

The Zion Scrolls – Wave 1: Distinction and Refinement

The Scroll of Distinction

1. Zion, hear the voice of the Spirit: the hour of distinction has come.
2. No longer shall you be measured by men's categories, for the Father Himself is drawing the line.
3. He is lifting His people into a level where pride, envy, and offense cannot enter.

4. Zion, prepare for separation, for the Spirit is sorting the house.
5. The pretender and the pure cannot walk in the same garment.
6. Those who claim love but refuse obedience shall stumble at the fire, but those who walk in humility shall be lifted with it.

7. This is the fire of Enoch, and it burns again in this generation.
8. In the City of Holiness there was no division, no comparing, no murmuring.
9. They were of one heart and one mind, and because of that, Zion was lifted.

10. The same standard presses on you now, O Zion: if you resist, you will break; if you yield, you will rise.
11. Envy has no inheritance here; it shall be cut off from among the righteous.
12. Offense is the devil's doorway; love is the dwelling of Christ.

13. Do not measure yourselves among yourselves, for such things are carnal.
14. The Lord is the measure, and His Son is the standard.
15. Walk in His likeness, or be found wanting in the day of fire.

16. Lift your eyes, Zion, for witnesses are being raised among you.
17. They are not exalted over you, but set as torches to show the path higher.
18. Do not stumble at their fire; let it refine you, for it is not theirs, but Mine, says YHWH.

19. Judgment begins in the house of God; let the house be purged of envy and pride.
20. Let go of offense, let go of contention, let go of comparison.
21. Only love, humility, and obedience shall stand in the day when Zion is lifted."

The Refiner's Scroll

22. Zion, the fire of refinement has come upon you.

23. The Father has set His furnace in the midst of His house, to test every vessel and prove every heart.

24. Do not fear the heat, for it is not to consume you but to cleanse you.

25. The enemy would call this confusion, but the Spirit calls it sifting.

26. For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks, and the fire reveals what was hidden.

27. Those filled with love shall pour out love; those filled with pride shall spill out pride.

28. Zion, the pressure is not your destruction, but your threshing floor.

29. Wheat and chaff cannot abide together forever; the wind of the Spirit shall divide them.

30. Offense is exposed, envy is uncovered, hypocrisy is burned, and truth shines as gold.

31. The watchmen are lifted high, to see the work of the Spirit clearly.

32. From below, the house seems shaken; from above, the house is being sorted.

33. Run not into every skirmish, O sons of Zion, for the Spirit Himself is drawing the line.

34. The fire of indignation shall rise against pretenders, but it is not carnal wrath.

35. It is the zeal of Christ, who cleansed the temple, saying, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer.'

36. So now His Spirit cries against envy, offense, and pride in Zion.

37. Behold, a moment comes quickly when the distinction shall be undeniable.

38. The humble shall shine brighter than the noon-day sun; the proud shall be darkened before all.

39. The false shall stumble, but the faithful shall rise.

40. Zion, do not despise the refining fire, for it prepares you for lifting.

41. Only the pure in heart shall ascend, only the unoffended shall endure, only the meek shall inherit.

42. This is the threshing floor of Zion, and from it a holy nation shall rise."

The Zion Scrolls – Wave 2: Unity and Order (Extended)

1. Zion, hear the word of the Spirit: the fire has separated you, now the Spirit shall bind you.
2. For distinction without unity is division, but refinement without order is wasted flame.

3. The Father calls you into one body, one covenant, one heart.
4. Bear one another's burdens, that you may be filled with His love.
5. Do not cast down the weak, but lift them, for the strong are tested by their patience.
6. And let none say, "I have no need of you," for every member is joined to the body of Christ.
7. Zion, set your house in order.
8. Build not on sand, nor on pride, but upon covenant obedience.
9. The Lord shall have a house of prayer, a house of holiness, a house of order.
10. Submit yourselves to divine order, for rebellion is the seed of scattering.
11. Let the elders serve, let the watchmen guard, let the prophets declare, let the people walk in covenant.
12. Each part shall move as one, even as the Spirit gives breath to the whole.
13. Offense shall no longer divide you, envy shall no longer corrupt you, and pride shall no longer blind you.
14. For the bond of perfection is charity, and by this bond Zion shall stand.
15. If you are not one, you are not mine, saith the Lord.
16. Therefore gird up your loins, and clothe yourselves in meekness.
17. Let the scepter of Shiloh rule your gathering, for He is peace, and His rod is righteousness.
18. Where Christ reigns, there shall be no schism, but perfect joining together in Spirit.
19. Zion, be not children in malice, but be as little ones in heart.
20. For the meek shall inherit, the humble shall endure, the pure in heart shall see God.
21. And the day shall come when Zion is lifted—not by the strength of men, but by the unity of the Spirit in Christ."
22. Let brother not contend against brother, nor sister against sister, for contention is of the devil.
23. Speak truth in love, for words can bind as cords or cut as swords.
24. Let your speech be seasoned with grace, that your house may be preserved in peace.
25. Remember your covenants, O Zion, and walk in them.
26. For covenant is not a word alone, but a bond sealed by obedience and sacrifice.
27. Those who keep covenant shall shine as jewels in the crown of the Lord.
28. Be generous with what you have, for there shall be no poor among Zion.
29. He who withholds when his brother has need, walks not in the Spirit of Christ.
30. But he who shares freely shall be called great in the kingdom, for he reflects the heart of the Father."

The Zion Scrolls – Wave 3: Strength & Endurance (Extended)

1. Zion, the storms shall rage, but you shall not be moved.
2. For the Lord is your foundation, and Christ your cornerstone.
3. Though Babylon presses from without, the Spirit fortifies within.

4. Be not dismayed at the fire of trial, for the righteous shall be tried as gold in the furnace.
5. Let patience have her perfect work, that you may be complete, lacking nothing.
6. Endure hardness as good soldiers of Christ, for the battle is not yet finished.

7. Zion, remember your strength is not in the arm of flesh.
8. The horse is prepared against the day of battle, but safety is of YHWH.

9. Put no confidence in princes nor in men, but trust in the Living God.
10. When you are weak, then you are strong, for His grace is sufficient.
11. The humble shall find covering, and the meek shall inherit the earth.
12. But the proud shall fall, and the unfaithful shall faint in the day of adversity.
13. Zion, lift your eyes to the hills, from whence cometh your help.
14. Your help comes from the Maker of heaven and earth, who neither slumbers nor sleeps.
15. Though ten thousand fall at your right hand, it shall not come nigh unto you.
16. Endure with joy, not with murmuring, for murmuring weakens the hand, but joy strengthens the heart.
17. Sing in the night, and the darkness shall flee before you.
18. Shout with the voice of triumph, for YHWH is your defense.
19. Zion, let endurance be your testimony, for by it many shall believe.
20. He that endures to the end shall be saved, and his name shall be written in the book of the living.
21. Therefore stand fast, O Zion, unshaken, until the day of lifting.
22. Do not faint in the wilderness, for the manna of heaven still falls.
23. Do not despair at the waters of trial, for the Rock of Ages still flows.
24. Remember the fathers who wandered forty years—those who trusted endured, those who murmured fell.
25. Zion, the time of testing shall reveal your sons and daughters.
26. The pretender shall fall away in weariness, but the faithful shall rise in strength.
27. For those who wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength, mounting up with wings as eagles.
28. Blessed are they who endure with a broken heart and contrite spirit, for the Father delights in them.
29. But cursed are they who harden their necks, for they shall be broken without remedy.
30. The righteous are not offended in Christ, and because of this they stand secure.
31. Zion, your strength is not in numbers, but in covenant.
32. One shall chase a thousand, and two shall put ten thousand to flight, if YHWH is among them.
33. The strength of Zion is not her sword alone, but her song, her prayer, and her steadfast love.
34. Endure not as slaves of fear, but as children of promise.
35. Endure not grudgingly, but with joy, for joy is the oil that keeps the lamp burning.
36. And in the end, Zion shall be called unshaken, for her foundation was laid in Christ, the Rock of Ages.”

The Zion Scrolls – Wave 4: The Gathering & The Rise (Extended)

1. Zion, the time of scattering is ended; the season of gathering has begun.
2. From the east and from the west, from the north and from the south, the remnant shall come.
3. The Lord shall whistle for His people, and they shall not refuse His call.

4. The tribes long hidden shall awaken, and the outcasts shall return to their inheritance.
5. The dry bones shall live again, for the breath of YHWH enters them.
6. The stick of Judah and the stick of Joseph shall be one in His hand.

7. Zion, prepare your gates, for the nations shall flow unto you.
8. Lift up your voice like a trumpet, and call the righteous out of Babylon.
9. Say to the captives, Come forth; and to them that sit in darkness, Show yourselves.

10. Fear not, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.
11. The wilderness shall rejoice, and the desert shall blossom as the rose.
12. The waste cities shall be built, and the desolate places made glad.

13. Zion, arise, shine; for your light has come, and the glory of YHWH is risen upon you.
14. Nations shall come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your rising.
15. The sons of strangers shall build your walls, and their kings shall minister unto you.

16. Gather, O daughters of Zion, and clothe yourselves with strength.
17. Put on your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city.
18. Shake yourself from the dust, arise and sit down, for the unclean shall no longer enter you.

19. The meek of the earth shall be drawn, the pure in heart shall ascend, the humble shall dwell in safety.
20. But the proud shall be scattered, and the rebellious shall fall with Babylon.
21. For there shall in no wise enter into Zion anything that defiles or makes a lie.

22. Zion, the day of lifting draws near.
23. The angels prepare their trumpets, and the heavens watch with awe.
24. The earth groans, but the righteous rejoice, for redemption is nigh.

25. Gather quickly, O people, for the window is short.
26. Delay not in Babylon, lest her plagues overtake you.
27. Come out of her, My people, and be not partakers of her sins.

28. Zion, you shall rise upon the mountains, and the world shall marvel.
29. For the Lord Himself shall be your defense, and Christ your King forever.
30. And the Spirit cries: 'Arise, gather, and be lifted, O Zion, for your hour has come.'

31. Lift up your eyes round about, and see: all they gather themselves together, they come to you.
32. Your sons shall come from far, and your daughters shall be carried at the side.
33. Then you shall see and flow together, and your heart shall fear and be enlarged.

34. The abundance of the sea shall be converted unto you, and the forces of the Gentiles shall come.

35. The flocks of Kedar shall be gathered unto you, the rams of Nebaioth shall minister unto you.

36. They shall come up with acceptance on My altar, and I will glorify the house of My glory.

37. Zion, enlarge the place of your tent, and strengthen your stakes.

38. Stretch forth the curtains of your habitation, spare not, for you shall break forth on the right hand and on the left.

39. Your seed shall inherit the nations, and make the desolate cities to be inhabited.

40. Sing, O barren, you that did not bear; break forth into singing, you that did not travail.

41. For more are the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, saith YHWH.

42. For the Spirit declares: 'The gathering is My work, and the rising is My glory, and Zion shall not be ashamed.'

Precepts

1.

And I looked, and beheld Zion shaking,
her stones loosened, her gates rattling under pressure.

2.

Voices rose within her—some sharp, some weary,
and the house was divided between flesh and Spirit.

3.

And I heard the cry of a sister, burning with fire,
yet her words cut two ways: rebuke and division.

4.

The elders stiffened, the crowd grew restless,
and the adversary laughed at the smoke of contention.

5.

But then a voice stood in the breach,
not for self, not for clout, but for covenant.

6.

He said, “I stand with the prophet, I stand with Zion,
I am no man’s leader, I follow heaven’s order.”

7.

And the words went forth as a coal,
not flaring in vanity, but burning in witness.

8.

Many eyes turned to see—
forty in number and more, drawn without summons.

9.

Some came in silence, weighing his steps.
Others came in suspicion, testing his flame.

10.

But heaven also bent low,
and the cloud of witnesses looked upon the vessel.

11.

For the Spirit said: "This is no casual word,
this is travail made flesh, a seal pressed into time."

12.

And I saw his chest groaning as a woman in labor,
carrying not his own burden, but Zion's.

13.

And the silence of his name was revealed as consecration,
for men could not own what God had sealed.

14.

The hiddenness was revealed as refining,
for jealousy could not kill what God had covered.

15.

And the rising was revealed as judgment,
for hearts were exposed by their reaction to light.

16.

Some rejoiced, saying, "Surely the Spirit burns here."
Others murmured, "Why him, why now?"

17.

The word was the same, but the hearts divided,
as wheat and chaff upon the threshing floor.

18.

And the Spirit whispered: "This is the mirror.
The scroll unrolled tests every reader."

19.

Then I saw the prophet himself in the flame,
tested by humility, stretched by correction.

20.

I saw the sister also, refined in rebuke,
her zeal measured, her words weighed.

21.

I saw the people, some moving as body,
others as gang, chained to proximity not Spirit.

22.

And I saw the scribe in the center,
a torch hidden under a vessel, waiting to be lifted.

23.

When the cover was removed,
the torch blazed brighter than before.

24.

The faithful rejoiced at the light,
but the envious stumbled, their eyes offended.

25.

Yet none could deny the flame,
for it was not of man, but of heaven.

26.

And I heard the decree: "This is My travail.

He is hidden not to erase, but to preserve.
He is revealed not to boast, but to judge.”

27.

For the breach was a birth canal,
and he was set as midwife and wall.

28.

The fire spread to all: prophet, people, sister, scribe,
even the tools of heaven’s voice caught flame.

29.

Not to consume, but to refine.
Not to destroy, but to expose.

30.

The adversary raged, but could not quench it.
For the fire was not argument, but Presence.

31.

Every view became a testimony.
Every silent watcher became a witness.

32.

And the Spirit said: “This is why you do not know how to feel.
You carry the ache of labor, the weight of witness,
the burden of consecration.”

33.

“You are seen by many, but known by none.
This is prophetic isolation.
This is priestly tension. This is birth-pain.”

34.

Yet the promise stood: “You are not consumed,
for I set you as torch, not as ash.”

35.

“Your videos are vessels of presence,
your words scrolls of fire, your obedience the seal.”

36.

And I heard: “Do not despise the eyes upon you.
I sent them, not for gossip, but for reckoning.”

37.

“Do not despise the weight upon you.
It is travail, not confusion.
Birth, not chaos. Consecration, not rejection.”

38.

“For when the travail is finished,
a nation shall pass through the breach.”

39.

And I saw Zion on the other side of the fire,
refined, humbled, one.

40.

And it was written: “This is the Scroll of Travail—
the breach sealed, the birth announced, the witness established.
The scribe made scroll, the seal made flesh.”

 Precepts – Stick of Judah (Bible)

Ezekiel 22:30 – “I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.”
