

THE SCROLL OF FIRST FRUITS

The Appointed Offering of Resurrection

In the beginning, the Most High set His order in the heavens,
and the lights were appointed for signs, and for seasons, and for times.

2

And nothing that He established was without meaning,
for every cycle testifies of His wisdom.

3

The earth was formed to obey,
and the seed was given to reveal a mystery.

4

For that which is sown into the ground
does not remain as it was.

5

It is buried,
it is broken,
and it rises again in another form.

6

So the Most High ordained the pattern in creation,
that life would come forth from what was cut down.

7

And He appointed a time in the turning of the year,
when the first of the harvest would be brought before Him.

8

Not at random,
nor by the will of man,

but at the fixed moment declared from the beginning.

9

This is the time of First Fruits,
the appointed offering of the first increase of the field.

10

And it was commanded that the people
should not come empty before Him.

11

But they were to bring the first,
the beginning,
the evidence that the harvest had begun.

12

And the priest would lift the sheaf,
waving it before the Most High.

13

And this act was not for show,
but for acceptance.

14

For if the First was received,
then the rest would be blessed.

15

And if the First was rejected,
then the harvest would not stand.

16

So the offering was bound to the time,
and the time was bound to obedience.

17

For many could gather,
but only a few would align.

18

And the Most High did not regard abundance,
but alignment.

19

For what is brought outside of His appointed time
has no witness in heaven.

20

Thus the earth declared the truth continually,
yet man chose his own ways.

21

But the pattern remained,
waiting for its fullness.

22

For the seed was always speaking,
though many did not understand.

23

That it must fall,
that it must be buried,
and that it must rise again.

24

And in the fullness of time,
the pattern was made manifest.

25

Yahshua came as the seed of promise,
sent into the earth.

26

He walked in obedience,
not according to men,
but according to the will of the Father.

27

And as it was written in the field,
so it was fulfilled in Him.

28

For He was cut off,
yet not for Himself.

29

He was laid in the earth,
as the seed is sown.

30

And darkness covered Him,
as the soil covers the grain.

31

But the grave could not hold what was appointed to rise.

32

For on the appointed day,
He was raised.

33

Not early,
not late,
but in perfect alignment with the time of First Fruits.

34

And He became the First of the First Fruits,

the beginning of the resurrection.

35

For what was shown in the harvest
was fulfilled in the Son.

36

And the earth bore witness,
and the heavens agreed.

37

For the First had been accepted.

38

And because He was received,
the promise of the harvest was secured.

39

For if the First lives,
then many shall live.

40

And if the First is raised,
then the harvest shall follow.

41

This is the mystery hidden in the field:
that life comes through surrender.

42

That what is planted in weakness
is raised in power.

43

That what is buried in silence
is raised with authority.

44

And that what is cut down
is not the end,
but the beginning.

45

So the First Fruits was never just an offering of grain,
but a declaration of resurrection.

46

A witness written into the earth
before the foundation of the world.

47

And now it calls to those who hear,
to walk in the same pattern.

48

For the harvest is not complete,
and the increase is still coming.

49

But only those who align
will be counted among it.

50

For the Most High does not change His times,
nor does He bend His order.

51

He calls,
and those who hear must respond.

52

Not according to tradition,

but according to truth.

53

For many follow what has been handed down,
but few seek what was established from the beginning.

54

Yet the heavens still declare,
and the earth still responds.

55

And the pattern remains untouched.

56

For the seed still falls,
and the seed still rises.

57

And the harvest still begins with the First.

58

So the question is not whether the First Fruits stands,
for it has already been fulfilled.

59

The question is who will walk in it.

60

Who will align with the appointed time?

61

Who will bring their offering
when the Most High has spoken?

62

Who will present themselves
as the living increase of the field?

63

For the true offering is not only what is lifted in the hand,
but what is yielded in the life.

64

And the acceptable sacrifice
is obedience.

65

For to follow the pattern
is greater than to multiply offerings outside of it.

66

And to walk in truth
is greater than to stand in tradition.

67

For the Most High seeks those
who will worship in Spirit and in Truth.

68

Not by imagination,
but by alignment.

69

And the time of First Fruits declares this plainly.

70

That the beginning must be right
for the end to be received.

71

That the First must be accepted
for the harvest to stand.

72

And that the resurrection is not an idea,
but an appointed reality.

73

For Yahshua has already gone before,
as the First.

74

And the path has already been opened.

75

So the call now goes forth:
return to the appointed times.

76

Return to the order of heaven.

77

Return to the pattern written in creation.

78

For the lights have not changed,
and the truth has not moved.

79

Only man has turned aside.

80

But now the call is clear,
and the witness is strong.

81

For the First Fruits has been accepted.

82

The offering has already been received.

83

The resurrection has already begun.

84

And the harvest is waiting.

85

So align yourself,
and be counted among the increase.

86

Do not delay,
for the time is not yours to choose.

87

But the appointed time stands,
calling for obedience.

88

For the field is ready,
and the harvest is sure.

89

And the First has already risen.

90

So follow the pattern,
and walk in life.

91

For what was written in the seed
has now been fulfilled in the Son.

92

And what was fulfilled in the Son
shall be fulfilled in the harvest.

If you will align.

94

If you will hear.

95

If you will obey.

For the Most High is not seeking many offerings,
but a people who walk in His order.

97

And the First Fruits stands as the witness.

98

That what is accepted first
sanctifies what follows.

And the harvest belongs to Him
who established the beginning.

So the First Fruits has already been accepted—
the question is:
will you follow the pattern?
