One day at a time.

Keep a notebook if something hits deep.

Pray before and after each day.

Expect discomfort — it means growth.

Expect clarity — it means Christ is near.

Expect honesty — it's the only soil endurance can grow in.

 NEW PROLOGUE — “WAKE UP.” (Strong, Loving, Identity-Driven)

This book is not here to comfort you.
It is here to wake you up.

Not with fear.
Not with hype.
But with truth — the kind you feel in your chest before your mind even catches up.

Because somewhere along the way, life hit you harder than you admit.
And the crazy part?
You carried it so well that everyone around you believed you were fine.

But you weren't.
And you're not.
Not fully.
Not yet.

There are parts of you tired.
Parts disappointed.
Parts numb.
Parts still hoping someone would notice you were drowning quietly.

Listen...

TMH noticed.
Christ noticed.
Heaven noticed.
And that's why you're holding this book.

This is not a devotional.
This is not a cute inspirational read.
This is a meeting place —
where the part of you that's been asleep finally meets the part of you God called from the
beginning.

I'm not here to make you comfortable.
I'm here to remind you:

You are not fragile.
You are not forgotten.
You are not disqualified.
You are not who the pain tried to turn you into.

You are somebody Heaven has been watching for a long time.

And now it is time to wake up the real you.

This book will push you.

Break you.

Hold you.

Heal you.

Expose the lies you've lived under.

Pull up the roots you've ignored.

And invite you back to the person you were before the world touched you.

If you're ready, turn the page.

If you're scared, turn the page anyway.

If you've been waiting for something real,

something honest,

something that speaks to BOTH the old wounds AND the future promise...

You just found it.

Let's begin.

🔥 DAY 1 — "THE FIRST TRUTH: YOU ARE NOT OKAY, AND THAT'S HOLY."

You've been carrying everything alone for so long that you forgot what honesty feels like.

People ask you if you're good.

You say "I'm straight."

But your spirit whispers,

"Not really."

Here is the wake-up call wrapped in love:

You are not okay.

And Heaven is not offended by that.

Heaven is moved by that.

Brokenness is not failure.

It is invitation.

You think God waits for perfect versions of people?
Read every story He ever touched:

Moses stuttered.

David struggled.

Peter was inconsistent.

Jeremiah wanted to quit.

Job cursed the day he was born.

Paul was exhausted beyond strength.

But they all had one thing in common:

they stopped pretending.

Endurance begins the moment you stop lying to yourself.

The moment you stop performing strength.

The moment you stop giving people the “everything is fine” version of you.

The moment you say:

“Father, here’s the truth...

I’m tired.

But I’m here.”

That honesty is holy.

That honesty is worship.

That honesty is where endurance is born.

SCRIPTURE PAIR (Two Sticks, One Voice)

> “He healeth the broken in heart.” — Psalm 147:3

“And He will make weak things become strong unto them.” — Ether 12:27

He heals the place you admit is broken.

He strengthens the place you stop hiding.

ACTION FOR TODAY

Sit still for 60 seconds.
Say nothing.
Force nothing.
Just breathe and let your heart tell the truth.

Then say quietly:

“Father, awaken the real me.”

DAY 2 — “THE BATTLE YOU NEVER ADMITTED YOU WERE IN”

Most people don't break because the fight is too big.
They break because the fight is silent.

You've been in a war you never told anyone about —
a war in your mind,
a war in your heart,
a war between who you've become and who you were supposed to be.

And here's the truth you've avoided:

Your silence didn't make the battle go away.
It just made you fight alone.

Endurance does not grow in isolation.
It grows in honesty.

There is a version of you that's been trying to breathe for years —
the version before fear shaped your decisions,
before pain taught you to protect yourself,
before disappointment trained you to expect less.

You're not weak because you're tired.
You're tired because you've been wrestling shadows with no light.

Today the light comes on.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “The light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.”
— John 1:5

> "...and it is by His light that ye may judge."
— Moroni 7:18

Light exposes the battle.
Light breaks the silence.
Light reminds you you're not crazy —
you're called.

REFLECTION

What battle did you pretend wasn't happening?

What part of you has been fighting alone?

ACTION

Write this somewhere you'll see it:

"I refuse to fight battles I won't name."

Naming the battle is how you reclaim your strength.

DAY 3 — "THE LIES THAT LIVED IN YOUR CHEST TOO LONG"

Some wounds never healed because you never exposed the lie attached to them.

It wasn't the heartbreak that broke you —
it was the lie that whispered afterward:

"You're not worthy."

"You're too much."

"You're not enough."

"God doesn't care."

"You're on your own."

"No one will show up for you."

"You always lose."

“You’re cursed.”

Lies don’t shout.
They settle.
They hide.
They live in the chest.
And over time, they start sounding like your own voice.

But listen...

Christ does not rebuild you around lies.
He breaks lies before He builds strength.

This is why endurance feels painful:
you’re not losing yourself —
you’re losing what was never you.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “He sent His word, and healed them.”
Psalm 107:20

> “...and by truth, they shall be free.”
John 8:32

The Word heals the wound.
The Truth evicts the lie.

REFLECTION

What lie have you secretly believed about yourself?

Who told you that lie?

Why did you accept it?

ACTION

Say this out loud:

“Every lie that grew in my pain —
I reject you.
Christ, replace it with truth.”

Your healing begins with eviction.

DAY 4 — “THE MOMENT YOUR HEART WENT NUMB”

People think heartbreak is the worst pain.
It's not.

Numbness is.

Heartbreak means you still feel.
Numbness means you stopped expecting anything to change.

But numbness is not protection —
it is slow spiritual suffocation.

Somewhere in your story,
something hit you so hard
that your heart shut down instead of speaking up.

You didn't choose numbness.
Numbness chose you
when your soul decided,
“Feeling hurts too much.”

But Christ never leaves people in numbness.
He touches the part that shut down.
He breathes into the part that stopped believing.
He brings warmth back to what went cold.

You think God needs your strength?
No.
He needs your surrender.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh.”

Ezekiel 36:26

> "...and I will give unto them a new heart."
Ezekiel 11:19 (recorded twice for a reason)

This is His specialty:
turning numb hearts into living ones again.

REFLECTION

When did you go numb?

What were you trying to protect?

What do you need Christ to revive?

ACTION

Put your hand over your chest and say:

"Father, thaw what went cold."

He will.

 DAY 5 — "THE REAL YOU IS STILL ALIVE"

Pain tried to bury you.
Life tried to harden you.
People tried to define you.
Circumstances tried to shrink you.
And disappointment tried to rewrite your expectations.

But here is the truth the enemy hates:

The real you survived.

The childlike you.
The hopeful you.
The trusting you.
The destined you.
The called you.
The chosen you.

Buried does not mean dead.
Hidden does not mean gone.
Silent does not mean broken.
Delayed does not mean denied.

There is a version of you God has been protecting in secret —
waiting for the moment your heart is ready to rise again.

This book is that moment.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “Before I formed thee... I knew thee.”
Jeremiah 1:5

> “Awake, and arise from the dust.”
2 Nephi 1:14

Two witnesses:
You were known before you were wounded.
And you were called long before you were tired.

REFLECTION

What part of you has been buried but not dead?

What is Christ calling back to life?

ACTION

Speak this:

“The real me is waking up.”

Because you are.

🔥 DAY 6 — “YOUR WORTH NEVER LEFT YOU”

Life can bruise you so deeply that you start confusing pain with identity.

People walked away.
But that didn't mean you were unworthy.
You failed at something.
But that didn't mean you were a failure.
You made mistakes.
But that didn't change Heaven's investment in you.

Somewhere along the way you stopped believing you were valuable.
You started acting like you were optional.
Replaceable.
Forgettable.

But listen carefully:

Nothing you went through made you worth less.
Nothing you lost reduced your value.
Nothing you suffered changed who you were in God's eyes.

Worth is not something you earn.
Worth is something you carry because He placed it on you before you were born.

You've been living under the shadow of false measurements —
people's opinions,
your own failures,
your private disappointments.

But your worth was set in eternity,
and eternity doesn't adjust its value based on temporary pain.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “Ye are of more value than many sparrows.”
Matthew 10:31

> "...and the worth of souls is great in the sight of God."
Doctrine & Covenants 18:10

Two worlds.
Same truth.
Your value never left.

ACTION

Say this slowly:

"My worth is untouched."

Because it is.

🔥 DAY 7 — "YOU SURVIVED WHAT SHOULD HAVE DESTROYED YOU"

You think you're weak because you're tired.
But tired doesn't mean weak.
Tired means you've been fighting battles others never saw.

Look back at your life with honesty:

You didn't just endure pain —
you survived storms that should've taken you out.

The abandonment.
The betrayal.
The depression.
The heartbreak.
The hopeless nights.
The suicidal moments you never told anyone about.
The tears you wiped so fast nobody knew you cried.
The disappointments that tried to rewrite your future.

And yet here you are.
Breathing.

Searching.
Trying.
Reading this book.
Still open to God.
Still willing to heal.
Still capable of love.

That's not weakness.
That's evidence.

Evidence that Heaven held you
when you didn't know you were being held.

You're not reading this because you're broken.
You're reading this because you were preserved.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> "When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee."
Isaiah 43:2

> "...for it was by His grace that ye were preserved."
Moroni 7:28

You survived because grace wouldn't let go.

ACTION

Write this somewhere:

"I am still here — and that means something."

Because it truly does.

 DAY 8 — "YOUR HEART STILL KNOWS GOD'S VOICE"

You thought you couldn't hear God anymore.

Not because He stopped speaking,
but because life became louder than your spirit.

But here is the secret you forgot:

Your heart never lost the ability to recognize His voice.

Your mind gets confused.
Your emotions get loud.
Your fears get aggressive.
Your doubts get creative.
But your heart — the place He formed —
still knows the sound of its Creator.

When Christ speaks to you, it's not always words.
Sometimes it's clarity.
Sometimes it's conviction.
Sometimes it's peace in a place you used to panic.
Sometimes it's that inner pull you can't explain.
Sometimes it's the feeling that something is off —
or something is right —
even when you don't know why.

Your heart has never stopped recognizing Him.

You just stopped trusting your knowing.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> "My sheep hear my voice."
John 10:27

> "...for they shall know the voice by which they are called."
3 Nephi 14:7

Knowing is woven into you.

ACTION

Hand on your chest, say:

“Speak again. I’m listening.”

He will.

🔥 DAY 9 — “YOU ARE NOT BEHIND — YOU ARE BEING PREPARED”

Nothing makes a person feel more defeated than the illusion of being “behind.”

Behind in life.

Behind in purpose.

Behind in healing.

Behind in spiritual growth.

Behind compared to others.

Behind compared to where you thought you’d be.

But timing is not your enemy —
comparison is.

Heaven is not on your schedule.
Heaven is on your development.

And God doesn’t rush what He intends to last.

Every delay shaped you.
Every setback taught you.
Every detour preserved you.
Every closed door redirected you.
Every season of silence strengthened your roots.
Every disappointment humbled your expectations.
Every heartbreak softened your compassion.

You think you’re late.
But you’re actually right on time —
because the version of you God needed
could only be formed the long way.

Preparation is not punishment.

It’s protection.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “Though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come.”

Habakkuk 2:3

> “And the Lord seeth fit to chasten his people; yea, he trieth their patience and their faith.”

Mosiah 23:21

Patience is not delay.

Patience is refinement.

ACTION

Say this aloud:

“I am not behind. I am becoming.”

Because you are.

 DAY 10 — “STAND UP INSIDE BEFORE YOU STAND UP OUTSIDE”

Healing is internal first.

Most people try to change their lives from the outside:

new job,

new relationship,

new habits,

new environment.

But nothing changes until you change.

Not your circumstances.

Not your patterns.

Not your relationships.

Not your outcomes.

Endurance begins when you stand up inside,

before anything around you improves.

Standing up inside means:

refusing to collapse emotionally

refusing to believe the old lies

refusing to let the past define you

refusing to shrink to fit people's expectations

refusing to let fear narrate the future

choosing truth over triggers

choosing growth over comfort

choosing healing over hiding

The world doesn't need a stronger version of your mask.
It needs the real you standing tall from within.

When you rise internally,
your life — slowly or suddenly — begins to rise with you.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> "Strengthen ye the weak hands, and confirm the feeble knees."
Isaiah 35:3

> "...and see that ye stand steadfast in this liberty."
Galatians 5:1

Before your feet move,
your heart must rise.

ACTION

Say this quietly, but with authority:

“I stand up now — from within.”

Because this is where everything shifts.

🔥 DAY 11 — “THE PERSON YOU PRETENDED TO BE IS EXHAUSTING YOU”

You didn't just hide your pain —
you built a whole identity around surviving it.

Strong.
Independent.
Unbothered.
Silent.
Resilient.
Focused.
Detached.

But here's the truth:

You outgrew the mask a long time ago.
Now it's draining you.

You're not tired because you're weak.
You're tired because you're pretending to be someone you never were.

And God is not asking you to be “stronger.”
He's asking you to be honest enough to put the false self down.

Your spirit doesn't want to perform anymore.
It wants to breathe.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward parts.”
Psalm 51:6

> “Lay aside every weight... and run with patience.”
Hebrews 12:1

The false self is a weight.
It's time to lay it down.

ACTION

Whisper this:

"I release the version of me I created for survival."

🔥 DAY 12 — "YOU ARE FIGHTING THINGS THAT ARE NOT YOURS"

Some of the battles draining you
aren't even yours to fight.

You've been carrying:

people's expectations

family burdens

generational patterns

friendships that pull from you but never pour into you

responsibilities you were never assigned

emotional weight someone else created

Not all storms are meant to be stood in.
Some are meant to be stepped out of.

Endurance isn't just holding on.
Endurance is also letting go of what is killing your spirit.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> "The LORD shall fight for you, and ye shall hold your peace."
Exodus 14:14

> "...and it is not requisite that a man should run faster than he has strength."
Mosiah 4:27

Some battles are His.
Stop stealing them.

ACTION

Say:

"If it's not mine, I put it down."

🔥 DAY 13 — "YOUR FUTURE NEEDS A DIFFERENT VERSION OF YOU"

Growth is uncomfortable because it demands separation
—from old habits,
old thinking,
old responses,
old versions of you.

You cannot walk into a new season with an outdated identity.

Your future doesn't need the wounded you.
Your future doesn't need the numb you.
Your future doesn't need the quiet, silenced, hesitant you.

The future TMH designed requires:

your clarity

your courage

your healed voice

your restored vision

your renewed hope

Endurance means becoming the person your future requires.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “Be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind.”
Romans 12:2

> “...put off the natural man and become a saint through the atonement of Christ.”
Mosiah 3:19

Transformation isn't optional.
It's preparation.

ACTION

Write this:

“I am becoming who my future needs.”

 DAY 14 — “STOP SHRINKING TO KEEP THE PEACE”

Peace built on your silence is not peace —
it's bondage.

You learned to shrink for:

family

friends

people who feared your growth

people who misunderstood you

people who needed you small to feel big

But shrinking is spiritual starvation.

Every time you made yourself less,
a piece of you dimmed.

Not anymore.

Christ didn't call you to be loud —
He called you to be true.

And your truth will disrupt every environment built on lies.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “Ye are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hid.”
Matthew 5:14

> “...and they could not deny His power.”
3 Nephi 7:18

Light does not apologize for shining.

ACTION

Say:

“I refuse to shrink for anyone.”

 DAY 15 — “DISCIPLINE IS LOVE IN MOTION”

Everyone wants a better life.
Few want the structure that creates it.

Discipline is not punishment.

Discipline is self-respect implemented.

It is:

choosing what aligns with your calling

refusing what drains your spirit

showing up when you don't feel like it

breaking cycles

protecting your energy

governing your emotions

training your mind

saying "no" with authority

and choosing growth over temporary comfort

Discipline is how you tell God:

"I love what You gave me enough to handle it well."

And discipline is what separates cycles from progress.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> "He that ruleth his spirit is better than he that taketh a city."

Proverbs 16:32

> "...and ye shall be diligent unto the end."

3 Nephi 12:20

Discipline is dominion over yourself.

ACTION

Declare:

“I will not waste the strength God is giving me.”

🔥 DAY 16 — “THE VOICE INSIDE YOU ISN’T CONFUSION — IT’S CLARITY GROWING”

Most people mistake spiritual clarity for emotional noise.

But clarity rarely arrives clean.

It arrives as:

discomfort,

restlessness,

inner agitation,

the feeling that something is “off,”

or the sudden urge to change what you used to tolerate.

This isn’t instability.

This is discernment waking up.

When God begins sharpening your spirit,
your environment becomes too loud,
your old patterns feel too small,
and your soul refuses to stay where your spirit no longer belongs.

The world calls this anxiety.

Heaven calls this alignment.

Clarity doesn’t always feel peaceful.

Sometimes it feels like being unwilling to lie to yourself one more day.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “Be still, and know that I am God.”

Psalms 46:10

> "...and the Spirit will show unto you all things what ye should do."
2 Nephi 32:5

Stillness reveals the truth that noise tried to bury.

ACTION

Place your hand over your heart:

"Ruach, increase my discernment."

🔥 DAY 17 — "YOU CAN'T HEAL IN THE SAME ENVIRONMENT THAT BROKE YOU"

One of the hardest truths to accept is this:

Some places, some people, and some patterns cannot go with you where God is taking you.

Healing requires distance.

Growth requires change.

Elevation requires separation.

You stayed in certain relationships and environments out of loyalty, fear, obligation, or hope that they'd change.

But here is the truth you already feel:

What breaks you spiritually cannot restore you spiritually.

You don't heal where you were wounded.

You heal where you are safe.

This is not abandonment.

This is alignment.

Christ never told people to stay where their soul was dying.

He told them to follow Me —

even if it meant leaving everything familiar behind.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “Come out from among them, and be ye separate.”
2 Corinthians 6:17

> “...and whosoever will come, him will I receive.”
3 Nephi 9:14

Leaving is not rejection —
it is protection.

ACTION

Say:

“My healing matters more than my history.”

🔥 DAY 18 — “THE SPIRIT IS TRAINING YOU TO RESPOND, NOT REACT”

Reactions come from wounds.
Responses come from wisdom.

A reaction is fast, emotional, defensive.
A response is slow, thoughtful, deliberate.

The Ruach is teaching you the power of pausing.

Your old self reacted.
Your healed self responds.

When you pause:

your mind clears,

your emotions settle,

your spirit speaks,

and wisdom rises.

You stop being controlled by triggers
and start being governed by truth.

This is where real strength begins —
in the moments you choose restraint over impulse.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “Be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath.”
James 1:19

> “...and see that ye bridle your passions, that ye may be filled with love.”
Alma 38:12

Self-governance is spiritual maturity.

ACTION

Say:

“I choose response over reaction.”

DAY 19 — “YOUR FUTURE CAN HEAR YOU THINKING”

Your thoughts are not harmless.
They are seeds.
Blueprints.
Instructions.

Your future responds to the internal language you repeat:

“I’m stuck.”

“I’m tired.”

“Things never work for me.”

“Nothing’s going to change.”
“I always mess things up.”

These thoughts build prisons.

But thoughts like:

“I’m growing.”
“I’m changing.”
“I’m healing.”
“God is strengthening me.”
“I’m becoming who I was meant to be.”

These thoughts build futures.

Every destiny begins in the mind long before it appears in life.

God has been trying to shift your thoughts
because your thoughts are trying to shape your destiny.

Your future can hear you thinking.
Make sure you’re speaking life.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “As a man thinketh in his heart, so is he.”
Proverbs 23:7

> “...and let virtue garnish thy thoughts unceasingly.”
Doctrine & Covenants 121:45

Your mind is the gate.
Your future is what passes through it.

ACTION

Say:

“My thoughts align with my calling.”

🔥 DAY 20 — “STOP WAITING TO FEEL READY”

Readiness is a myth people use to avoid obedience.

No one in scripture was ever “ready” when God called them:

Moses wasn’t ready.

Gideon wasn’t ready.

Jeremiah wasn’t ready.

Nephi wasn’t ready.

Peter wasn’t ready.

Paul wasn’t ready.

But purpose never waits for comfort.

You are not supposed to feel ready —
you are supposed to feel called.

Readiness comes through movement,
not before it.

Take one small step —
even if your voice shakes,
even if your faith wobbles,
even if your past screams louder than your future.

God doesn’t need perfection.
He needs participation.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “Go in this thy might.”
Judges 6:14

> “Arise and go forth.”
3 Nephi 11:20

He says go,
and your strength appears on the way.

ACTION

Write this down:

“I move when God calls — not when I feel ready.”

🔥 DAY 21 — “THE MOUNTAIN YOU CANNOT CLIMB IN YOUR OWN STRENGTH”

There comes a point in every journey
when self-improvement isn't enough.
Healing isn't enough.
Awakening isn't enough.
Insight isn't enough.

A moment comes when the soul realizes:

“I'm better than I was...
but I'm still not clean.”

You've carried wounds, yes.
But you've also carried sin.
Choices you regret.
Moments you don't talk about.
Patterns you knew were wrong but felt unable to stop.

And here is the truth no one wants to admit:

You cannot ascend the mountain of TMH
with unwashed hands
and an unturned heart.

The pain was real —
but so were the choices you made in the pain.

The numbness was real —
but so were the sins committed while numb.

The darkness you survived was real —
but you also contributed to shadows of your own.

This is not condemnation.
This is the doorway.

Healing gets you standing.
Repentance gets you clean.
Baptism gets you covered.
Covenant gets you secured.

Self-help can lift you.
Only Christ can wash you.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD?
He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart.”
Psalm 24:3–4

> “Repent, and be baptized... that ye may stand spotless before Him.”
3 Nephi 27:20

Two sticks.
One message.
You climb by cleansing.

ACTION

Whisper:

“Father, show me the parts of me that still need to turn.”

He will.

🔥 DAY 22 — “REPENTANCE IS NOT SHAME — IT IS FREEDOM”

Most people misunderstand repentance.
They think it's humiliation.
Embarrassment.

Groveling.
Punishment.

But repentance is not shame.
Repentance is release.

It is the moment when:

your past loses its grip

guilt loses its authority

sin loses its claim

darkness loses its voice

and you finally exhale the thing you hid for too long

Repentance is not for perfect people.
Repentance is for honest people.

The ones who are tired of running.
Tired of pretending.
Tired of carrying the weight alone.

Repentance is not you falling at God's feet —
it is you returning to the One who never left.

It is a homecoming.
Not a sentencing.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

> “A broken and contrite heart... Thou wilt not despise.”
Psalm 51:17

> “...and as many as repent and are baptized shall be saved.”
Mosiah 18:2

Brokenness is not a barrier.
It is the bridge.

ACTION

Say:

“I choose honesty over hiding.”

🔥 DAY 23 — “THE WATERS THAT WASH WHAT YOU COULD NEVER FIX”

You can heal emotionally.
You can grow spiritually.
You can rise mentally.
You can change habits physically.

But there is one thing you cannot do on your own:

Wash your soul.

Your past has stains you cannot scrub.
Your story has moments you cannot reverse.
Your heart carries residue you cannot cleanse.

This is why baptism exists.
Not as a ritual.
Not as a tradition.
Not as an outward show.

But as a spiritual washing
where Heaven removes

After baptism, most people expect fireworks.
Voices.
Angels.
Instant transformation.

But Heaven works deeper than feelings.

You may rise from the water:

still feeling ordinary,

still carrying memories,

still navigating emotion,

still seeing the same environment,

still facing the same battles.

But this is the truth you must anchor into your spirit:

Identity changes before feelings do.

Status changes before emotions catch up.

Heaven calls you 'new' even while you're learning what 'new' means.

When you entered the water,

God didn't wash your personality —

He washed your record.

He didn't erase your story —

He erased your guilt.

He didn't remove your memories —

He removed your charge.

He didn't fix your circumstances —

Baptism cleans the heart.
But renewal cleans the mind.

If your heart is washed
but your mind stays unchanged,
your past will keep pulling you into places your spirit no longer belongs.

This is why transformation is a process:

You must train your mind
to stop partnering with the old you.

The old you:

panicked

overthought

doubted

reacted

apologized for existing

self-sabotaged

expected rejection

confused trauma for discernment

The new you:

pauses

prays

listens

discerns

chooses wisely

forgives quickly

believes deeply

expects Christ to show up

A clean heart
and an unrenewed mind
will argue with each other every day.

Endurance means training your mind
to agree with your reborn spirit.

SCRIPTURE PAIR

Sanctification is not one moment.
It is a daily yes.

ACTION

Say:

"My thoughts must serve my salvation."



Now the reader is:

stabilizing internally.
