

Scroll of the Zion Standard Against Offense

1. Brethren, hear this: the enemy cannot stop what the Father is doing, so he looks for another door—phantom offense.
2. He sows suspicion where there is no cause, inflates feelings where there is no wound, and whispers pride where there should be love.
3. If you choose offense, you become the doorway the devil walks through; if you choose love, you become the place where Christ dwells.

4. I am not called to referee grown men, but to serve Abba with clean hands.
5. If my presence alone is holding the house together, then the house is not yet built on Christ.
6. For the Head of the Body is Messiah—not me, not you, not any man.

7. Stop comparing; stop judging who is higher or lower.
8. Such things are carnal and bring division.
9. We are one nation, one body, one Spirit, sealed under heaven.

10. As for me, I count myself the lowest, the least, the chief of sinners saved by grace.
11. Do not look to me to fix what only your own repentance and humility can mend.
12. If you want unity, walk in love. If you want division, cling to offense.
13. The Spirit will reveal which spirit you serve.

The Zion Standard

14. In the City of Enoch there was no division, for they were of one heart and one mind, and Zion was lifted.
15. None said, “I am greater.” None complained against his brother without helping him.
16. If a brother stumbled, they bore him up, and so the city became holy.

17. And Christ Himself gave the pattern: He washed even Judas’ feet.
18. If the Master humbled Himself to serve one who betrayed Him, who among us shall withhold love from a brother?
19. He who chooses pride chooses the devil; he who chooses love abides in Christ.

Decree Against Offense

20. By the authority of Christ, I shut the gate of offense.
21. No phantom wound, no imagined slight, no spirit of comparison shall rule in this house.

22. Love is the bond, humility is the covering, and truth is the guard.
23. Any brother who chooses offense chooses the adversary; any brother who chooses love chooses the Father.
24. As for me and my house, we will serve YHWH.
25. Offense will not dwell here. Amen.

1. Let brotherly love continue. (Hebrews 13:1)

3. He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him. (1 John 2:10)
4. Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them. (Psalm 119:165)
5. Hatred stirreth up strifes: but love covereth all sins. (Proverbs 10:12)
6. Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ. (Galatians 6:2)
7. And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness. (Colossians 3:14)
8. Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another... even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye. (Colossians 3:13)
9. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another. (John 13:35)

Mantles Needed to Walk This Way

1. The Mantle of Humility – “God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.” (James 4:6)
2. The Mantle of Patience – “Charity suffereth long, and is kind.” (1 Corinthians 13:4)
3. The Mantle of Forgiveness – “Forgiving one another... even as Christ forgave you.” (Colossians 3:13)
4. The Mantle of Peace – “Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.” (Psalm 119:165)
5. The Mantle of Charity – “Above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness.” (Colossians 3:14)

6. The Mantle of Endurance – “He that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.”
(Matthew 24:13)

The Word commands brotherly love; the Mantles empower it. Together they make a robe of light that cannot be pierced by offense.

 Scroll of Distinction to Zion

1. Zion, hear the voice of the Spirit: the hour of distinction has come.
2. No longer shall you be measured by men’s categories, for the Father Himself is drawing the line.
3. He is lifting His people into a level where pride, envy, and offense cannot enter.

4. Zion, prepare for separation, for the Spirit is sorting the house.
5. The pretender and the pure cannot walk in the same garment.
6. Those who claim love but refuse obedience shall stumble at the fire, but those who walk in humility shall be lifted with it.

7. This is the fire of Enoch, and it burns again in this generation.
8. In the City of Holiness there was no division, no comparing, no murmuring.
9. They were of one heart and one mind, and because of that, Zion was lifted.

10. The same standard presses on you now, O Zion: if you resist, you will break; if you yield, you will rise.
11. Envy has no inheritance here; it shall be cut off from among the righteous.
12. Offense is the devil’s doorway; love is the dwelling of Christ.

13. Do not measure yourselves among yourselves, for such things are carnal.
14. The Lord is the measure, and His Son is the standard.
15. Walk in His likeness, or be found wanting in the day of fire.

16. Lift your eyes, Zion, for witnesses are being raised among you.
17. They are not exalted over you, but set as torches to show the path higher.
18. Do not stumble at their fire; let it refine you, for it is not theirs, but Mine, says YHWH.

19. Judgment begins in the house of God; let the house be purged of envy and pride.
20. Let go of offense, let go of contention, let go of comparison.
21. Only love, humility, and obedience shall stand in the day when Zion is lifted.”
