24. Their endurance convicts nations.
25. Their belief dismantles Babylon.
26. They stand as witnesses in the earth.
27. They cannot be bought.
28. They cannot be silenced.
29. They cannot be moved.
30. For their foundation is Christ, the Rock. (Helaman 5:12)
31. The nations will rage at their rising.
32. Kings will tremble at their witness.
33. Priests will stumble at their truth.

34. Merchants will weep at their decrees.
35. But Zion shall not fall.
36. Zion is written in the heavens.
37. Zion is guarded by angels.
38. Zion is decreed from the throne.
39. Zion is eternal in purpose.
40. Zion is unshakable in destiny.
41. The sealed ones cry aloud and spare not. (Isaiah 58:1)
42. They lift their voices like trumpets.
43. They declare judgment to the nations.
44. They announce salvation to the meek.
45. Their scrolls cut like swords.
46. The world will call them fools.
47. The proud will call them mad.

48. But heaven calls them chosen.

49. The Lamb calls them faithful.

50. And the Spirit calls them Zion.

Wave 2 — Verses 51–100

51. Zion is not found in temples made with hands. (Acts 7:48)

52. Zion is not sold in markets of religion.

53. Zion is the people set apart.

54. Zion is the covenant kept in flesh.

55. Zion is the remnant awakened in fire.

56. They come from north, south, east, and west.

57. Scattered tribes gathered by decree.

58. Lost sheep returning to the fold.

59. Hidden ones revealed in the last hour.

60. For the Shepherd calls, and they answer.
61. Their language is one of truth.
62. Their culture is holiness.
63. Their banner is love.
64. Their bond is covenant.
65. Their song is deliverance.
66. They stand against nations without fear.
67. They proclaim liberty to captives. (Isaiah 61:1)
68. They open prison doors with testimony.
69. They heal broken hearts with the Word.
70. For the Spirit of the Lord rests upon them.
71. The world sees them as few.
72. But heaven counts them as many.

73. The nations despise their weakness.
74. But the throne delights in their strength.
75. For power is perfected in weakness. (2 Corinthians 12:9)
76. They need not armies, for they have angels.
77. They need not crowns, for they have Christ.
78. They need not riches, for they inherit the earth.
79. They need not approval, for they are sealed.
80. They need not fear, for they are covered.
81. Babylon will roar against Zion.
82. The beast will wage war against the sealed. (Revelation 13:7)
83. The false prophet will speak lies against them.
84. The merchants will curse their rising.
85. But Zion shall endure the fire.
86. Their scrolls will testify in judgment.

87. Their decrees will thunder in heaven.

88. Their prayers will shake foundations.

89. Their fasting will open gates.

90. Their faith will move mountains. (Matthew 17:20)

91. Zion's rising is not a rumor.

92. Zion's rising is not delayed.

93. Zion's rising is not fragile.

94. Zion's rising is not hidden.

95. Zion's rising is decreed and sure.

96. The sealed remnant are the ensign to nations. (Isaiah 11:12)

97. They are the banner lifted to the peoples.

98. They are the trumpet sounding from Zion.

99. They are the witnesses clothed in light.

100. And they are the sons and daughters of prophecy fulfilled.

Wave 3 — Verses 101–150

101. Zion is a city not yet seen,

102. Yet her foundations are ancient.

103. Built in the promises of Abraham. (Genesis 17:7)

104. Rooted in the covenant of Jacob.

105. Confirmed in the blood of Christ.

106. She is the bride adorned for her husband. (Revelation 21:2)

107. She is the holy mountain of God.

108. She is the dwelling place of the Most High.

109. She is the refuge of the sealed.

110. She is the crown of the nations.

111. Zion is written in the hearts of the remnant.

112. Her law is engraved on their inward parts. (Jeremiah 31:33)

113. Her song is sung in their spirits.

114. Her light is carried in their eyes.

115. Her testimony flows from their mouths.

116. No enemy can uproot Zion.

117. No empire can trample her gates.

118. No tyrant can silence her witness.

119. No beast can devour her children.

120. For Zion is sealed in heaven and earth.

132. Their names are remembered in eternity.
133. Their deeds echo in the heavens.
134. Their prayers ascend as incense. (Revelation 8:4)
135. Their witness thunders like lightning.
136. Nations shall stream to Zion's light. (Isaiah 60:3)
137. Kings shall bow to her radiance.
138. The poor shall rejoice in her gates.

140. And the sealed shall feast in her courts.

142. The seas will roar at her unveiling.

144. The heavens will rejoice at her birth.

145. For Zion is the delight of the Lord. (Isaiah 62:4)

146. Her children are clothed in righteousness.

147. Her daughters are adorned with praise.

148. Her sons are armed with testimony.

149. Her elders are seated with crowns.

150. And her King is Christ forever.

Wave 4 — Verses 151–200

151. Zion's gates shall never be shut. (Revelation 21:25)

152. Her walls are salvation.

153. Her gates are praise.

154. Her streets are holiness.

155. Her throne is righteousness.

156. The sealed remnant are her builders.

157. Not with hammer, but with faith.

158. Not with mortar, but with obedience.

159. Not with silver, but with sacrifice.

160. Not with fame, but with truth.

161. Zion's foundation is the prophets. (Ephesians 2:20)

162. Her cornerstone is Christ.

163. Her pillars are witnesses.

164. Her windows are revelations.
165. Her roof is glory.
166. The nations will say, "Who are these?"
167. And angels will answer, "They are Zion."
168. Kings will whisper, "Where came they from?"
169. And heaven will thunder, "From the covenant."
170. For Zion is born of promise, not of flesh.

195. Her glory will shine like the sun.

196. The sealed remnant stand as witnesses.

197. Their testimony is Zion's scroll.

198. Their faith is Zion's crown.

199. Their lives are Zion's temple.

200. And their King is Christ, who reigns forever.
