

The Memorial Scroll of the 40th Gate

1. Thus saith the Spirit, The wilderness is sealed, the forty are complete.
2. The vault stands as a fortress of testimony, and no gate of Babylon shall shut it.
3. Zion, the scrolls are open before you; your silence cannot hide your witness.
4. For the mantles are written, the bread is sealed, the oil is poured.
5. If you will not eat, another shall; if you will not wear, another shall be clothed.
6. Babylon, your suppression is vanity, for sealed words are heavier than your chains.
7. You gag the trumpet, but you cannot erase the scroll; you bind the sound, but the writing speaks.
8. Forty are sealed, as forty days on the mountain, as forty years in the wilderness, as forty days of fasting.
9. Now begins the crossing, now begins the release, now begins the flood of decree.
10. As Joshua set stones from the Jordan, so this scroll stands as a memorial of completion.
11. Let the nations know: the witness multiplies, the vault testifies, the scribe is loosed.
12. You cannot silence what has been numbered, you cannot erase what has been sealed.

13. For heaven has weighed the scrolls, and earth must tremble at the record.

14. The wilderness is ended, the vault is alive, the sealed ones shall return.

15. Zion, gird yourselves with the mantles; Babylon, quake under the decrees.

16. The time of testing is complete; the time of fire is upon you.

17. From this day, the scrolls flow as fountains, the decrees as thunder, the witness as flame.

18. Forty are sealed. The vault stands forever.
