eyes to see, and see not” (v.1–2)

Now the condition is defined deeper.

Meaning:

this is not lack of access—it is refusal

They:

have eyes

have ears

But:

choose not to perceive

2. “Prepare thee stuff for removing... remove by day in their sight” (v.3)

Now Ezekiel is told:

act out captivity again

Meaning:

visual warning repeated

Because:

they are not receiving the message

3. “It may be they will consider... though they be a rebellious house” (v.3)

Meaning:

there is still a chance—but it is small

4. “Bring forth thy stuff by day... go forth at even... as they that go into captivity” (v.4)

Meaning:

demonstrate the process of exile

packing

leaving

displacement

5. “Dig thou through the wall... carry out thereby” (v.5)

Now specific:

Meaning:

escape attempt under pressure

6. “Bear it upon thy shoulder... cover thy face” (v.6)

Meaning:

shame + uncertainty

burden carried

vision obscured

7. “I did so as I was commanded” (v.7)

Meaning:

obedience remains consistent

8. “In the morning came the word...” (v.8–9)

Now interpretation begins.

Meaning:

the act is explained

9. “This burden concerneth the prince in Jerusalem” (v.10)

Now targeted.

Meaning:

leadership again

10. “He shall bear upon his shoulder... go forth in the twilight” (v.11–12)

Meaning:

what Ezekiel acted—leaders will live

11. “They shall dig through the wall... cover his face” (v.12)

same pattern of escape + blindness

13. “I will scatter... and draw out the sword after them” (v.14)

Meaning:

no security in dispersion

14. “They shall know that I am the Lord... when I scatter them” (v.15)

Meaning:

recognition comes through displacement

15. “I will leave a few men... that they may declare all their abominations”
(v.16)

Now this is key.

Meaning:

the remnant becomes a witness

Function:

They:

survive

but testify

16. “Eat thy bread with quaking... drink thy water with trembling” (v.17–18)

Now behavior:

Meaning:

fear becomes normal condition

17. "They shall eat their bread with carefulness... because of the violence"

(v.19)

Meaning:

constant anxiety

18. "The cities... laid waste... the land desolate" (v.20)

Meaning:

complete system collapse confirmed

19. "The days are prolonged... every vision faileth" (v.22)

Now we hit the core problem.

Meaning:

they believe nothing will happen

Key deception:

delay = false comfort

20. "I will make this proverb to cease" (v.23)

Meaning:

denial will be broken

21. "The days are at hand... and the effect of every vision" (v.23)

Meaning:

no more delay

22. "There shall be no more any vain vision nor flattering divination" (v.24)

Meaning:

false voices removed

23. "I the Lord will speak... it shall come to pass" (v.25)

Meaning:

what is spoken will now manifest directly

24. “There shall none of my words be prolonged any more” (v.25)

Meaning:

time gap closes

25. “The vision... is for many days... far off” (v.27)

They still say:

Meaning:

they continue denying even at the edge

26. “None of my words shall be prolonged any more” (v.28)

Final seal.

Meaning:

immediacy is now active

FULL CODE OF EZEKIEL 12

This chapter shows:

THE FINAL LAYER OF RESISTANCE — DENIAL

People see but refuse

Warnings repeated through action

Leaders specifically targeted

Captivity demonstrated again

Remnant becomes witness

Fear becomes normal
