**7**

**8**

**9**

They revealed remembrance.

**10**

And from Eden to Zion, the pattern remained.

## **ADAM AND EVE**

**11**

When Adam transgressed, his nakedness was exposed.

**12**

And he sought to cover himself.

**13**

Yet the work of his hands could not provide what heaven required.

**14**

Therefore TMH made coats and clothed them.

**15**

Thus the first covenant garment appeared.

**16**

Not as decoration.

**17**

But as mercy.

**18**

For judgment had come.

**19**

Yet covering was provided.

**20**

And the garment testified that TMH remembers His creation.

## **JOSEPH**

**21**

Then Joseph received a special coat from his father.

**22**

And the garment distinguished him among his brethren.

**23**

His brothers saw the garment.

**24**

Yet they did not understand the purpose.

**25**

For TMH had marked Joseph beforehand.

**26**

The coat testified of calling.

**27**

The dreams testified of destiny.

**28**

And the pit could not remove what heaven had appointed.

**29**

The garment became a witness of separation.

**30**

Not separation unto pride.

**31**

But separation unto service.

**AARON**

**32**

Then TMH commanded holy garments for Aaron.

**33**

Garments for glory.

**34**

Garments for beauty.

**35**

Garments for ministry.

**36**

The Ephod was prepared.

**37**

The breastplate was prepared.

**38**

The robe was prepared.

**39**

The crown was prepared.

**40**

Nothing was random.

**41**

Every thread testified.

**42**

Every stone remembered.

**43**

Every garment proclaimed covenant order.

## **ELIJAH**

**44**

Then the mantle appeared.

**45**

Elijah carried it before kings.

**46**

He carried it before prophets.

**47**

He carried it through wilderness places.

**48**

The mantle became known throughout Israel.

**49**

For authority was carried openly.

**50**

And when Elijah departed, the mantle remained.

**51**

For TMH always preserves His work.

## **ELISHA**

**52**

The mantle fell.

**53**

Elisha took it up.

**54**

The garment changed shoulders.

**55**

Yet the purpose remained.

**56**

The river opened again.

**57**

The witness continued again.

**58**

And Israel knew that heaven had established succession.

**59**

Thus the mantle testified that assignments continue across generations.

## **MORDECAI**

**60**

Mordecai once wore sackcloth.

**61**

He mourned for his people.

**62**

He cried before heaven.

**63**

Yet TMH reversed the decree.

**64**

The mourning garment was exchanged.

**65**

Royal apparel replaced sackcloth.

**66**

Honor replaced humiliation.

**67**

And the garment testified that TMH exalts the faithful in due season.

## **YAHSHUA**

**68**

Then came the Son.

**69**

The Lamb.

**70**

The King.

**71**

And even His garment became a witness.

**72**

The soldiers cast lots for it.

**73**

For it was woven without seam.

**74**

Not divided.

**75**

Not torn.

**76**

For the covenant He carried would not fail.

**77**

The garment testified while the cross stood nearby.

## **THE SAINTS**

**78**

The prophets saw white robes.

**79**

The apostles saw white robes.

**80**

The righteous were clothed in white.

**81**

Purity was revealed through garments.

**82**

Victory was revealed through garments.

**83**

Remembrance was revealed through garments.

**84**

And those who overcame were clothed by heaven.

## **THE WEDDING GARMENT**

**85**

Yahshua spoke of a wedding feast.

**86**

Many were invited.

**87**

Yet one entered without the garment.

**88**

And the king questioned him.

**89**

For attendance alone was not enough.

**90**

The garment mattered.

**91**

Preparation mattered.

**92**

Readiness mattered.

**93**

For the wedding garment testified of covenant alignment.

## **PUT ON CHRIST**

**94**

Therefore the apostles taught:

**95**

Put on Christ.

**96**

Put off the old man.

**97**

Put on the new man.

**98**

Walk worthy of the calling received.

**99**

For the outward garments witnessed earthly realities.

**100**

But the greater garment is carried within.

**101**

The garment of obedience.

**102**

The garment of faithfulness.

**103**

The garment of righteousness.

**104**

The garment of remembrance.

**105**

The garment of covenant.

## **ZION**

**106**

Thus the pattern stands.

**107**

Adam was clothed.

**108**

Joseph was marked.

**109**

Aaron ministered.

**110**

Elijah carried.

**111**

Elisha received.

**112**

Mordecai was honored.

**113**

Yahshua testified.

**114**

The saints were robed.

**115**

The wedding garment remained required.

**116**

And Zion shall yet be clothed with salvation.

**117**

Her sons shall arise.

**118**

Her daughters shall arise.

**119**

Her servants shall be remembered.

**120**

And the garments of covenant shall testify once more before the nations.

**121**

For TMH has never abandoned the pattern.

**122**

The garments remain.

**123**

The witness remains.

**124**

The covenant remains.

**125**

And the call remains for every generation to put on the garments prepared by heaven.
