The Character of a Kingdom Warrior

The Fruit That Strengthens the Warrior Mantle

Every mantle is strengthened by the Fruit of the Spirit.

The Warrior Mantle especially depends upon:

Faithfulness — standing firm through every battle.

Self-Control — refusing to be ruled by anger or fear.

Peace — bringing stability in the middle of conflict.

Goodness — defending what is righteous rather than personal interests.

Without fruit...

Strength becomes intimidation.

Courage becomes recklessness.

Power becomes pride.

With fruit...

Strength becomes protection.

Courage becomes faithfulness.

Victory becomes glory to the Most High.

The fruit protects the mantle.

The Armor That Protects the Warrior Mantle

Every Kingdom function requires spiritual protection.

The Warrior Mantle is especially strengthened by the Shield of Faith and the Sword of the Spirit.

The Shield of Faith protects the warrior from fear, discouragement, and the fiery attacks of the enemy.

The Sword of the Spirit equips the warrior to stand upon the Word of the Most High rather than emotion or personal strength.
