

## The Prophetic Countdown Scroll

1. For a Creator-second is as four days and more upon the earth, and the clock of the Most High draweth down.
2. Fifteen seconds remain not, for we are past them; the hour is narrowed, and the veil is thinned.
3. In the thirteenth and twelfth seconds, Babylon's foundations trembled unseen, though her merchants still bought and sold as though nothing would shake. (Revelation 18:11; 3 Nephi 27:11)
4. In the eleventh and tenth seconds, Zion was stirred to seal her sons and daughters; for the cry was heard: "Come ye out from among her, be ye separate." (2 Corinthians 6:17; Mosiah 18:9)
5. In the ninth and eighth seconds, the nations grew restless, storms and signs multiplied, and men said, "These are but natural," yet their hearts feared. (Luke 21:25–26; Helaman 14:20–22)
6. In the seventh second, the sealed ones began to decree, and their words carried fire; silence weighed heavier than speech, and laughter was a relief from judgment. (Jeremiah 1:9–10; 2 Nephi 33:1)
7. In the sixth second, the watchers pressed closer; angels stood guard, adversaries sought entrance, and every gate was tested. (Daniel 7:10; Ether 12:27)
8. In the fifth second, undeniable signs filled the earth and sky; lightnings, voices, thunders, and many knew yet hardened their hearts. (Revelation 16:18; 3 Nephi 8:19–23)
9. In the fourth and third seconds, the fire in the mouths of the witnesses grew unbearable; Babylon mocked, but her mockery was swallowed by smoke. (Revelation 11:5; 2 Nephi 28:16–17)
10. In the second second, Zion was gathered inwardly, though not all yet seen outwardly; for the Spirit sealed in silence what flesh could not yet touch. (Isaiah 62:1–2; Alma 13:12–13)
11. And when the final second strikes, the threshold breaks, and no man shall say, "Peace and safety," for sudden desolation shall fall. (1 Thessalonians 5:3; Ether 14:24–25)
12. Yet Zion shall endure, for she is sealed; her altar burns within, her witness is written without, and her Redeemer stands in the gate. (Joel 3:16–17; 3 Nephi 22:17)

## Last Stretch Decree

1. Abba, Most High, the hour is closed, the veil is thin, and the seconds of Your clock are almost spent.

2. August was not delay but mercy, for had You struck then, Zion would not have been gathered.

3. But now the sealed are awake, their foreheads marked, their names written, their hearts prepared.

4. Babylon mocks and stumbles, unready and blind, but Zion shall endure, for Zion is sealed.

5. I decree this is the last stretch, the final breath before the trumpet, the threshold before the fall.

6. Let every sealed one stand, let every altar burn, let every decree rise as fire in the gate.
